Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of July 2025



July 1

Officer was dispatched to the area of Riverside Dr and Fishinger Rd on a hit/skip crash. Officers determined that the accident occurred in the City of Columbus on Fishinger Rd. The other vehicle called and stopped on Dublin Rd in Hilliard. Columbus police were notified of a crash occurring in their jurisdiction.

July 2

Officers responded to a multivehicle accident on Riverside Dr near River Hills Ln. The driver of unit 2 was transported to the hospital for minor injuries. The driver of unit 1 was cited for ACDA.

July 3

While patrolling Blind Brook Dr in Worthington Hills, officer smelled the odor of natural gas in the air. Officer asked dispatch to call for Worthington Fire. Worthington Fire determined that there was a small gas leak in the 900 block of Blind Brook Dr. They were able to shut off the gas line and called Columbia Gas.

July 3

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Winston Ct N on a report of a shooting threat. Officers spoke individual who made the threat and warned them that she would be arrested if she threatened anyone with a firearm.

July 3

Officer initiated a traffic stop on Riverside Dr near Canterbury Rd after observing a vehicle speeding. During the stop, officer discovered that the driver had been suspended for 6 months regarding excessive points. A citation was issued with a mandatory appearance for excessive speed and driving while suspended.

July 4

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Fishinger Rd. Unit 1 failed to stop for the red traffic light and struck unit 2 on the passenger side. Unit 2's passenger was transported to the hospital. The driver of unit 1 was cited for a traffic control device violation.

July 5

Officers were dispatched on a mutual aid request from Dublin PD on reports of a threat at a Speedway gas station. After meeting with the reporting party, officers searched the area of Cherylbrook Dr but were unable to locate the suspect or their vehicle.

July 5

Officer responded to the 1200 block of Clubview Blvd S on a theft report.

July 5

While conducting traffic as part of the FCSO OVI task force, officer observed a vehicle without any visible registration appearing to be accelerating over the posted speed limit. Officer initiated

a traffic stop. Officer discovered that both the driver and passenger did not have a valid license. The driver was cited for operating a motor vehicle with a suspended license.

July 6

Officer observed a vehicle travel left of center on W Dublin Granville Rd near Fiesta Dr. Officer initiated a traffic stop and discovered that the driver did not have a valid license. The driver was issued a citation for marked lanes violation and operating a vehicle without a valid license.

July 6

Officer observed a vehicle driving aggressively and commit several traffic offenses on Bethel Rd and then Sawmill Rd. Officer initiated a traffic stop and discovered that the driver had a warrant through Bexley PD. Officer verified that the warrant was good, however, Bexley did not request a relay or re-cite. The driver was cited for an illegal lane change and advised to go to Bexley Municipal Court.

July 7

Officer was dispatched on mutual aid to Sharon Twp PD to assist with an arrest for a warrant. The arrest was completed without incident.

July 7

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr just south of Fishinger Rd. The driver of unit 1 was cited for ACDA.

July 8

Officer was dispatched to the 3400 block of Wolf Ridge Dr on a traffic complaint. The complainant stated that a vehicle drove through the emergency access road between Ravello and the Courtyards on Riverside.

July 8

Officer was dispatched on an alarm drop in the 8000 block of Fairway Dr. Officer found the house secure with no glass damage. Officer spoke with the homeowner and advised that the house was secure.

July 8

Officer responded to the 1500 block of Clubview Blvd S on report of an abandoned golf cart.

July 9

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr approaching south of the intersection with Hayden Run Rd. Unit 1 was cited for ACDA. Both vehicles were able to be driven from the scene.

July 9

Officers responded on mutual aid to Sharon Twp PD to assist with serving a warrant. It was determined that the individual was not home and officers cleared without further involvement.

July 10

Officers responded to the 8200 block of Fairway Dr on a report of domestic violence.

July 10

Officers responded on mutual to Sharon Twp PD to assist with an injury accident on SR-315 at Hard Rd.

July 10

Officer was dispatched to Riverside Dr on a disabled vehicle. Officer used his cruiser's push bumper to move the vehicle into the nearby Strader's parking lot.

July 11

A concerned resident came to Perry Twp PD headquarters to inform officers about potential drug activity.

July 12

Officers were dispatched to the 5000 block of Henderson Hts Rd regarding an intimidating solicitor. Officer discovered that the solicitor had an active warrant for theft by deception. Officer instructed the contractor on scene to leave.

July 12

Officer was dispatched to the 1100 block of Clubview Blvd N on an investigative complaint.

July 12

Officer was dispatched to the 0000 block of Forrest Ridge Dr in Sharon Twp to assist Sharon Twp PD per mutual aid on a domestic complaint.

July 13

Officers responded to an accident in the intersection of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd. Unit 1 failed to yield when making a left turn onto Hayden Run Rd, causing unit 2 to strike the passenger side of unit 1. The driver of unit 1 was cited for failure to yield on a left turn.

July 15

Officer was dispatched to the Riverside Dr north of Zollinger Rd on a disabled vehicle with two flat tires. AAA responded and towed the vehicle per the owner's request.

