Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of March 2021

March 3, 2021

Officers were dispatched to the 1400 block of Oakview on an alarm drop. Upon arrival Officers spoke with a contractor on scene who stated that he opened the patio door and accidentally set the alarm off.

March 3, 2021

Officers were dispatched to the 7000 block of Greenside Lane on a suspicious person. Officers were not able to locate anyone matching the description.

March 4, 2021

Officers responded to an alarm drop at the 1500 block of Markland Street. Officers arrived on scene and discovered it was a false alarm.

March 6, 2021

Officers were dispatched to the area of W Dublin Granville Road and Linworth Road on a suspicious person. Officers arrived and located the man who was in need of medical assistance. A squad was called and help was provided. The individual was then given a ride to a shelter, as he had no place to stay for the night.
