Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township  
**Month of January 2025**



**Jan 1**

Officer was dispatched to the area of SR-161 and Linworth Rd for a disabled vehicle blocking the railroad tracks. Officer located

**Jan 2**

Officer was dispatched to the 70 block of Forrest Ridge Dr to assist a Sharon Twp Officer with an assist to medics on an ill, elderly male possibly barricaded in his home. Upon arrival, officers were let into the home and informed medics that entering was okay. Medics evaluated the male and determined no further medical attention was needed. Officers cleared without incident.

**Jan 2**

Officer received a request from dispatched to contact a resident regarding an aggressive dog in the 1300 block of Clubview Blvd N. The resident advised that a Doberman at the address on Clubview Blvd N continually runs at him and his wife while they go for walks. He stated that Doberman is very aggressive and has tried to nip at his wife at least once. Officer spoke with the owners of the dog. They said they would try to keep him under control.

**Jan 3**

Officers were dispatched to the 8300 block of Evangeline Dr on a report of a domestic dispute.

**Jan 4**

Officers were dispatched to the intersection of US-33 and Canterbury Rd on an accident. Unit 1 was southbound on US-33 approaching Canterbury Rd. Unit 2 was also southbound on US-33 approaching Canterbury. Unit 2 attempted to avoid a vehicle that had braked abruptly to turn onto Canterbury Rd causing Unit 2 to side swipe unit 1. No citations were issued.

**Jan 4**

Officers responded to an accident on Clubview Blvd N near Park Ridge Dr. Unit 1 was parked parallel to the roadway facing northeast. Unit 2 was traveling northeast, drifted off to the right and struck the rear of Unit 1. Unit 2 flipped over and came to rest on its top in the roadway. Unit 2's operator was examined by medics on scene and released. Unit 2 was issued a citation for failure to maintain reasonable control of a motor vehicle.

**Jan 4**

While traveling southbound on US-33, officer observed an abandoned car blocking the curb lane near Canterbury Rd. There was no note nor any person(s) seen near the car. Additionally, the license plate expired four months prior. The vehicle was impounded by Capital Towing. While preparing the vehicle for impoundment, a second wrecker arrived, dispatched by Geico Insurance. Officer informed the wrecker that the vehicle was an impound due to being left abandoned in the roadway and due to the expired license plate.

**Jan 5**

Officers were dispatched on report of a suicidal person.

**Jan 6**

Officers were dispatched to assist Worthington Fire who were enroute to the 6700 of Merwin Rd for a non-breather. Dispatchers were coaching the husband through CPR. Officers arrived on scene shortly after Medic 101. Medic 101 transported a female in critical condition to the hospital.

**Jan 7**

Officers were dispatched to the intersection of US-33 and Fishinger Rd. Unit 2 was eastbound on Fishinger Rd stopped behind unit 1. Unit 1 began to travel and stopped suddenly due to other stopped traffic. Unit 2 began to travel eastbound and observed unit 1 stop suddenly. Unit 2 could not stop in time and struck unit 1 in the rear end. Damage to both vehicles was minor. Driver unit 2 was issued a citation for ACDA.

**Jan 8**

Officer was notified of a flock hit of a stolen vehicle at the Worthington Hills County Club. Officer found the vehicle and met with the driver. He stated that it was a rental car he had for about three weeks after this car was involved in an accident. He provided the rental agreement. It was a three-day agreement dated December 11, 2024. The car was reported stolen out of California on January 5, 2025. The vehicle was impounded by Capital towing.

**Jan 9**

Officer investigated a complaint at Worthington Hills Elementary. There was a concern over a parent possible being under the influence when picking up their student after school. There was also concern for the student's well-being after the parent made statements about attempting to harm themselves and being in a bad mental state. As the parent lives in the City of Columbus, officer contacted CPD to advise them of the situation. CPD advised they would conduct a wellness check and lethality assessment.

**Jan 10**

Officer located 12 keys in an open shed door in the 2800 block of Snouffer Rd at the Korean Church. Officer took custody of the keys and secured the shed. The keys were eventually returned to the pastor of the church.

**Jan 10**

Officer was dispatched to the 6000 block of Deer Bluff PI on a reported theft of identity.

**Jan 10**

Officer was dispatched to Longshore St in Dublin on a hit-skip accident that reportedly occurred in Perry Township. Upon arrival, officer observed a Toyota van with rear end damage. Officer spoke with the owner, who stated that he was on the Hayden Run bridge when he was struck from behind by a newer Chrysler. The Chrysler drove away without exchanging information. Officer informed him that the accident occurred in Columbus. Columbus declined to respond to the scene and he was referred to the Columbus police website to report his crash.

**Jan 11**

Officer responded to a single-car accident at the intersection of SR-161 and Fiesta Dr. Unit 1 was traveling west on SR-161 and slid off the roadway, striking a fire hydrant, then hitting a pole. The driver left the scene prior to police arrival. The accident is still under investigation.

**Jan 11**

Officer was conducting traffic enforcement along US-33 near the city of Upper Arlington. While traveling south on US-33 south of Fishinger Rd, officer observed a black Dodge driving southbound. The sedan quickly and simultaneously activated a signal and changed lanes. After passing Canterbury Rd, the sedan quickly changed lanes again without a signal. Officer initiated a traffic stop. The driver did not speak English, so officer utilized a translator device. Officer discovered that the driver did not have a valid operator's license nor vehicle insurance. The driver was issued a citation for lines & lanes violations and for operating a motor vehicle without a valid license. The vehicle was impounded by Capital Towing.

