Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of February 2018

February 1, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 7000 block of Candlewood Lane on a theft from a motor vehicle. It was discovered that a backpack was stolen from an unlocked vehicle during the night hours.

February 1, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1600 block of Pendennis Ct on a theft from a motor vehicle. A neighbor called and said they found various business cards, ID cards and wallet. Officers went to the house where items were stolen from and spoke with the resident, who states that her husband must have forgot to lock his vehicle at night.

February 1, 2018

Various items that were previously stolen from vehicles were located in the 1100 block of Clubview North.

February 1, 2018

Officer was dispatched to the 1000 block of Clubview south where the victim states that her vehicle was gone through the previous night. At this time nothing was found missing.

February 1, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 8000 block of Copperfield on a theft from a motor vehicle. Victim states that her vehicles were left unlocked and miscellaneous gift cards were missing.

February 3, 2018

Officers came across a disabled vehicle at Riverside and Lane Ave. The individual ran out of gas. The officers waited until his help arrived then cleared the scene.

February 3, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6000 block of McVey Blvd on an attempted burglary. February 3, 2018

Officers arrived at the 2500 block of Bethel Road to serve a warrant. Officers made the arrest. The suspect was transported to Franklin County Clerk of Courts to post an appearance bond. Her court date had not been scheduled yet. Officers went back on patrol.

February 4, 2018

Officer was dispatched to the 1000 block of Clubview N on a theft from a motor vehicle. Upon arrival the officer spoke with the resident who states that an unknown person entered his unlocked Ford truck and removed items. There are no suspects at this time.

February 4, 2018

February 5, 2018

February 5, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 5000 block of Henderson Heights on a domestic dispute. Upon arrival, officers spoke with both mother and daughter who were having an argument. Both parties were calm when officers arrived. The mother called the police to deescalate the situation. There were no signs of violence.

February 9, 2018

An officer was dispatched to the 2700 block of West Dublin Granville Road on an alarm drop. Upon arrival the officer spoke with an employee who states that the cleaning crew had just left and believes it was them who left the door unlocked. A check was made in the building and nothing seemed out of the ordinary. The employee turned the alarm off and the officer went back on patrol.

When officers arrived they spoke with the resident who states that a former roommate was going to come over and move back in with his girlfriend until they get evicted. The officer advised that is not a threat. She then called back and said he will be working with a pastor.

February 10, 2018
