Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township  
**Month of October 2025**



**Oct 1**

Officer responded to the 900 block of Colony way to assist Sharon Township PD with an alleged assault that occurred at Colony Way and Colony Ct.

**Oct 2**

Officer was working the school zone at 6700 McVey Blvd and was approached by a gentleman who stated that he found property at Snouffer Rd and McVey Blvd. The items included several cards and a broken cell phone. Officer took the property to Perry Township PD and placed it in an evidence locker for safekeeping.

**Oct 3**

Officer responded to an accident on Riverside Dr at Quarry Ln. Unit 2 was traveling northbound on US-33 and was stopped in traffic. Unit 1 was traveling behind unit 2 and failed to keep an assured clear distance, striking unit 2 in the rear. Unit 1 then went off the roadway and stopped upon hitting an adjacent embankment. Driver of unit 1 was cited for failure to maintain ACDA.

**Oct 5**

Officer was traveling northbound on Riverside Dr approaching Nottingham Rd and observed a vehicle traveling south on Riverside Dr at a high rate of speed in the media lane. Officer estimated a speed of roughly 60 MPH in the 45 MPH zone; radar indicated a speed of 66 MPH. Officer activated lights and siren and initiated a traffic stop. Officer approached the driver's window and observed that he had red bloodshot eyes and the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage. The driver declined to perform field sobriety tests. He was placed under arrest for suspicion of driving under the influence of alcohol. The driver was asked to submit to a breath test and he again declined. He was issued a citation for unlawful speed and OVI.

**Oct 5**

Officers were dispatched to the Public Storage on Billingsley Rd on a theft complaint.

**Oct 6**

Officers responded to the area of SR-161 and Linworth Rd to provide mutual aid to Worthington Police on reports of a female attempting to break into multiple businesses.

**Oct 6**

Officers responded on mutual aid to Sharon Township PD on a suicidal individual.

**Oct 6**

Officers responded to an accident on US-33 south of Fishinger Rd. Unit 1 was attempting to turn northbound onto US-33 from the McDonald's parking lot. Unit 2 was traveling northbound south of the intersection. Unit 1 failed to yield when turning from the parking lot, causing the front left corner of unit 2 to strike the right-side rear of unit 1. Unit 1 was cited for failure to yield.

**Oct 7**

Officer was dispatched to the 6200 block of Scioto Highlands on a threat/harassment complaint.

**Oct 8**

Officer was on routine patrol and came across a blocking disabled vehicle on W Dublin Granville Rd. Officer was able to use his cruiser's push bumper to push the vehicle out of the roadway.

**Oct 9**

Officer responded to an accident in the 2700 block of W Dublin Granville rd. The driver of unit 1 stated that she was not paying attention and struck the center rear of unit 2. The driver of unit 1 was issued a citation for ACDA.

**Oct 10**

Officers responded to the area of the I-270 eastbound ramp to Sawmill Rd on reports of a vehicle fire on a semi-truck. Upon arrival, officer observed flames on the inside of both rear tires of the semi's trailer. Officer used a fire extinguisher to extinguish the fire. Officer waited for Dublin PD and Washington Township Fire to arrive on scene before clearing.

**Oct 11**

Officer was dispatched to the 5400 block of Havenhill Dr on a complaint regarding a Fed Ex driver parking his truck in a resident's yard.

**Oct 11**

Officer responded on mutual aid with Sharon Township for an injury accident in the 7900 block of Flint Rd.

**Oct 13**

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr at Cranston Dr. Unit 1 was traveling west on Cranston Dr. Unit 2 was traveling north on Riverside Dr. Unit 1 failed to yield on a left turn causing them to strike the right front of unit 2.

**Oct 13**

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Clubview Blvd S for a stand-by for property retrieval.

**Oct 13**

Officer was dispatched to the 1500 block of Oakview Dr to assist Worthington Fire on a house fire. Officer spoke to fire officials who advised that the fire was contained and it appeared to be the bathroom exhaust fan that caught fire. No injuries were reported.

