SPECIAL SESSION

The Board of Trustees convened in special session at 11:00AM, Friday, November 4, 2022.

ROLL CALL:

Andy English, James Roper and Chet Chaney were present.

OTHERS IN ATTENDANCE:

Michele Elliott, Fiscal Officer; Beth Beatty, Administrator

The Board of Trustees discussed the need to improve the condition of the current government offices, buildings and site. Mr. English stated that his preference is to renovate Building No. 2 to house the Police Department, move the Road Department to Building 3 (currently the Police Department) and renovate the bathrooms in the Administrative Building (No. 1). He stated that a colleague suggested tearing down the Road Building (No.2) and replacing it with a new build for the Police Department. However, Mr. English prefers to renovate due to current economic conditions.

Mr. Roper and Mr. Chaney stated that they believed it would be more efficient to have one building for all staff and requested a cost estimate. Mr. English will reach out to the architect and request updated renovation cost as well as the cost to build new. Architect, Mike Lusk, is scheduled to present renovation plans to the Citizen Advisory Committee on December 13, 2022. The meeting may be rescheduled if the cost estimates are not available by that time.
