Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of December 2025



Dec 1

Officer responded to a report of an unconscious person. Officer found the victim awake. Officer cleared when Worthington Medic 101 arrived and required no additional assistance.

Dec 1

Officer responded to an accident on Winston Ct W. While attempting to move his parked vehicle, the driver accidentally hit a fire hydrant. The driver was cited for failure to maintain reasonable control.

Dec 1

Officer observed a minivan on US-33 remain stopped at a green light for an unusual amount of time and impede northbound traffic. Officer observed the driver using a cellphone while stopped at the light. Officer initiated a traffic stop. Upon approach, officer could smell an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from inside the vehicle and observed what appeared to be an open alcoholic beverage. The driver had glassy eyes with wide pupils. The driver presented a temporary Illinois driver's license. Officer asked the driver to exit the vehicle and the driver refused. Upon continued refusal, officers removed the driver from the vehicle. The driver was arrested and the van was impounded for safekeeping.

Dec 2

Officers responded to a request from Sharon Township for mutual aid on a non-injury single car accident where the driver was suspected of driving under the influence. The driver refused to submit to standardized field sobriety tests and was arrested by Sharon Township PD for operating a motor vehicle while under the influence.

Dec 3

Officer responded to an accident on Riverside Dr at Zollinger Rd. Unit 1 was southbound on Riverside Dr and was not able to stop in time, striking unit 2 from behind. The driver of unit 1 was cited for ACDA.

Dec 3

Officer observed a sedan with parked on the north side of Riverside Dr. Officer cleared after help arrived to fix the vehicle's alternator.

Dec 3

Officer observed two vehicles parked in the Perry Township parking lot. Officer observed two individuals, a male and a female. The female began yelling and screaming at the male. Officer spoke with the female, who was uncooperative and belligerent. She said that she was just involved in a crash and exchanged information with the man. Officers refused to allow the man to drive home due to the smell of an alcoholic beverage and glassy eyes.

Dec 4

Officer was dispatched to the 2400 block of Merbrook Rd on a vandalism report.

Dec 5

Officers responded to a single vehicle accident on West Case Rd. Unit 1 failed to make the left

turn onto Riverside Dr, striking a guardrail. Medics arrived on scene to check on the driver. The driver refused to be transported to the hospital. The driver was cited for failure to control.

Dec 5

Officer responded to the 900 block of Bethel Rd on reports of threats received from an unknown individual.

Dec 6

Officer was dispatched on mutual aid to assist OSHP with an OVI arrest. An OSHP Trooper requested use of Perry Township PD's BAC machine.

Dec 7

Officer was dispatched to the 1200 block of Clubview Blvd N on a death notification.

Dec 8

Officer observed a vehicle traveling at 70 MPH on Riverside Dr in a 50 MPH zone. Officer conducted a traffic stop and discovered that the driver did not have a valid license.

Dec 8

Officers were dispatched to assist Dublin PD on alarm drop in the 4100 block of W Dublin Granville Rd. Officers found the business to be secured and left a notice on the door.

Dec 9

Officer assisted CPD with a traffic stop in the 6300 block of Sawmill Rd. It was determined that the driver had a medical condition and CPD transported them to the hospital.

Officers observed a gray vehicle parked at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Lane Rd with emergency blinkers on. Officer made contact with the driver, who explained that he had just picked his car up from the shop and it started overheating. Officer could smell a strong odor of fresh and burnt marijuana emitting from the vehicle. Officer observed a smoked joint in the center console area. When asked, he stated that he did not have firearms on his person or in his vehicle. Upon asking again, the driver stated that he did have a firearm in his vehicle. Officer found a 9mm pistol in the passenger side rear pocket. The driver was arrested for improper handling of a firearm in a vehicle.

Dec 10

Officer responded to an accident on Riverside Dr at Lane Rd. Unit 1 failed to stop in time striking the rear of unit 2. The driver of unit 1 was cited for ACDA.

Dec 10

Officer responded on mutual aid to Sharon Township on an injury accident in the area of I-270 westbound and SR-315 southbound. Officer remained on scene to assist with traffic control until being relieved by FCSO deputies.

Dec 11

Officers responded on mutual aid to Sharon Township for an injury accident on US-23 north at Flint Rd.

Dec 11

Officer initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle traveling 52 MPH in a 35 MPH zone on SR-161. Officer discovered that the driver did not have a valid license. The driver was cited for operating a motor vehicle without a valid license and speed.

The driver stated that he then backup and turn in front of unit 2 causing the collision. The driver of unit 1 was cited for improper backing.

Dec 13

Officers responded to a call from a suspicious person on Riverside Dr at Lane Rd. Upper Arlington Medic 72 was on scene and treating the male. He was transported to the hospital for medical treatment.

Dec 14

Officer observed a vehicle facing westbound in the eastbound lanes of Bethel Rd. Officer observed an unconscious male in the back passenger side seat. He was the only occupant of the vehicle. Columbus Police and Medics were contacted as it was in their jurisdiction. Officer was unable to wake the occupant. He was released to Columbus Police who were handling the incident.

It then spun completely around and crossed two lanes of traffic, finally coming to rest facing north in the northbound lanes. Unit 1 did not strike any other vehicles. The driver was cited for failure to maintain reasonable control.

Unit 2 began rolling onto its side and struck unit 3 on the front bumper and hood. The drivers of units 2 and 3 were transported to the hospital in stable condition by Upper Arlington medics. The driver of unit 1 was cited for failure to yield on a left turn.
