Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of January 2018

January 1, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6800 block of Merwood Street on a call of a child locked inside of a running vehicle. When officers arrived on scene they found that the keys were in fact locked inside of the vehicle by the child and that their assistant was not needed.

January 1, 2018

A Westerville man was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and Godown Road after random registration check showed his driver's license was suspended. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court.

January 1, 2018

Officers were dispatched to assist Worthington Police on an alarm call in the 700 block of Lakeview plaza. Upon arrival it was determined that it was a cleaning crew with no code. Officers checked the building then went back on patrol.

January 2, 2018

Officers were dispatched to Brookside Country Club on an alarm call. Officers checked the building and found all windows and doors locked.

January 3, 2018

Officers responded to a disabled vehicle at the 5000 block of Riverside Drive. Upon arrival AAA was already with the vehicle. Officer waited for the vehicle to be loaded up then went back on patrol.

January 4, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of US 33/ Riverside Drive and Lane Avenue on a report of blocking non-injury crash. When officers arrived, they located the crash within Upper Arlington Police jurisdiction. An officer was requested from Upper Arlington to respond.

January 5, 2018

A Columbus woman was stopped in the 900 block of Bethel Road for an equipment violation. After further checking the driver's information she was found to have a suspended driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to court.

January 5, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Crier Road and Sawmill Road for an equipment violation. After further checking the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license and the BMV revoked his registration privileges. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court and the license plates were sent back to the BMV.

January 5, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2700 block of Snouffer Road on a domestic dispute. Officers arrived on scene and found a father and son having a verbal disagreement. Officers were able to assist the family with a resolution for the evening.

January 6, 2018

An officer patrolling in the area of US 33 / Riverside Drive and Henderson Road assisted a stranded motorist with his disabled vehicle and a tow company to get him to the nearest repair shop.

January 6, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of West Dublin Granville Road on a suspicious person walking in the roadway. Officers, who were already in the area, checked the area but were unable to find anyone matching the description given.

January 6, 2018

An Officer patrolling the 1800 block of West Dublin Granville Road assisted three non blocking vehicles on the side of the road. It was determined that two of the vehicles were there assisting their mother who blew out a tire and was waiting on AAA.

January 6, 2018

Officers were dispatched to US 33 / Riverside Drive and Lane Avenue on a tire in the roadway. Officers arrived on scene and found the tire but also found a disabled vehicle on Lane Avenue just east of where the tire was located within Upper Arlington Police jurisdiction. An Upper Arlington officer was requested to respond to assist with the stranded motorist.

January 6, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Circle On The Green on a residential alarm with glass break included. Officers arrived, checked the exterior of the home and did not find any signs of forced entry. The homeowner then arrived and officers were able to check the interior and found no signs of disruption

January 6, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped and arrested for operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol and / or drugs after he was observed failing to maintain his lane of travel and several other traffic violations. After further review of the driver's information he was found to also have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court to a responsible person.

January 8, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6500 Block of McVey Blvd on a suspicious vehicle. Officers arrived and the home owner stated a van backed into her driveway that she did not recognize so she took a picture of the license plate to show officers and pass on the info just in case. Officers took the information and documented it for future reference.

January 8, 2018

Officers were dispatched to US 33 and Nottingham Drive on a blocking disabled vehicle. Officers arrived on scene and the owner told the Officer he had a tow truck already in route. He requested the Officer push him out of the roadway.

January 11, 2018

A Columbus Officer reported seeing a suspicious person biking around Township building #1. He then noticed the same person take off running across the street to an unknown location. He found the bike ditched behind the building. The bike was taken in to property for safekeeping.

January 11, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6000 block of McVey Blvd on a residential alarm. Officers arrived on scene and found the home to be secure.

January 11, 2018

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road and 270 for an expired registration violation. After further checking the driver's information she was found to have a suspended license and an active warrant for her arrest. The woman was cited and transported to Franklin County Clerk's Office to post bond on her warrant and then released with a summons for court.

