Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of December 2018

December 1, 2018

An Officer on patrol in the 7000 block of Sawmill Road noticed a vehicle stopped at the entrance of Perry Township Headquarters and stopped to check on the driver. The driver stated the lug nuts on the tire had come loose. The Officer assisted with tightening the lug nuts so the driver could safely drive to the location that had just serviced the car.

December 1, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of US 33/ Riverside Drive and West Case Road on report of a crash into the trees. Officers arrived and searched the area but were unable to locate a crash or any evidence that a crash had occurred. The Officers checked the trails along the river and did locate a vehicle matching the description given and the driver explained they were fine and that no crash had occurred-they were just driving the trails for fun.

December 1, 2018

An Officer was dispatched to Perry Township Headquarters to complete a vehicle release request for a vehicle owner that had his car towed after a crash to Capital towing. The Officer was able to make contact with Capital to have the vehicle contents released after verifying it was not supposed to have been placed on a hold.

December 1, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2700 block of Snouffer Road on a barking dog complaint. Contact was made with the owner and they brought the dog inside until it calmed.

December 2, 2018

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of US 33/ Riverside Dr and Lane Ave for an expired registration violation. During the course of the traffic stop the woman began to have an anxiety attack so the Officer requested medics and a supervisor to respond. When the medics arrived, she declined medical attention and was then released.

December 2, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Olde Hill Court South on a domestic dispute. The argument was between adult siblings and was all verbal with no violence. Officers resolved the issue to the degree it could be for the day and refer the parties to Franklin County Municipal Court for further action.

December 4, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Clubview North on an alarm drop. Officers found the basement door unlocked. They checked the basement and found it clear. They did not check the upstairs due to a large, not so friendly dog being in the residence. Officers checked the exterior and cleared.

December 5, 2018

An Officer made a traffic stop at Clubview and Candlewood. It was determined that the driver had a suspended license. The driver was cited for driving under suspension, no seat belt, no operator's license, and failure to signal. She was summoned into court. The vehicle was impounded by Capital Towing for safe keeping.

December 6, 2018

Officer was dispatched to Riverside Dr. and West Case Rd. on a disabled vehicle. The Officer assisted the driver by pushing it off the roadway. The Officer waited until help arrived.

December 6, 2018

An Officer took a theft report over the phone. A moving company was suppose to deliver items to her new home out of state but never showed up. The Officer advised the victim that a detective will follow up with her.

December 7, 2018

An Officer was flagged down by a resident stating their dogs were lost. The Officer was able to locate them and called the owners to pick them up.

December 7, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2700 block of West Dublin Granville on a report that a person had fallen. Medics were called to the scene. The individual was transported to Riverside Hospital for observation.

December 7, 2018

An Officer was dispatched to a Washington Twp address off of Cosgray Road to assist the Sheriff's Office on an alarm drop. When the Sheriff Deputy arrived on scene, both units checked the residence and found it to be secure. Both agencies cleared the house.

December 7, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of Candlewood to assist medics. The resident there fell out of her wheelchair.

December 7, 2018

An Officer made a traffic stop for a license plate violation. It was discovered that the driver had a suspended license. The driver was cited for driving with a suspended license, expired plates and no operator's license. The vehicle was driven away by the subject's mother.

December 8, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6000 block of McVey Boulevard on a residential alarm. Officers arrived on scene, checked the exterior of the home and found it to be secure.

December 8, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of Hayden Run Road and Riverside Drive on an injury accident involving multiple vehicles. Officers arrived on scene and located the accident just east of the intersection within the City of Columbus' jurisdiction. Columbus police was then requested to respond to the scene to complete an accident report.

December 8, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6000 block of McVey Boulevard on report of a damaged mailbox. The caller was a neighbor to the home with the damaged mailbox but the homeowner was out of town on this date. A separate neighbor did a temporary repair to the mailbox until the homeowner could return from vacation but the neighbors wanted to have a report filed.

December 9, 2018 A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and Pickforde Road after random registration check showed the owner having a suspended driver's license. The driver of the vehicle matched the description of the registered owner, but after the vehicle was stopped the driver was found to not be the registered owner. After further checking the actual driver's information, he was found to have a suspended driver's license as well. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

December 9, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of West Case Road and Godown Road for a speeding violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to not possess a driver's license from any State. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

December 10, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of Fishinger Road and Riverside Drive on two suspicious persons. The Officers arrived in the area but were unable to locate anyone matching the description given.

