Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of September 2025



Sept 1

Officer was dispatched to the 1300 block of Hicker Ridge Ln on a motor vehicle theft. The complainant advised that unknown person(s) took his unlocked with spare key inside vehicle.

Sept 2

Officers responded to a single vehicle accident on Riverside Dr between Wickliffe Rd and Eastcleft Dr. The vehicle was southbound on Riverside Dr and lost control. The driver stated that he hit a bump. The vehicle drove off the right side of the road and overturned. It came to rest on a tree on its side. The driver was assisted out of the vehicle and treated on scene by medics. The driver was transported to the hospital in stable condition.

Sept 2

Officer made contact with a resident who advised that an unknown person(s) entered his unlocked vehicle and removed a purse.

Sept 3

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd. Unit 1 failed to yield when turning left onto Hayden Run Rd and was struck by southbound unit 2. The driver of unit 1 was cited for failure to yield.

Sept 3

Officer responded to the 3000 block of Greenvale Dr regarding a complaint about construction.

Sept 4

Officers were dispatched to the 4600 block of Shuster Rd on a complaint. Dispatch advised that one of the parties was being disruptive and possibly assaulted. Both parties were referred to the prosecutor's office if they wanted to pursue charges.

Sept 4

Officers were dispatched to the area of US-33 and Henderson Rd to assist UAPD on shutting down the roadway due to a bomb threat. Officers blocked off traffic flow towards the scene. Officers cleared after a bomb squad unit cleared the vehicle once.

Sept 5

Officer was dispatched to the 2300 block of Riverside Dr on a report of a burglary attempt. Officer searched the premises and did not locate any signs of a possible burglary. Officer informed the caller that a moving crew appeared to be taking furniture in and out of the building on the south door. It could confuse someone that the door is a public access door and not a resident's door. With no indication of a crime occurring, no further action required.

Sept 5

Officers responded to an accident on Henderson Rd at Henderson Hts Rd. Unit 1 failed to yield on a left turn while turning from Slate Run Woods Ct to Henderson Rd and was struck by westbound unit 2. Unit 1's passenger was transported to the hospital by UAFD 73 with possible internal injuries.

Sept 5

Officer was dispatched to the 6300 block of Perimeter Loop in Dublin on report of an identity theft. The victim, who lives in Perry Township, had his identity used to buy a Porsche. Officer met with the victim, who advised that

he had not bought a Porsche so he went to the dealership in Dublin. It was determined by the dealership that the vehicle was purchased from Silver Springs Porsche in Silver Springs, Maryland, using the victim's information. Officer took a report to forward to the Detective Bureau for further investigation.

Sept 6

Officers responded to a call of a male in the roadway. Upon arrival, officers observed UAPD officers speaking to a male who was standing in the intersection of US-33 and Lane Rd. The male appeared to be confused and had trouble communicating clearly with officers. Once it was determined where the man lived, he was given a courtesy transport by Columbus Police. All cleared without incident.

Sept 6

Officer conducted a traffic stop on Sawmill Rd after observing a vehicle go left of center, make repeated marked lane violations, and erratically turn high beams on and off despite there being oncoming traffic. Upon making contact with the driver, officer immediately noticed the very strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from the vehicle. The driver's eyes were very bloodshot and watery and he had a noticeable slur to his speech. The driver admitted to drinking a Corona and a Mai Tai. Officers conducted SFSTs. The driver was placed under arrest for operating a motor vehicle while under the influence. He was slated at Franklin County James A. Karnes Correctional Facility.

Sept 6

Officers were dispatched to the 3300 block of West Dublin Granville Rd to meet the victim of a hit-skip accident. The complainant has made several complaints within the surrounding jurisdictions accusing people of following her and causing accidents.

Sept 6

Officer was dispatched to a hit-skip accident at Henderson Rd and Riverside Dr. The reporting party stated that a gray, older model Hyundai sedan rear ended her then fled eastbound on Henderson Rd. Upon reviewing camera footage, officer was able to locate the reporting party's vehicle but could not locate the other vehicle. There was damage to the party's vehicle but it is unknown when that damage occurred.