**Oct 14**

Officer responded to an accident on Riverside Dr at Hayden Run Rd. Unit 1 was southbound on Riverside Dr at Hayden Run Rd in the left turn lane. Unit 2 was northbound on Riverside Dr at Hayden Run Rd. Unit 1 driver stated that he had a green arrow to turn left onto eastbound Hayden Run Rd. Unit 2 driver stated it was impossible for unit 1 to have a green arrow because she had a green light that turned yellow when unit 1 turned left and struck her rear driver's side tire area. Unit 1 driver was issued a citation for failure to yield on a left turn.

**Oct 15**

Officer was dispatched to the 1500 block of Oakbourne Dr on a theft from vehicle complaint.

**Oct 15**

Officer was driving on Park Ridge Dr and notice da black briefcase laying in a driveway in the 1400 block. Officer picked up the briefcase and found mail addressed to the residence. Officer also noticed that the center console of the vehicle parked in the driveway was unlocked and had been opened. A neighbor contacted the homeowner as no one would answer the door. The homeowner checked the vehicle for missing items and could not tell if anything else was taken.

**Oct 15**

Officer was dispatched to the 700 block of Lakeshore in Sharon Township on mutual aid on a wellness check.

**Oct 15**

Officer responded to an accident on Riverside Dr. Unit 2 was traveling north on Riverside Dr in the left lane. Driver 1 was in the left lane and attempting to merge into the left lane as the right lane ends. Both drivers gave conflicting statements on scene and ODOT video is not discernable as to the location of both vehicles during impact.

**Oct 16**

Officers were dispatched to the 2200 block of West Dublin Granville Rd on a traffic accident with wires down and where the at-fault vehicle had fled. Worthington Fire 101 checked the lines and contacted AT&T. Worthington Fire located a grocery bag in a tree and advised officers. Officers checked the bag and discovered a bag of marijuana and a scale. Officers also located a small Henessey bottle and the suspect's Costco card. Perry Officers impounded the marijuana and Worthington Police found more marijuana on the subject.

**Oct 16**

Officer was on patrol on Smoky Row Rd. While monitoring southbound traffic, Officer observed a tan Honda sedan traveling southbound at 58 MPH in a posted 35 MPH zone. Officer initiated a traffic stop. Upon approach to the driver's side window, officer immediately detected a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from the open driver's window. The driver had glassy eyes and slurred speech. When asked to exit the vehicle, the driver appeared unsteady on his feet and was observed swaying side to side and front to back. Officers conducted field sobriety tests and determined that the driver was impaired. The driver refused breath testing and administrative suspension procedures were initiated. The vehicle was impounded and the driver cited for OVI and speeding. He was released to a responsible party.

**Oct 16**

Officers were dispatched to the 6500 block of McVey Blvd on a vehicle that had struck a fire hydrant then left the scene. Officers later received a call from the driver who admitted fault. They were cited for failure to control.

**Oct 16**

An individual arrived at the Perry Township Police Department to report a possible identity theft case.

**Oct 17**

Officer observed a vehicle travelling westbound on Snouffer Rd with no left headlight illuminated. Officer conducted a traffic stop. The driver stated that she did not have a valid driver's license. Officer issued a citation for driving without a license and having a headlight out.

**Oct 17**

Officer responded on mutual aid for Sharon Township to the 8200 block of Windsong Ct on a mental health call.

**Oct 17**

Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Rosslyn Ave on mutual aid to assist Sharon Township with an individual in a mental health crisis.

**Oct 18**

Officers responded on mutual aid to the 5200 block of Avery Rd on a report of a residential fire with people possibly still inside. Upon arrival, it was determined that everyone had exited the residence and the fire department was on scene and actively working to extinguish the fire. Officers remained on scene to help with road closures.

**Oct 18**

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Fishinger Rd. Unit 1 was traveling eastbound on Fishinger Rd attempting to turn northbound on Riverside Dr. Unit 2 (a motorcycle) was traveling westbound on Fishinger Rd approaching Riverside Dr. The driver of unit 1 said that he was waiting at the green light to turn northbound onto Riverside Dr. Unit 1 began a left turn and was struck in the center front by unit 2. Both occupants of unit 2 were ejected before landing at the northwest corner of Riverside Dr and Fishinger Rd. Both the driver and occupant of unit 2 were transported to the hospital. The driver of unit 1 was issued a citation for failure to yield when turning left.

