Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of December 2020

December 1, 2020

Officers responded to the area of 315 and 161 on an auto accident to assist Sharon Township. The Sharon officer advised there were no injuries.

December 1, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Drive and Henderson Road on a panhandler. Officers checked the area and found no one matching the description.

December 2, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 5000 block of Henderson Road on an alarm drop. The Officers checked the exterior doors and windows and all were found to be locked and secured.

December 2, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 1800 block of West Case on an auto accident. The accident was determined to be in the Columbus Police Department's jurisdiction. While at the scene an Officer got hurt moving a guardrail.
