Month of May 2021

May 2, 2021

Officers were dispatched on a 911 call to the 1000 block of Clubview Blvd S. Once on scene Officers located the callers outside who stated they witnessed a power transformer catch fire and it caused their phone service to disconnect.

May 2, 2021

Officers were dispatched to an animal complaint in the area of Riverside Dr and Ravello Community entrance. Offices arrived and found a deer that had been critically injured in a car accident. The Officer then dispatched the deer and requested ODOT to come collect the deer carcass.
