Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of November 2025



Nov 1

Officer conducted a traffic stop in the 5500 block of Riverside Dr. The vehicle was traveling at a speed of 73 MPH. The driver acknowledged that she had active warrants in Franklin County. Officer verified that the driver had a suspended Ohio license. The driver was arrested and subsequently transported to the JAK Franklin County Jail. The driver was additionally cited for speed and driving under suspension.

Nov 3

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Sciotoview Ln on a well-being check. Officers were able to make contact with the resident who advised that all is well.

Nov 3

Officer responded to a report of identity theft.

Nov 3

Officer was dispatched on a report of an elderly female who was breathing but was nonresponsive. Worthington Medic 101 checked on her vitals, and all showed normal.

Nov 5

Officer responded to a lockout call in the 1200 block of Candlewood Dr.

Nov 5

Officers responded to the area of Newcomer Rd and Markhaven Dr on a report of an aggressive driver who was possibly intoxicated. During the investigation it was determined that the driver was not intoxicated. There was a box of old corona beer bottles in the truck. The driver did not have a valid driver's license and had fictitious plates. The vehicle and trailer were impounded. The driver was cited for driving without a valid driver's license and two counts of fictitious tags.

Nov 7

Officers responded with Sharon Twp PD on mutual aid for an accident with a vehicle fire on SR-315 N at I-270.

Nov 8

Officer observed two vehicles in the middle of the SR-161 roundabout that appeared to have been involved in a crash. Officer provided both parties with exchanges of information as Dublin PD arrived.

Nov 8

Officer was dispatched to the 6500 block of Winston Ct E on a vandalism. An unknown person(s) broke the front passenger window of the resident's truck.

Nov 8

Officer was dispatched on a protection order violation through social media.

Nov 8

Officers assisted Dublin per mutual aid with setting up a perimeter to locate suspects who had stolen a vehicle.

Nov 8

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr at the intersection with Henderson Rd. The driver was driving westbound on Riverside Dr and slid through the intersection striking the guardrail. The driver was issued a citation for failure to control and ODOT was contacted regarding damage to the guardrail.

Nov 9

Officers were investigating a traffic crash at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Henderson Rd. Officers utilized marked patrol cars to block all traffic driving through the immediate area. An SUV drove through flares and failed to slow or attempt to divert as instructed. In an attempt to prevent injury to other officers investigating the accident, officer sped up to cut off the SUV before it reached the impact area. Officer approached the young male driver, who apologized. He stated that he was not carrying a driver's license. Officer observed for more young males in the vehicle and the smell of an alcoholic beverage. None of the teens were over 17 years of age. Officer contacted the parents of each juvenile. The mother of one of the boys received authorization from the other parents to take custody of them. The driver was issued a citation for violation of a traffic control device and failing to provide license upon demand.

Nov 9

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr at the intersection with Zollinger Rd. Unit 2 was southbound on Riverside Dr stopped to turn left onto Zollinger Rd. Unit 1 was also southbound on Riverside Dr approaching unit 2 from behind. Unit 1 was unable to stop and struck the rear of unit 2. The driver of unit 1 was cited for ACDA and no operator's license.

Nov 9

Officer was dispatched on mutual to Sharon Twp for a non-injury crash on the SR-315 southbound ramp to Bethel Rd.

Nov 10

Officer was dispatched to the 1300 block of Hickory Ridge Ln on a vehicle lockout. Officer was able to gain entry to the vehicle and access the keys.

Nov 11

Officer was dispatched to the area of Sawmill Rd and Sawbury Blvd to assist the Delaware County Sheriff's Office and the Powell Police Department with a pursuit and armed carjacking. On scene, DCSO and Dublin PD had a male on the ground. Powell PD had a female in custody.

Nov 12

Officers were dispatched to Riverside Dr and Fishinger Rd on a blocking disabled vehicle. The owner advised that the vehicle had simply stopped running and that a tow was enroute.

Nov 12

Officer was requested to respond to the 1300 block of Oakbourne Dr over threats being made by a homeowner towards on-scene workers.