January 11, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1100 block of Clubview Boulevard North on a residential alarm. Officers arrived on scene, checked the exterior of the home and found a rear door to be open and some damage on the door frame area. The homeowner arrived on scene and confirmed that the damage was old damage and someone must have forgotten to lock the rear door.

January 12, 2018

Officers were dispatched to US 33 and Canterbury Drive on a disabled vehicle. Officers arrived on scene and found a vehicle partially in a ditch. The owner requested Officers attempt to push the vehicle out of the ditch. The attempt was unsuccessful and Capital Towing was called at the request of the vehicle owner. Officers stood by until the tow truck arrived.

January 12, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 8000 block of Golfview Court on a 911 hang up call. When Officers arrived on scene, they spoke with the resident who stated it was accidental and everything at the home was okay.

January 12, 2018

A Columbus man was arrested for operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol after being stopped for driving on the wrong side of the road and crashing in the 1800 block of Bethel Road. The man was transported to the Franklin County Jail and slated on several traffic violations and operating under the influence of alcohol.

January 13, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2400 block of Summit View Boulevard on a disabled vehicle. Officers arrived on scene and found a United States Postal vehicle that was already being towed by Rusty's Towing.

January 13, 2018

Officers were requested to assist Sharon Township Police Department and check on a stranded motorist in the area State Route 315 and Bethel Road. Sharon Township was concerned due to reports of a female being inside the car. Officers arrived and found the vehicle unoccupied and in the ditch but not blocking.

January 13, 2018

Officers on regular Patrol in the area of State Route 315 and Bethel Road came across a two-vehicle accident that occurred within Sharon Township Police Department jurisdiction. A request for a Sharon Township officer to respond for the crash report was made. Officers stood by until Sharon Township Officers arrived.

January 13, 2018

Columbus Police Department requested a BAC certified operator to run a test on an individual suspected of driving under the influence of alcohol. The Officer arrived at headquarters and performed the test. The individual was found to be over the limit and Columbus Police charged him with the appropriate citations.

January 14, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bent Tree Boulevard and Federated Boulevard after failing to stop for a red light. After further checking the driver's information he was found to not have a valid driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court.

January 18, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Drive and Zollinger Road on an injury crash. Once on scene they found a vehicle off the roadway stuck in a snow bank that had swerved to avoid collision with another driver who spun out in the roadway. The driver was not injured and had a tow truck already in route. The Officer left information for the driver to call if the tow truck needed additional assistance while retrieving the vehicle.

January 19, 2018

Officers assisted a stranded motorist with a dead battery in the area of Riverside Drive and West Case Road.

January 19, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Scioto View Dr on a stolen vehicle. Once on scene the caller explained that she spoke to her bank and they informed her they had repossessed the vehicle. While there the caller gave the Officers a copy of a new restraining order against her ex husband, which was brought back to Police headquarters.

January 20, 2018

Officers were requested to contact the owner of a home the 2400 block of West Dublin Granville Road that is currently vacant. The owner stated that persons unknown have been entering the unoccupied home and squatting on multiple occasions. He stated his maintenance man has repaired the rear window and door in an attempt to keep them out. He requested extra patrol until new renters can be found.

January 20, 2018

Ohio Homeland Security requested mutual aid to respond to Beightler Armory to sweep with a K9 unit for possible explosives. No alerts were made inside or outside the premises

January 20, 2018

Officers responded to the area of Bethel Road and Kenny Road after a passerby flagged down an Officer stating that a man was walking in the middle of the road carrying a female over his shoulder. He stated the man dropped her and then picked her up and threw her over his shoulder then continued walking. Officers arrived and found the female to be unharmed. Officers requested Columbus Police to respond as this was within their jurisdiction. The man and woman were then released to Columbus Police.

January 21, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6800 block of Merwood Road to assist with a lockout. Once on scene the vehicle owner was verified thru registration. The car door was unlocked and the keys turned over to her at the owner's request.

January 22, 2018

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road and Snouffer Road for an expired registration violation. After further checking the driver's information she was found to have a suspended driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to court.

