Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township  
Month of September 2020

### September 1, 2020

An individual came to the police department to drop off a cell phone that was found at the Brookside Country Club. Officers took the phone and impounded it for safe keeping and placed it in locker 3.

### September 2, 2020

Officers assisted Columbus Police on an accident near Snuffer Road and McVey Blvd.

### September 2, 2020

Officers assisted Columbus Police at Perry Township headquarters on a BAC test. The subject had two invalid tests so Columbus Police transported him to Riverside hospital for a blood draw.

### September 3, 2020

Officers were dispatched 1300 block of Beechlake Dr on an emotionally disturbed person yelling in front of the caller's home. Officers arrived and spoke with a neighbor who stated the person who was yelling was an autistic child who was already back inside his home. Officers spoke to the parents who declined any additional assistance.

### September 4, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the area of US 33/Riverside Dr and Henderson Road on a blocking disabled vehicle. Officers arrived and a tow truck was already on scene assisting the motorist. Officers stood by until the vehicle was safely removed.

### September 4, 2020

The Columbus Police Department was not responding to non-injury crashes at that time.