Nov 12

Officers responded to an accident in the 3000 block of Riverside Dr. Unit 1 was southbound on Riverside Dr attempting to turn left. Unit 2 was northbound on Riverside Dr. Unit 2 noticed unit 1 begin to make the turn and attempted to avoid the collision. This caused unit 1 and unit 2 to collide in a sideswiping manner. Unit 1 was cited for failure to yield when turning left. No injuries were reported.

Nov 13

Officer made contact with church on Smoky Row Rd. The owner stated that a bike had been left

on their property for several months and not moved. Officer took the bike to police headquarters for safekeeping.

Nov 16

Officer was dispatched to the Brookside Country Club for a motion alarm. All doors were locked and there were employees inside the club.

Nov 16

Officers responded to an accident on SR-161. Unit 1 was exiting a business from a right turn only driveway. Unit 2 was westbound on SR-161 approaching Linworth Rd Unit 1 made a left turn to go east on SR-161 and struck the front of unit 2. The driver of unit 1 was issued a citation for failure to obey a traffic control device.

Nov 18

Officers came across a blocking disabled vehicle on SR-161. Officer assisted with moving the vehicle safely out of the roadway.

Nov 19

Officer observed a black vehicle traveling eastbound on Hayden Run Rd drive through the intersection on a red light, almost causing an accident. Officer initiated a traffic stop and observed that the vehicle possibly had tinted windows above the legal limit and an expired registration sticker. The driver did not have his license with him. Officer learned that the driver was under a license forfeiture suspension and did not have a current valid license. The driver was cited for a traffic control device violation, prohibited tint, driving while under a license forfeiture suspension, and driving without a valid license.

Nov 20

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr and Zollinger Rd. Unit 2 was traveling southbound on Riverside Dr at Zollinger Rd stopped in traffic. Unit 1 was traveling in the same direction as unit 2. Unit 1 failed to notice unit 2 causing the front of unit 1 to strike the rear of unit 2. No injuries were reported. The driver of unit 1 was cited for ACDA.

Nov 21

Officer initiated a traffic stop on McVey Blvd near Brookbend Dr for a traffic control violation. Officer discovered that the driver's license had expired. The driver was issued a citation for a traffic control device violation and driving without a valid driver's license.

Nov 22

Officer initiated a traffic stop after a vehicle failed to dim their high beams for traffic. Officer discovered that the driver had a suspended license. The driver was issued a citation for driving under suspension.

Nov 22

Officer responded to an accident on Riverside Dr south of Zollinger Rd. The driver of unit 2 stated that an unknown vehicle struck the rear left corner of his truck. The driver of unknown unit 1 did not stop at the scene. The driver of unit 2 was found to have an expired driver's license and an active non-compliance suspension. The driver was issued a citation for driving under suspension and no driver's license.

Nov 24

Officers were dispatched to the 4600 block of Shuster Rd regarding a personal property complaint.

Nov 25

Officer responded to an accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd.

Nov 25

Officers responded to a mutual aid request from CPD regarding a suspect in a felony theft running from police in the area of Bethel Rd and Sawmill Rd. An individual matching the description of the suspect was apprehended by CPD in front of 5018 Henderson Hts Rd.

Nov 27

CPD requested the use of the Perry Township PD BAC machine per mutual aid.

Nov 27

Officer was dispatched to assist OSHP with an impaired motorist. OSHP trooper requested to use the Perry Township PD BAC machine for a breath test.

Nov 28

Officer observed a vehicle with hazard lights on at Sawmill Rd in the center lane. Officer spoke with the driver, who indicated that the vehicle locked up. Officer waited for CPD and a tow to arrive to prevent a crash.

Nov 29

Officer responded to a crash on W Case Rd. Unit 1 was traveling westbound on W Case Rd. Unit 2 was traveling eastbound on W Case Rd. As both units passed, unit 1 went left of center causing the driver side front of unit 1 to strike the driver side front of unit 2. The driver of unit 1 was issued a citation for a marked lanes violation.
