Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township  
**Month of January 2021**

**January 1, 2021**

Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Bethel Road on an alarm drop. An open door was found and the owner was contacted who said he would have an employee come and secure the door.

**January 5, 2021**

Officer were dispatched to Riverside Drive and McCoy Road on a vehicle fire. Officers arrived and found a vehicle that had overheated. Officers spoke with the owner/driver and she stated she had help on the way.

**January 7, 2021**

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Scioto View. The caller had her vehicle stolen in Columbus and wanted an officer to walk through her apartment to make sure no one was inside since her keys were in the vehicle. The Officer searched the apartment and found no one.
