Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township  
**Month of August 2020**

### **August 1, 2020**

A Columbus man flagged down an Officer as they exited the Perry Township Police Headquarters. The man stated he had just been rear ended by a silver vehicle that left the scene. It was determined the crash occurred in the Columbus Police jurisdiction so a Columbus Police Officer was requested to respond to the scene.

### **August 1, 2020**

An Officer was dispatched to assist Sharon Township Police in the area of SR 315 and Hard Road on a single car injury crash. The Officer assisted Sharon Officers until the crash scene was cleared up and Sharon Township made an arrest on the driver for operation under the influence of alcohol.

### **August 1, 2020**

Officers were dispatched to the area of U.S.33/Riverside Dr on a man who appeared to be drunk and stumbling about. Officers arrived and searched the area but did not locate anyone matching the description given or anyone in the roadway at all.

### **August 2, 2020**

Officers were dispatched to the 2700 block of West Dublin Granville Road on a business motion alarm. Officers arrived and found an uber driver waiting outside for someone. Officers made contact and identified a Columbus man who was at the business for a wedding and fell asleep in the locker room during the festivities. As he exited, he tripped the alarm. No damage was found and the building was found to be locked.

### **August 2, 2020**

Officers were dispatched to the 2600 block of Scioto View on a suspicious person ringing the callers door bell. Officers arrived and were flagged down by a man who matched the description given. After he was identified, he explained he was riding his bike, became lost and had no phone so he tried to get someone to help him. Officers were able to contact a family member to provide the man with a ride.

### **August 2, 2020**

Officers were dispatched to the area of Scioto View Lane on an animal complaint. Officers made contact with the complainant and was advised another dog had attacked his dog. Officers made contact with the other dog owner and the situation was referred to animal control for a follow up.

### **August 2, 2020**

Officers were on patrol and noticed a power pole burning next to a transformer in the area of Fiesta Drive. Officers closed the road and had Worthington Fire department respond to control the fire. Officers notified AEP which responded and fixed the pole and transformer.

**August 3, 2020**

Officers arrived and the caller stated nothing was missing but, the car had been gone through. A report was taken to be forwarded to the detective bureau. She felt it would be safer with the weapons out of the home. The weapons were taken on her behalf and logged into property for safekeeping.

Officers were on patrol in the area of Linworth Road and noticed a disabled vehicle blocking the roadway. Officers helped push the vehicle off the road and stood by while Triple A arrived to help.

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Drive on a suicide attempt by pills. The individual in question denied trying to harm themselves. Officers had medics check out the individual and it was determined that everything was fine and that the individual would talk with a therapist.