Sept 7

Officers responded on mutual aid to Sharon Township on a burglary in the 1300 block of Home Acre Dr. The occupants stated that someone had opened their front door, stole a cat, and left a note. The male occupant stated that they had cleared the house and refused to have officers check inside the house. The male occupant entered the home and found the cat while officers were at the house.

Sept 8

Officer was dispatched to SR-315 and Hard Rd to assist Sharon Township on an accident. Officer obtained information from the not-at-fault vehicle for Sharon Township and took pictures.

Sept 8

Officer was requested by a teacher to have a conversation with a student (at his parents' request) regarding taking things from the teacher's desk. Officer spoke with the student and the student said he understood and would not do it again.

Sept 8

Officers responded to the 1500 block of Oakview Dr on report of a theft of a motor vehicle. The vehicle was stolen from a resident's driveway by unknown suspect(s). The victim had previously reported the theft of a purse from the same vehicle. The key was potentially used in the theft of the motor vehicle.

Sept 8

Officers were dispatched to a multi-vehicle accident on Riverside Dr south of Henderson Rd. Unit 1 stated that he failed to stop and struck the rear bumper of unit 2, which caused unit 2 to strike the rear bumper of unit 3. The driver of unit 1 was cited for ACDA.

Sept 9

Officers were dispatched to a multi-vehicle accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Fishinger Rd. Unit 1

stated that their brakes went out causing it to strike unit 2, then unit 3, and finally come to a stop after striking unit 4. Unit 1 was cited for ACDA and no operator's license.

Sept 9

Officer was dispatched to the Brookside Golf and Country Club on a suspicious person and vehicle. A red Honda sedan was driving around the parking lot looking at vehicles. Country club employees advised that they believe the vehicle was associated with recent thefts from vehicles.

Sept 9

Officer was dispatched to the intersection of Clubview Blvd N and Clubview Blvd S on a pedestrian struck. Upon arrival, officer discovered that it was actually a crash involving a bicyclist. Sharon Township responded as it occurred in their jurisdiction. The bicyclist was transported to the hospital in stable condition.

Sept 10

Officer was at SR-161 and Hamilton Rd while working special duty. Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle after observing an SUV driving on the closed portion of the roadway within a construction while workers were present. The driver was issued a citation for operating a motor vehicle without a valid license, driving upon a closed roadway, and operating in violation of a temporary permit restriction.

Sept 10

Officer observed a vehicle with an expired registration on SR-161 near Bent Tree Blvd. Officer conducted a traffic stop. The driver was issued a citation for no operator's license and expired registration.

Sept 10

Officer was dispatched to a non-injury accident at Riverside Dr and Cranston Rd. The victim stated that he was stopped in the left turn lane on Cranston waiting to turn southbound onto Riverside Dr and was struck in the left front by a separate vehicle. CPD was called as the accident occurred in their jurisdiction. As he was unable to stand without support, the driver was placed in the back of cruiser 162 for safety. He advised that his wife had a home health aid but she might leave before he is able to get home. Officer advised that he would go to his house and check on her.

Sept 10

Officer came across a blocking disabled vehicle at Riverside Dr and West Case Rd. Officer spoke with the driver who advised that he was out of gas. Officer offered to push the vehicle out of the roadway and the driver said that would be okay. Officer moved the vehicle out of the way while the driver made arrangements with AAA. AAA arrived and the driver was able to continue home.

Sept 11

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd. A collision occurred in the intersection after northbound unit 1 turned left in front of southbound unit 2. Both drivers were transported to the hospital.

Sept 11

Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Rosslyn Ave on a mutual aid request from Sharon Township.

Sept 12

Officers were dispatched to the 1400 block of Candlewood Dr to take an identity theft report.