**Oct 18**

Officer observed a vehicle that appeared to be traveling above the speed limit on Riverside Dr near Nottingham Rd. The registered owner was listed as suspended and found that the vehicle color of the vehicle listed in the registration did not match the vehicle the officer observed. Officer conducted a traffic stop for fictitious plates and the operator complied. Officer discovered the operator to be the registered owner and reviewed the driver's registration paperwork. Officer determined that everything was correct except for the color of the vehicle. The driver was issued a citation for driving with a suspended license and given a warning for speed.

**Oct 19**

Officer observed a black Dodge truck on SR-315 south traveling at excessive speed in the area of SR-161. Officer observed the truck using the middle and median lanes to pass other cars. The truck also had a broken left taillight. Officer initiated a traffic stop. Officer conducted a records check of the tag and found that it had expired five months ago. There was no record of a driver's license for the registered owner. The driver conceded that he did not have a valid driver's license. The driver did not exhibit any signs of impairment. Officer conducted a driver's license search and discovered that the driver was actively suspended. The vehicle was impounded and the driver was provided a courtesy transport to his place of employment.

**Oct 20**

Officer was in Worthington Hills Elementary School and was advised by the principal that a

teacher had passed out and needed help. Washington Township Engine 92 and Columbus Medic 27 arrived to render assistance.

**Oct 22**

Officers were dispatched to the 1800 block of West Case Rd on a possible injury accident where a vehicle crashed into trees. Officer arrived and spoke with the caller. The caller indicated that the suspect was over by the vehicle. Officer approached the vehicle and the suspect started to run eastbound along the road and then around trees. Officer continued after the suspect. Officer grabbed the suspect to place into custody. The suspect passively resisted. Officers took the suspect into custody and later found that the suspect had previously been arrested for OVI. Officers discovered that the vehicle had left the roadway in Columbus's jurisdiction and turned the scene over to CPD.

**Oct 22**

Officer responded to an accident on Riverside Dr. Unit 2 was traveling southbound on US-33 approaching Wickliffe Rd. Unit 1 was traveling southbound on Riverside Dr behind unit 2. Unit 1 struck unit 2 from behind causing unit 2 to go off the right side of the roadway. Unit 1 was cited for ACDA.

**Oct 22**

Officer was driving southbound on Riverside Dr approaching Ravello Dr and noticed a small silver SUV making multiple marked lanes violations. Officer could see the driver's head tilted to the right of the seat. Officer believed that she was either on the phone or possibly distracted. Officer continued to follow the vehicle and observed it make more marked lane violations, fail to react when a light turned green and observed it cross the center line into oncoming traffic. After Officer activated lights and siren the vehicle began to slow down but then accelerated. Eventually, the vehicle slowed down and came to a stop. Officer approached the driver, an elderly Asian woman, and determined that there was probably a language barrier. Using a translator app, Officer was able to speak with the driver. During the conversation, Officer believed that she might be suffering from some kind of medical condition. Medics determined that she was medically fine. A medic who spoke her language was able to assist with communication. Officer determined that she needed to retake her test for her driver's license due to the multiple traffic violations observed.

**Oct 23**

Officer responded to a request from Sharon Township to perform a breath test for a motorist that they had arrested for suspected impaired driving.

**Oct 23**

Officer was dispatched to the 900 block of Bethel Rd. Dispatch advised that there was an open telephone line with screaming and yelling in the background. Officer spoke with the owner of the plaza who stated that there were no issues at his business. Officer also checked the other businesses around, but nothing was found.

**Oct 23**

Officer was dispatched to assist a resident with reporting an identity theft case.

**Oct 23**

Officers responded on mutual to Sharon Woods Park in Sharon Township on mutual aid for a suicidal person.

**Oct 23**

Officers were dispatched to the area of Clubview Blvd N on a dead-on-arrival call.

**Oct 23**

Officers responded to the area of Clubview Blvd N on a possible mental health crisis.

