Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of April 2018

April 2, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Circle on the Green on a residential alarm. Officers arrived on scene found no one home and all the doors to be secure.

April 2, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of US33/ Riverside Drive and Fishinger Road on a blocking disabled vehicle. As Officers arrived, there was a tow truck with a vehicle already hooked up and ready to depart. The Officer then directed traffic to allow the tow truck driver to leave.

April 3, 2018

An officer on patrol in the area of Sawmill Road and Cranston Road came across a non-injury multi-vehicle accident. The officer assisted with clearing the main roadway so that traffic could continue to move. The crash occurred within city of Columbus limits so the Officer notified CPD that the drivers would be exchanging information and filing a report at a later date.

April 3, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Fairway Drive on a residential alarm. When an Officer arrived on scene they spoke with a cleaning service that was there to clean the home; they stated they put the wrong code in the keypad.

April 3, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6500 block of McVey Boulevard on a suspicious vehicle parked & occupants taking pictures of homes. Officers arrived and searched in the area but did not find any vehicles matching the description given.

April 4, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road and Snouffer Road after random registration check returned showing the owner having an expired license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court.

April 4, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Larkstone Dr and Linworth Road after following too close to the vehicle in front of him. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to be an unlicensed driver. The driver's mother also knew he was an unlicensed driver and allowed him to drive. The mother, a Columbus woman, was then cited for wrongful entrustment and the man was cited and released on a summons to court as well.

April 4, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1500 Block of Blackstone Drive on a residential alarm. Officers arrived and checked the exterior of the home and found no signs of forced entry and all to be secure.

April 4, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Blindbrook Drive on a possible sexually-oriented crime involving a minor. A report was taken at the scene and an investigation is currently pending.

April 5, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Kenny Road and Bethel Road for a license plate violation. After further checking the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court.

April 5, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of 1400 Oakbourne Dr to speak with the driver of a vehicle register to that address. It was reported that a man almost struck a pedestrian and a parked car. After speaking to the man and explaining to him why the officer was called to his home the officer was able to determine the man OK.

April 6, 2018

After warrant verification check, a Columbus woman was placed under arrest for an active warrant out of Perry Township. She was transported to Franklin county Clerk's office to pay out and receive a new court date.

April 7, 2018

An Officer made a traffic stop for expired plates. It was discovered that the driver had a suspended license and two traffic warrants. She was taken into custody and transported to the clerk's office where she paid her fines and warrants. Her vehicle was impounded by Capital Towing. She was given a court date for her violations.

April 8, 2018

The man was stopped in the area of US 33 and Old Bethel Road for multiple equipment violations. After further checking the driver's information he was found to have an expired license that expired less than 6 months prior. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court.

April 8, 2018

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and Dierker Road for a tail light violation. After further checking the driver's information she was found to not have a driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to court.

April 9, 2018

An Officer on patrol in the area of US 33 Riverside Drive near Hayden Run Road assisted a stranded motorist who had run out of gas.

April 9, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the Worthington Hills Elementary School on a 911 hang up call. When officers arrived on scene it was determined that a teacher accidentally called when attempting to get an outside line that required her to push 9 first.

April 9, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of West Dublin Granville Road on report of a non-injury accident. When officers arrived on scene they spoke with two separate drivers who stated it was a rear-end accident with very little if any damage. The victim declined a crash report.

April 10, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of Riverside Drive a report of a domestic incident. When officers arrived they spoke with the homeowners who stated they were involved in a verbal argument and nothing further. One party had already decided to leave for the night. Officers remained in the area for short time afterwards to ensure tranquility.

April 10, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of Candlewood Drive on a criminal mischief. Upon arrival the home owner stated that unknown person(s) entered his unlocked vehicle but did not remove anything from his vehicle.

April 10, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1400 block of Oakbourne on a theft from a motor vehicle. Upon arrival officers spoke with the homeowner who states that someone entered his unlocked vehicle and removed a wallet containing a drivers license and credit cards. There are no suspects at this time.

April 10, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1900 block of Blindbrook on recovered property. The homeowner wanted to turn in a pellet gun he ran over in the middle of the road.

April 10, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1600 block of Crusoe Drive on a theft from motor vehicle. The homeowner stated that he left his vehicle unlocked at night and had thirty dollars stolen from his vehicle.

April 10, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 8000 block of Copperfield on a theft from a motor vehicle. Upon arrival the home owner stated that a piggy bank containing ten dollars was stolen along with tools worth fifty dollars. There are no known suspects at this time.

April 10, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Circle on the Green on a loud music complaint. Upon arrival Officers did not hear any loud music. Officers then spoke with the home owners, who stated that the band has been playing for ten years and has not had a complaint until the new neighbors moved in. This is the eighth time that officers had been dispatched there.

April 10, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 5000 block of Charlbury on a vandalism report. Upon arrival Officers found tires ruts in the caller's yard. The suspect vehicle had left the scene before the police arrived.

April 10, 2018

An Officer stopped a vehicle for expired plates. It was discovered that the drivers' license had expired less than six months. The driver was charged with expired plates and not having a valid license. The vehicle was driven away by a friend.