Sept 12

Officer observed a silver Chevrolet sedan fail to yield the right-of-way when turning left from Fiesta Dr onto SR-161, almost causing a collision. Officer initiated a traffic stop. Officer discovered that the driver's license was suspended for medical reasons. The driver exhibited some form of memory loss and her son was able to come to give her a ride. The driver was cited for failure to yield on a left turn and for operating a vehicle with a suspended license.

Sept 12

Officers were dispatched to a non-injury accident involving a bus and a bicycle in front of 1455 Candlewood Dr. The driver stated that he was driving slowly on Candlewood Dr and saw a young kid on a bike trying to squeeze past his

bus and a trash can. He stated that the kid bumped into the trash can and fell in front of the bus. The driver was able to stop in time. There was no damage to the bus or the bicycle and the child was unharmed.

Sept 12

Officers were dispatched on a complaint of domestic violence. The victim stated that the suspect came to her apartment uninvited and caused her physical harm. Officers entered the apartment with firearms drawn. Officers located the suspect hiding on the floor behind the door. He complied with commands to crawl out and lay flat on the floor. He was placed in handcuffs and custody was turned over to Upper Arlington Police who had him evaluated on scene by medics.

Sept 12

Officers were dispatched to conduct a welfare check of a possible suicidal male.

Sept 13

Officers were dispatched to the 1400 block of Park Ridge Dr to stand by for property per court order to retrieve belongings.

Sept 13

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr at Scioto View Ln. Unit 2 was waiting to turn west onto Scioto View Ln and was struck in the rear by unit 1. The driver of unit 1 was cited for ACDA.

Sept 13

Officer was dispatched to the 2500 block of Riverside Dr on a harassment/threat complaint.

Sept 13

Officers were dispatched to an accident in the 5300 block of Riverside Dr. The driver of unit 1 stated that he got distracted and struck construction barrels, overcorrected, and the struck the center face of a guardrail.

Sept 14

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Dr and Courtyard Landing on multiple reports of a white male walking back and forth across Riverside Dr holding his hands to his head and "looking distressed." Officer made contact with the man. Upon speaking with him, it was immediately apparent that he was intoxicated as he was slurring his speech and had the very strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his person. The man got agitated and tried to walk away at a fast pace towards Riverside Dr. Officer told him to stop as there was traffic. The man began to calm down and admitted that he had lost his shoes and his phones. Officers were able to call his girlfriend, who answered and immediately stated that she had been looking for the man for hours. Officers provided her with a location, and she arrived on scene. The man was safely transported and all parties cleared without further involvement.

Sept 14

Officers responded to the area of Dick's Sporting Goods on Sawmill Rd to assist Columbus PD search for an escapee.

Sept 16

Officer was driving on Sawmill Rd and heard an audible alarm going off at the Chic-Fil-A. Officer requested CPD respond and checked for open doors. The north side doors were partially unlocked and appeared to be able to be opened easily. Officer found the south side doors unlocked and made entry into the building. Officer cleared the building. Nothing appeared to be out of place.

Sept 16

Officer was dispatched to Riverside Dr and McCoy Rd on a disabled COTA bus. COTA mechanics were enroute with new batteries.

Sept 17

Officers were dispatched to an accident on Riverside Dr at Craigs Way. Southbound unit 1 went to make a left turn and was struck by southbound unit 2. The driver of unit 1 was transported to the hospital to be treated for internal injuries.

Sept 17

Officers responded to an accident on Henderson Rd. Unit 1 struck the center rear of unit 2. The driver of unit 1 was issued a citation for ACDA.

Sept 17

While responding to the previous accident, another accident occurred on Henderson Rd. Unit 2 was struck from behind in the previous crash. Unit 1 was unable to stop in time causing the center front of unit 1 to strike the center rear of unit 2.

Sept 18

Officers responded to an accident in the 5300 block of Riverside Dr. Unit 1 swerved to avoid an unknown vehicle and struck the right rear of unit 2. Unit 1 was transported to the hospital for observation.

