Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of January 2026



Jan 1

Officers responded to a report of an unoccupied car parked and unattended in the roadway. Capital Towing was notified and responded to impound the vehicle.

Jan 2

Officer was dispatched to Linworth Rd and SR-161 on report of a disabled vehicle. Officer located the vehicle with the hood up. The father of the registered owner stated that the alternator was out. Officer waited on scene until a tow truck arrived.

Jan 2

Officers responded to a crash on Clubview Blvd S approaching Colon Way Dr. Unit 1 was traveling southbound on Clubview Blvd S and failed to stop, striking the rear of unit 2. The driver of unit 1 was issued a citation for assured clear distance ahead.

Jan 5

Officers were dispatched on report of an alarm drop. Officers arrived and checked the exterior of the residence and found it to be secured.

Jan 5

Officers responded on report of a possible heart attack along with Worthington Fire & EMS. Upon arrival, Officer was told that the victim was awake, talking, and breathing. Officer remained on scene until Worthington Fire & EMS arrived.

Jan 6

Officer observed a disabled vehicle at the intersection of US-33 and Emerald Parkway. Officer made contact with the driver who stated that he was an Acura representative and he was test-driving the vehicle for a customer. He stated that a tow truck was enroute. Officer placed down road flares for visibility and left as the tow truck arrived on scene.

Jan 7

Officer took a report of a theft from a vehicle.

Jan 8

Officer responded on mutual aid to Sharon Township on an injury accident on I-270 EB at US-23. Officer remained on scene to assist with traffic control until the scene was cleaned up.

Jan 9

Officers were dispatched to assist Sharon Township and the Franklin County Sheriff's Office on an injury accident at SR-315 SB at I-270. Officers blocked traffic until FCSO advised that they could clear.

Jan 9

Officer was flagged down at Arlington Pointe. The individual stated that there was what appeared to be an abandoned vehicle parked in the parking lot. The vehicle had a smashed out rear window. After some research, Officer determined that the vehicle could be towed.

Jan 10

Officer conducted a traffic stop after the driver failed to dim highbeams despite multiple

warnings. Officer discovered that the driver was suspended for non-compliance. The driver was cited for driving while suspended and failing to dim high beams.

Jan 10

Officer responded to the area of Kanawha Ave on mutual aid to Sharon Township on report of a non-injury crash. Officer assisted with the crash scene and helped with the exchange of information.

Jan 10

Officer responded to an accident on US-33 near West Case Rd. Unit 1 was northbound on US-33 while unit 2 was stopped at the red light on West Case Rd west. Unit 2 was proceeding through the intersection after the light turned green. Unit 1 failed to stop for the red light and was struck by unit 2. The driver of unit 1 was cited for failing to obey the red light.

Jan 10

Officer responded to assist Columbus Police with traffic control for an injury accident on SR-161 at Martin Rd while CPD pursued a suspect.

Jan 11

Officer observed a vehicle appear to be traveling in excess of the posted speed of 45 MPH on Canterbury Rd. Radar indicated a speed of 62 MPH. Officer initiated a traffic stop and discovered that the driver did not have a valid license. The driver was issued a citation for driving without a valid license and speed.

Jan 11

Officer observed a white sedan fail to stop at a stop sign on McVey Blvd SB. Officer initiated a traffic stop. The driver was cited for disobeying a traffic control device and operating a vehicle without a valid license.

Jan 12

Officer responded to an accident on US-33 at Hayden Run Rd. Unit 1 was traveling south on US-33 and failed to yield on a left turn, turning in front of unit 2. The driver of unit 1 was cited for failing to yield on a left turn while the driver of unit 2 was cited for not having a valid license.

Jan 15

Officers were dispatched to the area of US-33 at Bethel Rd on a blocking disabled white pickup with damage. On scene, officers were met by firefighters from Upper Arlington Fire. UAFD informed officers that a UAPD officer had the suspect at gunpoint. Officers immediately assisted UAPD. The suspect had been digging around the back of his truck and ignoring officers' commands. The suspect was eventually taken into custody without incident. Officers located no weapons but did find multiple open containers of Vodka and Modelo.

Jan 15

Officers assisted Columbus Police with apprehending a suspect.

Jan 15

Officer observed a vehicle on Hard Rd run a red light. Officer initiated a traffic stop and discovered that the driver did not have a valid driver's license or insurance. Officer also discovered multiple active warrants for the driver's arrest. Officer placed the driver under arrest per the warrants and additionally cited him for disobeying a traffic control device and driving without a valid driver's license. He was taken to Franklin County James A. Karns correction facility and slated.

Jan 16

Officer was dispatched to the area of West Case Rd on report of a car fire. Upon arrival,

Columbus Fire had already extinguished the vehicle and the driver had exited without injury. Officer provided the driver a courtesy transport to his home while the vehicle was towed.

Jan 17

Officers were dispatched to assist Sharon Township on a domestic complaint.

Jan 17

Officer was dispatched on mutual to Sharon Township for a wellness check.

