Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of October 2021



Oct 1

While on routine patrol, Officers observed a disabled vehicle at the intersection of Sawmill Rd and West Dublin Granville Rd. Officers assisted the vehicle out of the roadway and resumed patrol.

Oct 1

Officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for speed in the area of US 33 and Lane Ave. During the course of the stop, the driver was found to not have a valid license. The driver was cited, and the vehicle was released to a valid driver. Officers resumed patrol.

Oct 1

Officers responded to a custody dispute that occurred in the 6700 block of McVey Blvd. Officers spoke with the mother, who said her child was picked up by the father who, due to custody agreement, did not have the rights to. The male was in another jurisdiction. Officers contacted that jurisdiction and worked with them to conduct a well-being check on the child. The child was determined to be ok and was returned to the mother. Officers resumed patrol.

Oct 2

Officers were dispatched to a non-injury accident at the intersection of Henderson Rd and Riverside Dr. Officers arrived on scene and learned the crash occurred in the Upper Arlington Police Department's jurisdiction. Officers stayed on scene until Upper Arlington arrived on scene. Once on scene officers cleared the scene and resumed patrol.

Oct 2

While on routine patrol, officers observed a disabled vehicle in the area of Riverside Dr and Cranston Dr. Officers checked on the vehicle and discovered it was not occupied. Officers checked with local agencies, and it was not involved in any crimes or blocking the roadway. Officers documented the contact and resumed patrol.

Oct 2

While on routine patrol, officers observed a suspicious vehicle with a male running from homes in area of Clubview Blvd and Park Ridge Dr. Officers stopped the vehicle and, during the stop, the driver was found to have an expired license. The driver was cited, and officers resumed patrol.

Oct 3

While on routine patrol officers, observed a wrong way driver in the area of Sawmill Rd and SR 161. Officers conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle and, during the traffic, stop the driver was found to be intoxicated. The driver was placed under arrest and refused further testing. The driver was issued a citation and released to a sober party. Officers resumed patrol.

Oct 3

Officers were dispatched to an alarm drop in the 8000 block of Evangeline Dr. Officers arrived on scene and checked on the residence. Officers found no signs of forced entry and resumed patrol.

Oct 3

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Dr and Scioto View Ln on an abandoned vehicle. Officers arrived on scene and started a tow for the vehicle. The owner returned while officers will still with the vehicle and advised that it was out of gas. The owner was able to fill her car with gas and leave the area. Officers resumed patrol.

Oct 5

Officers were dispatched on a theft report. The theft occurred in the area of 2500 Riverside Dr. Officers took a report and went back on patrol.

Oct 5

Officers were dispatched to the area of West Case Rd on an abandoned vehicle. The vehicle was impounded for safe keeping. Officers cleared and went back on patrol.

Oct. 6

Officers helped Sharon Township Police Department on a traffic stop in the area of Linworth Rd. Officers stood by while an arrest was made, then cleared and went back on patrol.

Oct 7

Officers responded to the 2400 block of West Dublin Granville Rd on a suspicious male. Officers arrived on scene and spoke with the male. Officers discovered he had schizoaffective disorder and called for a county crisis officer to respond to the scene. The deputy arrived on scene and transported the male to the hospital per his request. Officers documented the incident and resumed patrol.

Oct 7

Officers assisted Dublin Police in looking for a suicidal male in the area of I-270. Officers were unable to locate the male and resumed patrol.

Oct 8

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Darwin Dr on a report of an identity theft. Officers arrived on scene and spoke with the victim. The victim stated that an unknown person had used their identity and opened multiple credit cards. The incident was documented, and officers resumed patrol.

Oct 8

While on patrol, officers discovered an injury crash in the area of West Henderson Rd and Reed Rd. Officers advised Franklin County Dispatch of the accident and that it was in the city of Columbus. Officers assisted the victims and had them checked by medics. Officers held the scene until the Columbus Police arrived. Officers resumed patrol.

Oct 9

Officers responded to a theft in the 2500 block of Riverside Dr. Upon arrival, Officers met with the victim who reported their Honda CRV had been stolen. Officers documented the incident and entered the vehicle as stolen into the L.E.A.D.S Database. Officers resumed patrol.

Oct 9

While on routine patrol, Officers located a Honda Civic in the area of Borgata Ln and Ridgetop Ln. After checking the plate on the Honda, Officers were alerted it had been stolen. Officers contacted the owner of the vehicle who was present in the area. He stated that vehicle was not stolen, and the Columbus Police had incorrectly entered his other vehicle that was stolen. Officers documented the incident and resumed patrol.

Oct 9

While on routine patrol officers observed a male who was rummaging through a car in the 2500 block of Olde Hill Ct. Officers made contact and while speaking with him the male fled on foot. Officers were unable to locate the male and documented the incident before resumed patrol.