Sept 18

Officer initiated a traffic stop on Henderson Rd on a vehicle with a canceled dealer plate. The driver did not have a valid driver's license. She also did not have proof that she purchased the vehicle and could not remember where she purchased the vehicle from. The dealer plate was confiscated, and the vehicle was impounded. The driver was issued a citation for no driver's license and no vehicle registration.

Sept 19

Officer observed a Jeep Compass run a red light at Hard Rd and SR-315. The driver had a suspended driver's license for failure to show insurance. The driver was cited for a suspended driver's license and traffic control device.

Sept 19

Officer observed several vehicles with hazard lights on Sawmill Rd and I-270 blocking the left turn lanes. Officer determined a vehicle was disabled and blocking one lane. Officer was able to push the vehicle into the right emergency lane and the driver stated that she was going to call AAA for a tow.

Sept 19

Officers responded to an accident on SR-161 approaching McVey Blvd. Unit 1 was traveling eastbound and failed to stop in time, striking the center rear of unit 2. The impact pushed unit 2 into the rear of unit 3. The driver of unit 1 was issued a citation for ACDA.

Sept 19

Officer met with individuals at the Perry Township Police Department headquarters to discuss a domestic dispute.

Sept 19

Officers were dispatched to assist Worthington PD on a search at SR-161 and SR-315.

Sept 19

Officer observed a vehicle with no taillights on Sawmill Rd. Officer conducted a traffic stop and discovered that the driver had never obtained a valid driver's license in the United States. The driver was issued a warning for the taillight violation and a citation for operating a motor vehicle without a valid license.

Sept 20

Officer responded to a request for assistance by medics to gain access to a home in the Larkstone Area. resident was evaluated by medics and cleared to remain at home.

Sept 20

Officer observed a car traveling southbound on Riverside Dr with highbeams activated and an estimated speed of 65 MPH in a 45 MPH zone. Officer conducted a traffic stop. The driver did not have a valid license. The driver was cited for driving without a valid driver's license.

Sept 21

Officer initiated a traffic stop after observing a vehicle leave its lane and maneuver a U-turn in the middle of the road. The driver did not have a license; however, the registered vehicle owner was a passenger and had their license. Officer discovered that the driver had a suspended license and two warrants. Neither warrant was extraditable from Franklin County. The driver was issued a citation and a mandatory court date.

Sept 21

Officer observed a vehicle traveling north on Riverside Dr near Nottingham Rd at a high rate of speed. Radar indicated the speed to be 63 MPH in a 45 MPH zone. Officer began to initiate a traffic stop. The vehicle came to a screeching stop then accelerated, made a lane change without signaling, and a marked lanes violation. Officer suspected that the driver may be impaired due to swerving within the lane and multiple traffic violations. Officer requested mutual aid from Dublin PBD for stop sticks. After a protracted chase, officer requested permission to conduct a Precision Immobilization Technique (PIT), which was approved. Eventually, officer was able to successfully PIT the vehicle west of Reflections Dr. Officers boxed the vehicle in so it could not flee and took the driver into custody. The driver had the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his person and blood shot and watery eyes and was combative. He was processed at Perry Township PD headquarters and charged with failure to comply, operating a motor vehicle while under the influence, driving under suspension, operating a motor vehicle without a valid license, furnishing false information to avoid citation, marked lanes violations, speed, disobeying a traffic control device, reckless operation, and open container. It was also discovered that he had multiple warrants through Franklin County Municipal Court. He was slated on his charges and warrants.

Sept 22

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr at McCoy Rd. Unit 1 attempted a left turn from Riverside Dr onto McCoy Rd without yielding to unit 2. Unit 2 attempted to avoid unit 1 but struck unit 1 in the passenger rear tire. Unit 1 was issued a citation for failing to yield.