Jan 18

Officers were dispatched to assist Worthington Medics with a forced entry to assist an injured party.

Jan 18

Officer observed a driver on with their cellphone in their hand and in front of their face on SR-161. Officer initiated a traffic stop and discovered that the driver did not have a valid license. The driver was cited for driving without a license and using a cellphone while driving.

Jan 18

Officers assist Franklin Township on mutual aid for a suspect that had broken into a business. Officers deployed a UAS to search for the suspect.

Jan 18

Officer observed a vehicle parked in the wrong direction on Skyline Dr W near Snouffer Rd. Officer ran the registration and discovered that the vehicle had been entered on stolen by Dublin Police. Officer contacted Dublin PD who then contacted the registered owner. The vehicle was released to the owner without incident.

Jan 19

Officers responded on mutual aid to Worthington Police to assist with an injury accident with suspects that fled on foot. Officers assisted in searching for the suspects, but no one was located.

Jan 19

Officer was dispatched on mutual aid to Worthington Police in searching for two juveniles who fled a stolen vehicle that they had wrecked on SR-161 at SR-315.

Jan 20

Officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of Clubview Blvd N to assist Worthington Fire in with traffic due to a gas line break. Officers blocked off Clubview Blvd N between Fairway Dr and Oakview Dt until Columbia Gas shut down the gas line.

Jan 20

Officer responded to a crash on US-33 south of Bethel Rd. Unit 1 failed to maintain assured clear distance head and struck the rear of unit 2.

Jan 20

Officers were dispatched Circle on the Green on a possible burglary in progress. Officers determined that the home was clear.

Jan 21

Officers responded to an accident on US-33 at Zollinger Rd. Unit 1 was southbound on US-33 making a left turn when it was struck by northbound unit 2. Unit 2 then struck unit 3. The driver of unit 1 was cited for failure to yield on a left turn.

Jan 21

Officer responded to a request by Columbus Police to use Perry PD's BAC machine.

Jan 22

Officers were dispatched to Clubview Blvd S on an alarm drop. Officers searched the building and found nothing disturbed. Officers were able to secure the door and returned to patrol.

Jan 22

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of US-33 and Hayden Rd. Unit 1 stated that, due to icy conditions, she was unable to come to a complete stop. Unit 1 struck the rear of unit 2.

Jan 22

Officer was flagged down regarding another crash that occurred on US-33. All parties exchanged information and declined a report.

Jan 22

Officer responded with Sharon Township PD on a reported house fire on Flint Rd. Officer assisted with traffic control until no longer needed.

Jan 22

Officers were dispatched to provide mutual aid to Sharon Township PD and Worthington Fire on reports of a residential fire.

Jan 24

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd on report of a suspicious person.

Jan 24

Officers were dispatched to US-33 north of Zollinger Rd on report of a possible impaired driver. Callers had stated that the Honda Pilot was traveling on the wrong side of the road and had minor damage. While responding it was reported that the Honda had crashed and rolled over. Officer made contact with the driver. He had struck a telephone pole which tore off the front passenger side tire and caused the vehicle to roll over. Officer noticed the strong odor of alcohol emitting from the driver's person. He also had glassy eyes and a slight slur to his speech. After SFSTs, the driver was placed under arrest for operating a motor vehicle while under the influence and failure to control.

Jan 25

Officer responded to an accident on Riverside Dr approaching Fishinger Rd. Unit 1 hit a snowbank and lost control. Unit 1 then struck the left front snowplow of unit 2 with the right front of unit 1. The driver of unit 1 was issued a citation for failure to control.

Jan 26

Officers responded on mutual aid to Sharon Township PD for an injury accident on SR-315 NB at Bethel Rd.

Jan 28

Officers were dispatched to a non-injury crash in the area of Shore Line Ln. As the accident occurred on private property, officers assisted with the exchange of information and called a tow truck.

Jan 28

Officer was dispatched to the area of Riverside Dr and Eastcleft Rd on several disabled vehicles. Officers moved the vehicles out of the roadway and assisted with traffic control until all vehicles could continue on or were out of the main roadway.

Jan 28

Officer was dispatched to the area of W Dublin Granville Rd and Bellbrook Pl on a disabled vehicle. Officer observed an unoccupied black sedan.

Jan 28

Officer observed a gray sedan traveling west on Bethel Rd at US-33 disobey a traffic control device. Officer initiated a traffic stop and the driver presented an expired California license. The driver was cited for disobeying a traffic control device and operating a motor vehicle without a valid license.

Jan 30

Officer responded to an accident on SR-161 at Nicholas Dr. Unit 2 was driving west on SR-161 and came to a stop for traffic. Unit 1 was also traveling west on SR-161. Unit 1 failed to come to a complete stop and struck the rear of unit 2. The driver of unit 1 was cited for ACDA.

Jan 30

Officer observed a silver sedan traveling eastbound on SR-161 at Brookdown Dr. The vehicle went left of center. Officer initiated a traffic stop and discovered that the driver had a suspended license. The driver was cited for a marked lanes violation and driving with a suspended license.