January 22, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of W Dublin Granville Road and Linworth Road on a very large pothole that had caused a flat tire and damage to the owners rim. A report was taken as requested by the vehicle owner and the road department was called to fill the hole.

January 22, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Snouffer Place on a suspicious person in a backyard. Officers arrived and searched the area but were unable to locate anyone matching the description given.

January 22, 2018

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Riverside Drive and Lane Avenue for a speed violation. After further checking the driver's information she was found not to have ever had a license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to court.

January 23, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1100 block of Circle on the Green to assist Medics with lifting a patient.

January 23, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6000 block of Merwin Place on a theft from a motor vehicle. Items taken were valued at approximately \$3,056.00. There are no known suspects at this time.

January 24, 2018

Officers conducted a traffic stop at Sawmill and 270. It was determined that the owner was driving on a suspended license. He was cited for no operator's license, failure to reinstate, and no seatbelt.

January 25, 2018

Officers responded to a crash at 161 and Linworth Road. Neither party involved in the crash could be located. Dispatch advised that they left the scene.

January 25, 2018

Officers made a traffic stop in the area of Sawmill and Sawbury. It was determined that the owner was driving on a suspended license. The driver was cited for No operator's license, Expired Plates, and Driving under Suspension.

January 26, 2018

Officers responded to a call in the 2500 of Shoreline Drive on an individual who was suicidal because of her past. This was called in by her mother. Before officers arrived the mother found her daughter on a hammock enjoying the day with no thoughts of suicide. Officers went back on patrol.

January 27, 2018

Officers were driving north on 315 and noticed a vehicle with its flashers on. It was determined that the car had crashed just south of the Worthington police jurisdiction and Columbus police was dispatched to take the report. It should be noted that no one was found in or near the vehicle.

January 28, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of Bride Water Boulevard and Snouffer Road on report of a driver unconscious behind the wheel and a passenger semi-conscious with hypodermic needles in plain view. Officers arrived and administered multiple doses of Narcan and were able to revive the driver. Medics arrived on scene and transported both people to the hospital.

January 28, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 8000 block of Markhaven Drive on a shots fired complaint coming from the woods. Officers arrived and spoke with a witness who was able to tell officers a description of three males who came out of the woods and an address that they went to. Officers made contact with the homeowner who stated his son admitted to shooting a shotgun that he purchased that same day. That shotgun was turned over to officers for safekeeping as the homeowner stated he did not want it in his home as of right now.

January 28, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of McVey Boulevard West on a suspicious person and vehicle. Officers arrived and searched the area but were unable to locate a vehicle or suspects matching the description given.

January 29, 2018

An officer was dispatched to meet with Worthington Police Department to pick up a Columbus man with an active warrant out of Perry Township for failure to appear. The officer took the man into custody and transported him to Franklin County Municipal Court where he posted bond, given a new court date and then released.

January 30, 2018

Officers were dispatched to Riverside and W Case on an auto accident. Upon arrival, Officers spoke with one of the drivers who stated that both parties agreed to exchange information. The officer went back on patrol.

January 30, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 5600 block of Riverside Drive on a possible sex abuse of a child. Officers knocked on the door to no avail. At this time there is no evidence that the individual police are looking for lives there or has any connection to the address. The report will be turned in to the detective bureau for follow up.

January 30, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 8000 block of Evangeline on a theft. Upon arrival it was discovered that a Huntington credit card was used to purchase many items which the victim states they did not make. There are no known suspects at this time.

January 30, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Highview on a fraud. Upon arrival, the victim states that someone tried to use her name to open an AT&T account with a bogus address in Detroit Michigan. At this time there has been no loss of funds. Paperwork was sent to the victim to fill out and return.

January 31, 2018

Officers were flagged down by a concerned citizen about a neighbors' well-being. Officers went to the 1300 block of Candlewood Drive to check on the individual. All checked fine and the officers went back on patrol.

January 31, 2018

Officers were flagged down in the 900 block of Clubview south by a citizen who locked her keys in the car. The officer was successful in gaining entry.
