Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township  
**Month of November 2020**

**November 1, 2020**

Officers were dispatched to the 3400 block of Henderson Rd on an injured deer in need of being put down. Officers arrived and determined the deer was badly injured and did in fact need to be dispatched to stop its suffering. The next person on deer pick up list was contacted and arrived shortly after.

**November 2, 2020**

Officers were dispatched to 2700 block of May Ct on a follow up for Hilliard Police. Officers arrived and spoke to the home owner and passed on the required information to Hilliard Police Department as requested.

**November 2, 2020**

Officers were dispatched to the area of 8500 block of Sawmill Rd on a suspicious person. Officers arrived and made contact with a male who was identified as an AEP subcontractor. He was permitted to stay on property.

**November 3, 2020**