July 15

Officer observed three juveniles driving illegally on the sidewalk heading northbound on Emerald Parkway. Officer was able to stop and not collide with them in the roadway. All three juveniles fled northbound on Emerald Parkway towards Hard Rd. Officers were able to detain the juvenile on the go-kart. The juvenile's mother was contacted and arrived on scene. She was advised of the seriousness of the incident and the juvenile was released to her. The go-kart was impounded.

July 15

Officers assisted Sharon Twp PD on a motorcycle on US-23 and I-270.

July 17

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd. Unit 1, traveling eastbound on Hayden Run Rd towards the intersection, failed to notice the red traffic light and struck the front of unit 2, which was traveling northbound on Riverside Dr. Unit 1 was cited for failing to obey a traffic control device, while unit 2 was cited for not having a license.

July 17

Officer was spoke with an individual who advised that he observed a vehicle traveling northbound on Riverside Dr in which the passenger was throwing water bottles at passing vehicles. Officer was able to identify the address to which the vehicle was registered and spoke with the resident. She advised that her son may have been driving the vehicle. She was concerned and apologetic and called her son to handle the matter.

July 17

Officer responded to a blocking disabled vehicle on Snouffer Rd at Snouffer Pl.

July 18

Officer was dispatched to the 4700 block of Shuster Rd on report of a fraudulent check that had been cashed at a bank.8

July 19

While on patrol, officer observed a vehicle westbound on Hayden Rd approaching Riverside Dr with an expired registration sticker and dark tinted windows. Officer initiated a traffic stop and discovered that the driver had an expired license. The driver was issued a citation for expired tags, prohibited window tint, and driving without a valid license.

July 18

While on patrol, officer observed a vehicle westbound on Hayden Rd approaching Riverside Dr with a suspected fictitious license plate and no visible county sticker. Officer initiated a traffic stop. After confirming with Ohio BMV that the plate was not issued by them, the driver was issued a citation for fictitious plates.

July 19

Officers were dispatched to the 7900 block of Fairway Dr on an accident which caused property damage with no injuries. The vehicle went left of center while traveling northbound and struck two parked and unattended vehicles. The driver emitted a very strong odor of an alcoholic beverage from his person and breath. After field sobriety testing, the driver was placed under arrest for suspicion of OVI. A BAC test was performed and the two results were a BAC of 0.131% and 0.124%. He was released with a summons and his vehicle was impounded.

July 20

Officer was dispatched to the 3500 block of Henderson Rd on a theft.

July 20

Officer stopped a vehicle on riverside Dr for speeding. During the traffic stop, the officer observed a firearm in the glovebox. The firearm was secured and found to not be stolen.

July 21

Officer was dispatched to 2500 block of Shore Line LN on a suspicious vehicle. Officer located the vehicle and the driver. The driver stated that she was just talking to her friend who lived in a nearby condominium. Officer cleared without further involvement.

July 22

Officer was dispatched to the 6600 block of Estel Rd on report of an arrow being found on a residential property. Officer met with the property owner, who stated that he found a compound bow and arrows in the bushes on his lot. He attempted to contact his neighbors but was unsuccessful in identifying the owner, in particular, his neighbor who is a known hunter. The property was secured for safekeeping.

July 22

Officer was dispatched to the 1400 block of Oakview Dr on a report of a bug spray company soliciting without a permit. Officer located the solicitors and notified them that they could not solicit sales in Perry Township without a permit.

July 23

Officer was approached by an individual in the parking lot of Arlington Pointe, who advised that her car stalled and she could not get it started. Officer was able to start the vehicle.

July 23

Officer as dispatched on a reported vandalism in the area of Riverside Dr. Officer met with the reporting party, who stated that she was involved in a road rage incident. She stated the driver of the other vehicle threw multiple cans at her car for unknown reasons. The total damage is under \$100.00.

July 25

Officer took a report for an individual who stopped by police headquarters to report an assault.

July 27

While on patrol in the 6600 block of Merwin Rd, officers noticed the strong odor of natural gas. Officers requested that Worthington Fire respond to the area. Worthington Fire was able to locate the source of the smell as there was a gas leak that was bubbling out of the ground. They put in a ticket for Columbia Gas to repair the leak.

July 27

Officers were dispatched to the 8300 block of Evangeline Dr on a report of domestic violence.

July 28

Officer was dispatched to assist Sharon Twp PD on a suicidal person call.

July 29

Officer was dispatched to the 800 block of Clubview Blvd N on a vandalism complaint.

July 29

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr north of Chateau Cir. Unit 1 failed to yield when making a left turn while traveling northbound and struck the entire length of southbound unit 2's driver side. The driver of unit 1 was cited for failing to yield when turning left.

July 30

Officer responded to a report of an identification card located on Candlewood Dr. Officer was able to contact the company and they stated that they would come by the Police Department and pick up said identification.

July 31

Officers responded to the 7400 block of Sawmill Rd to assist Columbus PD officers. CPD officers had been in the area of Hard Rd and Sawmill Rd when they heard gunshots from a nearby bar. CPD officers encountered three subjects in the parking lot. Upon arrival, Perry Officers provided cover for CPD officers while they took the subjects into custody.