**Jan 12**

Officer observed a gray Ford F-150 traveling northbound on US-33 near W. Fifth Avenue. The vehicle made multiple marked lanes violations before making an illegal U-turn. Officer conducted a traffic stop. Upon making contact with the driver, it was determined that he was operating a motor vehicle without a valid license. Officer issued a citation for driving without a valid driver's license and marked lanes violations.

**Jan 13**

Officer was dispatched to the 1300 block of Clubview Blvd S on a report of a possible interference with custody with an active court order in place.

**Jan 13**

Officers responded to an alarm call in the 3000 block of Brookdown Rd. Dispatchers advised the homeowner was alone and did not know why the alarm would have gone off. Officer made contact with the homeowner, who advised she may have set the alarm off accidentally.

**Jan 14**

Officers stopped with OSHP on a traffic stop at Federated Blvd and Sawmill Rd. The OSHP Trooper had made an arrest on an impaired driver. The passenger was also drunk and not complying with the orders of the Trooper. Both were transported to Perry Police HQ for breath testing. The driver blew a .177. The BAC printout was provided to OSHP.

**Jan 17**

Officers responded to a crash at the intersection of US-33 and Fishinger Rd. Unit 1 was eastbound on Fishinger Rd. Unit 2 was westbound on Fishinger Rd. Unit 1 attempted to make a left turn and struck unit in the intersection. Unit 2 then rolled into a guardrail before coming to rest. UA Medics responded and both parties were checked over but no transport was required. Unit 1 was found at fault for failure to yield.

**Jan 17**

Officer responded to the 8100 block of Blind Brook Ct on a report of identity theft.

**Jan 19**

Officers responded to an accident on US-33. Unit 1 was north on US-33 in the left lane, passing Zollinger. Unit 2 was also north on US-33. Unit 1 left their lane to the right. Unit 1 struck unit 2 and spun around before coming to rest in a ditch in front of the 3400 block of Riverside Dr. UA Medics responded to the scene. Unit 1 was found at fault for changing lanes without due regard and caution.

**Jan 24**

Officer responded to an accident near the intersection of US-33 and Fishinger Rd. Unit 2 was traveling north on US-33. Unit 1 was traveling in the same direction as unit 2. As unit 2 was waiting in the left turn lane, unit 1 struck the rear of unit 2. Unit 2 complained of neck and back pain but refused medics. Unit 1 was cited for ACDA.

**Jan 24**

Officer was dispatched to the 2500 block of Shore Line Dr on report of a suspicious person smoking drugs. Officer made contact with the caller, who indicated that an unknown black male entered the property without permission and was smoking marijuana in the men's bathroom.

**Jan 24**

Officer was notified by the Lieutenant of a possible threat against a local business. It was determined that there was no known threat at this time.

**Jan 25**

While traveling east on SR-161 from Brookdown Rd, Officer observed a speed car approaching with highbeam headlights activated. Officer estimated a speed of 60 MPH in a 45 MPH zone. Officer flash highbeams to alert the driver to dim their lights. The driver did not respond. Officer activated emergency lights and siren. The driver failed to pull over immediately. He pulled over just west of Danbury Dr. The driver did not have a valid driver's license. His wife, the registered owner of the vehicle, arrived to take possession of the vehicle. She had a valid driver's license. The driver was cited for driving without a license and failure to dim highbeams. He was warned for speeding and provided his mandatory court date.

**Jan 26**

Officer responded to an accident at the intersection of US 33 and Clifton Rd. Unit 2 was traveling south on US 33. Unit 1 was traveling west on Clifton. Unit 1 failed to notice Unit 2 causing the front of Unit 1 to strike the left side rear of Unit 2. Unit 1 was cited for failure to yield. No injuries were reported.

**Jan 27**

Officer observed an unoccupied silver sedan stopped and partially blocking the right turn lane on Riverside Dr north and Scioto Crest Dr. The vehicle had minor front end damage, appeared to have been in a minor collision, and was leaking coolant. The vehicle was impounded for safekeeping.

**Jan 28**

Officers were dispatched to a two-car non-injury crash at the intersection of Riverside Dr and West Case Rd. Unit 1 was directly behind unit 2 on Riverside Dr waiting to turn eastbound on West Case Rd when his foot slipped off the brake pedal not having enough time to stop again. This caused the front center of unit 1 to strike the rear center of unit 2. Unit 1 was found at fault for failing to maintain ACDA.

**Jan 29**

Officer was dispatched to a report of vandalism by FCSO. The caller reported finding his vehicle, while attempting to leave for work, with its passenger side window broken and the trunk popped. He stated that he could not find anything missing.

**Jan 31**

Officer was dispatched to the 8400 block of Evangeline Dr on report of a crash involving a trash truck. Officer made contact with the driver of the trash truck and the owner of a pickup truck. The driver of the pickup truck stated that he was attempting to enter the roadway and was too close to the trash truck and struck the rear taillight area. A Rumpke supervisor was on scene and handled contact with the pickup truck's driver. The pickup truck driver admitted fault.
