Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of February 2021

February 1, 2021

Officers were dispatched to the area of Hayden Run Rd and Riverside Dr on a non-blocking disabled vehicle. Officers arrived and spoke to the motorist who stated she and another vehicle were involved in a non-injury crash. The crash took place within the City of Columbus. Columbus Police were not taking non-injury crashes both parties were advised to exchange information.