December 10, 2018

Officers were dispatched to assist the medic in the 6000 block of McVey Boulevard. Dispatch reported a female breathing, but unconscious and unable to wake up. Officers and medics arrived on scene and the woman was then transported by medics to a nearby hospital for evaluation and observation.

December 10, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the administrative building at Perry Township Police Headquarters concerning an elderly man in the lobby. Officers arrived and spoke with the man and it was determined the incident needing attention occurred within the City of Columbus Police jurisdiction. Columbus Police were then requested to respond to Perry Township Police Headquarters to assist the man from that point.

December 11, 2018

Officers were dispatched to Riverside Dr. and Bethel Road on a possible accident. When Officers arrived, there was no damage to either vehicle. Neither party wanted an accident report taken. Both drivers exchanged information

December 11, 2018

An Officer was behind a vehicle on Sawmill Road which was weaving from lane to lane. When the Officer made the stop, he found the person was having a medical emergency. Medics were called to the scene. The individual was transported to the hospital.

December 12, 2018

An Officer was dispatched to the 1200 block of Candlewood Drive on a juvenile complaint. Upon arrival at the school, the Officer spoke with a secretary who stated that a child's parent never called to report the student sick. The Officer went to a several places and located the family. The mother made contact with the school.

December 12, 2018

An individual called to report someone had entered his unlocked vehicle at the 6700 block of McVey Blvd. Some loose change was taken. There are no known suspects at this time.

December 12, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6500 of Estel on a theft. The caller stated that her eleven-year-old son watched a woman open some one's mail box and retrieved the mail. The woman then placed some of the mail back. The woman then ran to the 6600 block of Millbrae. The police were able to get a description of the offender but unable to locate.

December 13, 2018

Officer were dispatched to the 7100 block of Sawmill Rd to meet Dublin Police on a warrant arrest that they wanted to serve. The individual had a warrant through Perry Twp for driving with no license and expired plates. He was taken to the Franklin County Clerk's office where they posted bond.

December 13, 2018

Officers were dispatched to State Rt. 161 and Nicholas Dr. on an accident. When Officers arrived, both parties agreed to exchange information. Neither driver wanted an accident report filed. The Officer went back on patrol.

December 14, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2700 block of Snouffer Road on a domestic disturbance. Upon arrival they found the caller. Officers then located the primary aggressor and made an arrest for domestic violence.

December 15, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Drive and Hayden Road on report of a non-injury accident. Officers arrived on scene and spoke with all parties involved who had already exchanged information. They all stated a crash report was not requested at this time.

December 15, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2400 block of McVey Court on a 911 hang up call. Officers arrived on scene and made contact with the homeowner who stayed he accidentally hit the wrong button when trying to make a call. The home and everyone inside were spoken to and everyone appeared to be OK.

December 16, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1400 block of Oakbourne Dr on an assistance to the fire department on a strange odor of burning. Worthington Fire Department arrived on scene as well and investigated the odor.

December 16, 2018

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Snouffer Road and Linworth Road for an expired registration violation. After further checking the driver's information she was found to have a suspended driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

December 17, 2018

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Clubview Boulevard North and Park Ridge Drive after a random registration check showed the owner having an active warrant out of Perry Township. The woman was able to take care of the warrant by the online payment system at the patrol car. The woman was then released from scene.

December 18, 2018

An Officer was dispatched to the 1200 block of Candlewood on a well being check. Upon arrival the Officer spoke with the school principal, who states that a child has not been in school. The Officer spoke with the aunt of the child who stated the child is fine.

December 18, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 7900 block of Fairway on an alarm. The residence was checked and found to be secure.

December 19, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 7800 block of Olentangy River Road on a hold up alarm and assisted Sharon Twp Police. After investigating, it was determined everything was OK. The teller was playing with the alarm button.

December 19, 2018

An individual came to The Perry Twp Police Department to turn in money she found near Snouffer and Bride Water Blvd. Officers impounded the money and placed it in Property Locker # 2 for safe keeping. Two Sergeants counted the money to verify the amount.

December 20, 2018

An Officer was dispatched to headquarters to assist a victim of a hit skip accident. The Officer arrived and spoke with a Columbus woman who stated while traveling on US 33 her vehicle was struck by an unknown vehicle that did not stop. The woman does not want a crash report at this time but just wanted Officers to be aware.