**Oct 25**

Officer was sitting in a cruiser on US-33 at Courtyard Landing. Officer heard the extremely loud sound of a vehicle accelerating. When the vehicle came into view, officer observed it to be traveling at an extremely high rate of speed. Officer estimated its speed to be 90 MPH. Radar confirmed a speed of 93 MPH in a 50 MPH zone. Officer lost sight of the vehicle before reaching Cranston Dr but observed that there was a noticeable amount of smoke left directly in the trail of the vehicle. Upon approaching SR-161, officer observed a Dublin cruiser in the roundabout with its lights activated. The vehicle that had just fled was stopped in front of the DPD cruiser. The vehicle had lost control and hit the median. The driver was arrested and issued a citation for speed and reckless operation and issued a criminal complaint for failure to comply with an officer's order or signal.

**Oct 25**

Officer responded to the listed address to assist Sharon Township with a mental health call.

**Oct 25**

Officer was patrolling Brookside Estates and observed juveniles running along McVey Blvd West. Officer noticed homeowners come out with flashlights and shine it on a group of juveniles in their yard. Officer discovered that the juveniles did not live in the area but had come from a party in the 6400 block of Brookbend Dr. They had decided to go ding-dong-ditching.

**Oct 25**

Officers were dispatched to the area of 6800 Merwood St on report of shots fired in the area. Upon arrival, officer checked the area before making contact with a resident who provided video footage capturing the noise. Multiple officers from Columbus PD arrived in the area and stated that they had received calls concerning shots fired in the area in the area just off of Snouffer Rd and one call from off of Smoky Row Rd. All units checked the area but could not find any evidence of shots fired.

**Oct 26**

Officers were dispatched to Sawmill Rd and Hard Rd on mutual to Columbus PD for an injury crash that was blocking multiple lanes. Officers aided by blocking the lanes and directing traffic away from the crash scene.

**Oct 27**

Officer was standing on the north side of Clubview Blvd S and Candlewood Dr with two teachers for special needs students while waiting for the bus. While the red lights were flashing, officer

heard the bus blow its horn and observed a black minivan with a female driver drive past the flashing red emergency lights. The bus driver was able to get the license plate of the minivan. Officer was able to locate the driver at their place of residence to issue a citation for failing to stop for a school bus.

**Oct 27**

While on patrol, officer came across a blocking disabled vehicle at US-33 and Hayden Run Rd. The driver said that he had help on the way. Officer helped push the vehicle out of traffic.

**Oct 28**

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Circle on the Green to assist Worthington Medic 101 on an unconscious male.

**Oct 28**

Officers were dispatched to the 2600 block of McVey Blvd W on a mental health crisis.

**Oct 29**

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Scioto View Ln on a report of a roommate complaint. Dispatch indicated that the caller was locked out of her condo by her roommate.

**Oct 29**

Officer was dispatched to the 1200 block of Clubview Blvd N on a well-being check. The resident was found to be okay, but his land-line phone was down. Officer was able to speak with a technician to have the phone line repaired.

**Oct 29**

Officer observed a sedan in the 1000 block of Bethel Rd with suspected tinted windows. Officer initiated a traffic stop. Upon contact with the driver, he stated that he did not have insurance and that his driver's license was not with him. Upon further investigation, officer discovered that the driver had a temporary Ohio permit and could only operate a vehicle while in the presence of a licensed driver. The driver was issued a citation, and the vehicle was released to a licensed driver.

**Oct 30**

Officer was dispatched along with Sharon Twp officer on a domestic incident in the 8300 block of Evangeline Dr.

**Oct 30**

Officers were dispatched to an accident on Riverside Dr near Clifton Rd. Unit 2 was southbound on Riverside Dr and stopped for traffic. Unit 1 did not come to a stop before striking the rear of unit 2. The driver of unit 1 was issued a citation for ACDA. No party was injured.

**Oct 30**

Officers were dispatched on mutual aid to Sharon Woods Metro Park for a suicide.

**Oct 31**

Officers were dispatched to Henderson Rd for an accident near Shady Hollows Ln. Unit 1 was

traveling westbound behind unit 2. Unit 2's driver stated that vehicles in front of him were coming to a sudden stop when he was rear-ended by unit 1. Unit 1 driver stated that unit 2 slammed on his brakes which is why he struck unit 2. The driver of unit 1 was cited for ACDA. There were no injuries.

**Oct 31**

Officer was dispatched on mutual aid to Sharon Township on an injury accident at Hard Rd and SR-315. Officer held the scene and collected information until Sharon Township PD arrived.
