September 1, 2021

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Bethel Rd on a 911 hang up. Officers spoke with receptionist who stated all was fine. Officers cleared the scene.

September 1, 2021

Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Clubview Blvd N on report of a theft. The caller stated that a check was stolen from his mailbox. After calling the bank, they advised that the check was altered. The amount was returned to the caller. Police do have a suspect.