Oct 10

While on routine patrol, Officers located a male juvenile lying on the ground in the area of Billingsley Rd. Officers requested medical assistance to the scene and provided aid to the male until medics arrived on scene. Once cleared by medics, the male was released to his parents and officers resumed patrol.

Oct 10

While on routine patrol, Officers observed a traffic crash in the area of Sawmill Rd and I-270. Officers assisted in traffic control until Columbus Police arrived on scene. Officers resumed patrol.

Oct 10

Officers were dispatched to the area of US 33 and Henderson Road on a disabled vehicle. Officers arrived on scene and spoke with the driver. The driver advised she had hit a lawn chair and it was stuck under her vehicle. Officers removed the chair, and the vehicle was able to leave the scene. Officers resumed patrol.

Oct 11

While on routine patrol officers located a single car accident on Riverside Dr at State Route 161. During the course of the accident investigation officers discovered the driver to be intoxicated. The driver was placed under arrest and issued a citation for driving while intoxicated. The driver was released to a sober party and officers resumed patrol.

Oct 11

Officers were dispatched to the 8000 block of Park Ridge Ct on a report of an identity theft. Officers arrived and spoke with the victim. She reported that she had been receiving strange emails about her personal information being stolen. The victim stated she had done multiple credit checks and saw no evidence of this. She informed officers that she would only want a report documenting the incident. Officers documented the incident and resumed patrol.

Oct 13

Officers responded to an injury accident in the area of Riverside Dr and West Henderson Rd. Officers arrived on scene and found two victims in critical condition. Those victims were transported to the hospital. Due to the severity of the injury's the crash scene was turned over to the Franklin County Sheriff's Office. Officers provided traffic control for the Sheriff's Office until they were done with their investigation. Officers then resumed patrol.

Oct 15

While on routine patrol, Officers conducted a traffic stop in the area of Sawmill Rd and Bethel Rd. During the course of the stop the driver was found to not have a valid Ohio Driver's License. The driver was issued a citation and the vehicle was released to a valid driver. Officers resumed patrol.

Oct 15

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Clubview Blvd S on an assist to medics. Officers arrived on scene and assisted medics. Once medics were done evaluating the patients, they decided they needed further medical treatment at a hospital. The patients were transported to the hospital and officer resumed patrol.

Oct 16

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of McVey Blvd on a report of a 911 hang up. Officers arrived on scene and were met by medics. Medics informed the officers that the resident had fallen and needed help getting up. Officers assisted medic in helping the resident and then resumed patrol.

Oct 17

Officers were dispatched to the area of Hard Rd and Graystone Ln to assist Sharon Township Police on an injury accident. Officers arrived on scene and provided traffic control until no longer needed. Officer cleared the scene and resumed patrol.

Oct 17

Officers responded to the Perry Township Headquarters to assist Sharon Township Police with a chemical breath test on a suspected drunk driver. Officers collected a breath test and provided it to Sharon Township. Sharon Township escorted their suspect out of the building and left the Perry Township Headquarters. Officers resumed patrol.

Oct 18

Officers were dispatched to the 1500 block of Oakview Dr on a harassment report. Officers arrived on scene and met with the victim, who stated that he had found damage on his vehicle on multiple occasions, and he received threats from an unknown party. Officers documented the incident and resumed patrol.

Oct 18

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Scioto View Ln on a man with a gun. Officers arrived on scene and located the suspects. No firearms were found. All parties were documented, and officers cleared the scene.

Oct 22

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Dr and Henderson Rd on a disabled vehicle. Officers arrived on scene and spoke with the driver, who stated they ran out of gas. Officers waited while the driver had someone bring them gas. The driver got gas and cleared the roadway. Officers resumed patrol.

Oct 22

Officers were dispatched to the area of US 33 and Riverside Dr on a road rage. The victim stated the driver of another vehicle got out of their vehicle at the stop light at US 33 and Riverside Dr and began punching the victim's vehicle. The victim fled the scene and contacted

the police. Officers checked the area and could not locate the suspect vehicle. The incident was documented, and officer resumed patrol.

Oct 22

Officers assisted Columbus Police in the 5000 block of Cobblestone Dr in looking for a stabbing suspect. Officers checked the area suspect but could not locate the suspect. Officers documented the assist and resumed patrol.

Oct 22

Officers were dispatched to the 7900 block of Fairway Dr on an alarm drop. Officers arrived on scene and checked the home. The home showed no signs of forced entry. Officers documented the alarm and resumed patrol.

Oct 22

Officers were dispatched to the area of Sawmill Rd on a stolen vehicle. Officers checked the area and located a vehicle that matched the description of the vehicle. Officers attempted to stop the vehicle but the vehicle fled the officers. Officers did not pursue and documented the interaction.