December 20, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6000 block of Winston Court East on report of a missing juvenile. Officers arrived and gathered information concerning the juvenile who struggled with mental health issues. The juvenile was later located and transported to Children's hospital for an evaluation. There was an arrest and an ongoing investigation concerning her original disappearance.

December 21, 2018

An Officer working a special detail at the Worthington Hills Country Club was dispatched to respond inside to assist medics on report of a choking child. The Officer located the parents and child prior to medics' arrival. The child's obstruction was cleared already and was no longer choking. The parents advised a medic was no longer needed.

December 21, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of McVey Boulevard and Estel Road on a report of a person with a gun attempting to shoot at squirrels. The Officers arrived and searched the area but were unable to locate anyone matching the description given or anyone with any guns outside.

December 22, 2018

An Officer on patrol in the area of State Route 161 and Linworth Road came across evidence of a crash and a damaged utility pole in the area. The Officer was able to follow the debris to the United Dairy Farmers gas station. After speaking with the manager, he was told it happened overnight and that Columbus Police had responded. The Officer followed up with Columbus Police and was told a report was taken and the damaged utility pole was already reported to the proper utility company for repair.

December 22, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2600 block of McVey West on an assistance call to the medic. Officers arrived and spoke with the daughter of the homeowner who stated she wanted her mother transported to the hospital. Worthington medics arrived and transported the homeowner for observation.

December 23, 2018

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road and I-270 for an expired registration violation. After further reviewing the driver's information she was found to have a suspended driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

December 23, 2018

Officers were dispatched to US33 / Riverside Drive and West Case Road on a non-injury crash that was blocking the roadway. Officers arrived on scene and found a vehicle matching the description given that had not been involved in a crash but was in fact a disabled motorist. An Officer stayed on scene with the driver until assistance arrived and moved the vehicle off the roadway.

December 24, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Drive and Fishinger on a report of a drunk driver. Officers found and stopped the vehicle. There was no sign of impairment. The driver advised that his car was in an accident and needed an alignment.

December 25, 2018

Officers were dispatched to Riverside Drive and Hayden Run Road on an individual passed out behind the wheel. The medics checked him out and did not detect any odor of alcohol on his person nor did the police. The driver stated he was just tired.

December 26, 2018

An individual came in to the police department to claim money that he lost back on December 21. He said he forgot that he set the large amount of money on top of his truck and drove off. He was able to articulate the amount of money in the envelope, where he lost the money (same area where it was found) and describe the envelope the money was in. The Sergeant returned the money to him.

December 27, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of Hayden Run Rd and US 33 / Riverside Dr. on a report of a disabled vehicle. The Officer arrived on scene and located the car blocking the roadway west of US 33 / Riverside Dr within the City of Columbus jurisdiction. Columbus Police were notified but stated they would not be responding and requested the Officer lay flares and verify the owner had assistance on the way.

December 27, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6500 block of McVey Blvd on a suspicious person. Officers arrived and searched the area but were unable to locate anyone matching the description given. The caller refused to be seen by Officers.

December 27, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Scioto View Lane on an assistance to the fire department. A firefighter stated they had to make entry as a fire alarm was constantly going off. Once inside they found a faulty alarm. The homeowner who lives out of state requested the key from the realtor lock box be given to her realtor.

December 27, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of US 33/Riverside Dr. and Henderson Road on a blocking disabled vehicle. Officers arrived and were able to push the vehicle off the roadway to a safe location to where she could wait for her tow truck.

December 28, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the 2000 block of West Dublin Granville Road after a registration check showed the license plate as being reported stolen. The man admitted to finding the tag on the ground and attaching it to his vehicle with the intention of buying his own in a few weeks. The man was placed under arrest. He was charged and slated at the Franklin County Jail for multiple traffic violations, receiving stolen property and also had a valid warrant for his arrest.

December 28, 2018

An Officer on patrol in the 5000 block of US 33/ Riverside Dr came across an Upper Arlington Officer who was on a traffic stop. The Upper Arlington Officer requested mutual aid to assist with detaining other persons in the vehicle. After an Upper Arlington Sergeant, arrived the Officer cleared the scene.

December 30, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of US 33/Riverside Dr and Fishinger Rd for an equipment violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to not have a valid driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.
