Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of July 2021



July 1, 2021

Officers were dispatched to the 5600 block of Riverside on an alarm drop. All doors and windows were locked and secured. Officers cleared the scene and returned to patrol.

July 1, 2021

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Drive and Cranston Road on a report of a driver striking a down tree branch. Officers arrived on the scene and documented the incident.

July 3, 2021

Officers were dispatched to the 3300 block of Courtyard Landing on an alarm drop. Upon arrival, officers checked the residence and found all doors to be secure and no signs of forced entry. Officers resumed patrol.