Oct 22

Officers were dispatched to the 8200 block of Copperfield Dr on an alarm drop. Officers arrived on scene and checked the home. The home showed no signs of forced entry. Officers documented the alarm and resumed patrol.

Oct 23

Officers were dispatched to malfunctioning railroad signs in the area of State Route 161 and Linworth Rd. Officers arrived on scene and provided traffic control until CSX arrived to fix the signs. Officers resumed patrol once the signs were fixed.

Oct 23

Officers were dispatched to an accident in the area of US 33 and Hayden Rd. Officers arrived on scene and discovered the crash occurred in the city of Columbus. Officers contacted the Columbus Police and were advised to have the parties exchange information. The Officers had the parties exchange information and cleared the scene before resuming patrol.

Oct 24

While on routine patrol officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle. During the course of the stop the driver was found to have warrants out of Delaware county. The driver was arrested and transported to meet with a Delaware County Sheriff's Deputy.

Oct 24

Officers were dispatched to the Railroad tracks near Linworth Rd. Officers were advised the tracks traffic control arms were down and not going up. Officers arrived on scene and directed traffic until the issues was fixed. Officers cleared the scene and resumed patrol.

Oct 24

Oct 25

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Clubview Blvd S on an identity theft. Officers arrived on scene and documented the incident. Officers resumed patrol.

Oct 25

Officers were dispatched to an injury accident in the 1800 block of West Case Road. Officers documented the crash and the vehicle involved was impounded for safe keeping and due to it being disabled. Officers documented the crash and resumed patrol.

Oct 26

Officers were dispatched to the 7100 block of Sawmill Rd on a call of an officer in trouble. After searching the area, Perry and Dublin Police located Columbus Police detaining a male on Billingsley Rd. Officers updated dispatch and canceled additional cars responding. Columbus Police cleared the scene and officers resumed patrol.

Oct 27

Officers were dispatched to Riverside Dr and Zollinger Rd on a vehicle crash. Upon arriving at the scene, officers determined it was not a car accident. Officers spoke with a male who stated that the woodchipper hitched to his truck had detached and run off the roadway. There was minor damage to the woodchipper, but no injuries. Officers documented the incident, cleared the scene, and resumed patrol.

Oct 28

Officers were flagged down on McVey Blvd by a male. The man said he was involved in a hit/skip and wanted to file a police report. The man explained he had gotten into an altercation with another driver and that, on Snouffer Rd, the other driver struck his door and drove away. Officer explained to the man that the crash happened in the City of Worthington and for a report he would need to contact Worthington Police.

Oct 29

A woman came to the Perry Township Police Department wanting to file a police report for a theft. The woman stated she was buying a dog online for her father. She was told by the seller that there would be an additional charge for shipping the dog. The woman said she would come pick the dog up, but the seller refusing, citing COVID-19 and refused to refund the money. The woman contacted her bank to see if they could refund her and would contact the police department if her money was able to be refunded.

Oct 29

Officers were dispatched to Hayden Run Road on an accident that occurred on Riverside Drive. Officers discovered that a car was rear ended while waiting for a red light. Officers spoke with both drivers and advised that Columbus Police does not respond to non-injury accidents and that they were to exchange information. Both parties exchanged information and officers cleared the scene.

Oct 30

Officer initiated a traffic stop on Henderson Rd on a vehicle that was tracked by RADAR as going 50mph. The officer began issuing a ticket to the male suspect. While conducting the stop with the suspect, officer noticed the suspect displaying delayed gross motor skills and low, slow speech, and empty cans in the vehicle and suspected they were for alcoholic beverages. Officer requested an additional officer be sent to investigate. After conducting tests and investigating the suspect's vehicle, the suspect was placed under arrest for operating a vehicle while under the influence of alcohol or drugs of abuse. His vehicle was inventoried and impounded.

Oct 30

Officers responded to a request from Columbus Police to locate a possible hit/skip vehicle at an address. Officers made contact with the parents of the vehicle's registered owner. The parents stated the owner did not live there anymore and provided a phone number. Officers provided Columbus Police with the number and cleared the scene.

Oct 31

Officers responded to a motorcycle crash on Riverside Drive and observed that the driver of motorcycle was intoxicated. The driver, a male, was found with the motorcycle laying on top of him and a strong odor of alcohol was coming out from or about his person. The male was transported to Riverside Methodist Hospital by Columbus Medics. Officers interviewed the suspect at the hospital, eventually charging him with operating a motor vehicle impaired, and impounding his vehicle.

Oct 31

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Riverside Drive to investigate a complaint. Complainant, a female, advised that her ex-boyfriend had stopped by their residence twice that day and was aggressive towards her and her friend. Officers received details of the individual and were unable to locate information in LEADS. Complainant advised she would call again if the individual returned to her residence. Officers cleared the scene and resumed patrol.