Sept 24

Officers were dispatched to a 911 hang up in the 3000 block of Greenvale Dr. The homeowner stated that he was the only one at home and that he did not recognize the phone number provided by dispatch. He did not appear to be in distress.

Sept 25

Officers were dispatched to an accident on Riverside Dr north of Lane Rd. Unit 2 was north on Riverside Dr and slowed then stopped for traffic. Unit 1 did not come to a stop before striking the rear of unit 2. The driver of unit 1 stopped and exited the vehicle but then got back in the vehicle and drove south on Riverside Dr.

Sept 26

Officer assisted Sharon Township PD on mutual aid on a report of a male who left his assisted living and was not at his previous residence and was confused. Officers assisted him and transported him back to his residence.

Sept 26

Officer observed a silver Volkswagen traveling east on Henderson Rd with possible prohibited tinted windows. Officer initiated a traffic stop. The driver was issued a citation for prohibited tint, failure to wear a safety belt, and driving without a valid license.

Sept 27

Officer was dispatched to the area of Riverside Dr and Henderson Rd on a male sleeping in the grass. Officer located and woke up the male, who advised that he was walking all evening and wanted coffee. Officer provided him with courtesy transport to the Shell gas station at Sawmill Rd and Bethel Rd.

Sept 27

Officer was dispatched to the 2500 block of Winston Ct N to assist Columbus's Water Department.

Sept 27

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of SR-161 and Linworth Rd. Unit 1 turned north onto Linworth Rd and was struck on the passenger side by Unit 2. Passenger of unit 2 was treated on scene by Worthington Medic 101. The driver of unit 1 was cited for failure to yield on left turn.

Sept 27

Officer observed a gray Mustang traveling east on SR-161 at Linworth Rd. Officer determined that the vehicle had an expired registration. Officer initiated a traffic stop and determined that the driver did not have a valid driver's license or insurance. It was determined that the vehicle's registration sticker on his license plate did not belong to the vehicle. He admitted that it came from a friend. The driver was issued a citation for driving without a valid

license, expired registration, and fictitious registration stickers. The plate was seized, and the vehicle was impounded.

Sept 27

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of SR-161 and Fiesta Dr. Unit 1 began to make a left turn onto Fiesta Dr as unit 2 entered the intersection causing unit 2 to strike unit 1 on the passenger side. Unit 1 was found to be driving an Ohio Temporary Permit without a valid driver in the vehicle. Unit 1 was issued a citation for no valid operator's license and failure to yield on a left turn. Unit 2 was found to be operating without a valid license and a citation for no valid operator's license was issued.

Sept 28

Officer observed a Toyota Prius traveling north on US-33 near Clifton Rd without functioning headlights and only fog lights. The vehicle also did not have a functioning license plate light. Officer attempted to conduct a traffic stop. The vehicle continued northbound, ignoring emergency lights and sirens. Officers conducted a felony stop ordering the driver out of his vehicle. The driver stated that he did not know what to do and did not know that he was supposed to stop for the police when they were behind him with lights and sirens activated. Upon further inspection, it was discovered that the vehicle had both a California and an Ohio registration. The driver was issued a citation for failure to comply, driving in violation of a license suspension, lights on a motor vehicle, and operating with plates of a previous owner.

Sept 29

Officer was dispatched to Forest Ridge Dr in Sharon Township to assist Sharon Officer on a domestic violence call. No arrests were made and officer cleared.

Sept 29

Officer responded to a request for mutual aid from Sharon Township PD for assistance in dealing with a person in a mental health crisis. Medics arrived to assess the individual. She was transported to the hospital on a mental health emergency with officers assisting.

Sept 29

Officers responded to Camp Mary Orton as back up to Sharon Township PD. There was a suspicious male seen climbing the gate and trespassing. The male was located on scene and appeared to be having a mental health episode. Medics arrived and he was transported to the hospital in stable condition.

Sept 30

Officer visited a first grade class at Brookside Elementary at the teacher's request to talk to the class about why they shouldn't take things that don't belong to them.
