Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of October 2020

October 1, 2020

Officers responded to Worthington Hills Country Club on an alarm drop. The Officers found employees clocking into work. They made contact with the individual who set it off who set it off accidentally.

October 1, 2020

Officers responded to an alarm drop at the 3400 block of Woodview. The officers spoke with the homeowner who stated that he accidentally set it off.

October 2, 2020

Officers responded to an alarm drop at the 7900 block of Fairway Drive. The officers found the garage door open and checked the interior of the house and found the home to be vacant and with no signs of forced entry. The Officers secured the garage door and while writing their report the home owner arrived home and stated that she was in a hurry a must have forgot to close the garage door.