April 12, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 3000 block of Greenvale Drive on a residential alarm. When Officers arrived the homeowner was standing in the driveway stating the alarm company called and she came home and had not been in the home yet. The officers went in and searched the home and determined it to be clear. The alarm appeared to come from the wind pushing the doors.

April 12, 2018

Officers were dispatched to US 33/ Riverside Drive and West Case road on the suspicious motorcycle lying in the trees. When officers arrived on scene they found the motorcycle with no one around. A search of the wooded area was completed and no one was found. A check of crisscross was attempted to finding a phone number to contact the register owner, but it was unlisted. Capital towing was contacted to impound the motorcycle for safekeeping and the information was passed on Franklin County to be entered in as a towed vehicle.

April 12, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 3500 block of Skyline Dr on a suspicious vehicle. Officers arrived and searched the area for several minutes but did not find any vehicles matching the given description.

April 12, 2018

A Powell man was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road and I-270 after random registration check showed the owner having a suspended driver's license. The registered owner was able to provide documentation showing his suspension being placed in stayed status in court. As communication was happening with the driver, the Officer detected the odor of marijuana. The man was subsequently arrested for possession of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia. He was then summons to court on the charges and released at the scene.

April 12, 2018

An officer was flagged down while on patrol in the 8100 block of Fairway Boulevard. It was reported to the Officer that a few nights prior an unknown person cut down the basketball net off the basketball hoop in her driveway. No other damage was reported on their property.

April 13, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 7800 block of Flint Road on a mutual Aid request from Sharon Township Police Department. They were responding to assist paramedics with an ill person and another with unexplained injuries.

April 14, 2018

An Officer on patrol in the area of Riverside Drive and Nottingham Road observed a motorcycle driving at excessive speeds. He attempted to stop the motorcycle who then continued to speed up and the Officer eventually lost sight. A short time later, the Officer saw the same motorcycle in the area of Sawmill Road near Cranston Road and attempted to get in behind the motorcycle to make a stop but the driver turned on a side road prior to the officer being able to and again lost sight of the motorcycle. The Officer was unable to get close enough to observe a license plate. This information was passed on to the Officers on the next shifts.

April 15, 2018

A Galena man was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road and Henderson Road for an equipment violation. After further checking the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court.

April 15, 2018

An officer was dispatched to the area of State Route 161 and the railroad tracks on a malfunctioning traffic signal. The officer arrived and observed that the signal was functioning properly. The officer stayed at the intersection for an extended period of time just to verify and observed no traffic signal problems.

April 15, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of Candlewood Drive on a residential alarm. Officers arrived on scene checked all exterior doors and windows and found the home to be secure.

April 15, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1400 block of Oakview Drive on a residential alarm. Officers arrived on scene and found no signs of forced entry. They checked all windows and doors and found the home to be secure.

April 16, 2018

Officers were dispatched on multiple calls throughout the night to Brookside Country Club on a business alarm drop. On each occasion the Officers arrived on scene and checked all the windows and doors which were found to be secure.

April 16, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of Park Ridge Drive and Fairway Drive on report of a suspicious vehicle. Officers arrived and searched the area but did not find any vehicle or person matching the description given.

April 17, 2018

A Columbus teen was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road and Sawbury Boulevard for an equipment violation. After further checking the driver's information he was found to not have a driver's license. The teen was then cited and released to an adult on a summons to juvenile court.

April 17, 2018

Officer made a traffic stop at McVey and Millbrae for expired plates. Upon further checking it was discovered that the driver's license had also expired. The driver was cited for both violations.

April 17, 2018

An individual stopped into Perry Township Police Department headquarters and stated he found two wallets with various items inside of them while he was at the park on April 15 but had not had time to bring it in the police department until now. The property was impounded for safe keeping.

April 17, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 8000 block of Fairway Drive on a call of two suspicious people in the area. Upon arrival the resident stated that two men came to their door and stated they were police officers. Neither man was in any type of uniform but they did have badges. They showed the resident a picture of a person they were looking for. Considering it took place at 9:30pm, the residents found it very odd and called Perry Twp police to investigate. Police patrolled the area but could not locate the two men.

April 17, 2018

An Officer observed a vehicle traveling with no headlights on and made a traffic stop after that vehicle was involved in a crash. Both vehicles exchanged information. The original targeted vehicle was cited for not having lights.

April 17, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Winston Court N on a suicidal individual. Upon arrival Officers spoke with the resident, who states that an individual wanted to harm themselves and others. The resident showed the officer a series of text messages from an individual who had stated they wanted to harm themselves. Officers went to the last known address where the suspect lived. Officers spoke with family members who state they have not seen him in months. The investigation was turned over to Columbus Police since it occurred in their jurisdiction.

April 19, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of Snouffer Road and the railroad tracks on a non-injury accident. When officer arrived on scene the parties decided to exchange information instead of filing an accident report.

April 19, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Drive and Palatas Place on report of a non-injury accident. The Officer arrived on scene and took an accident report. The at fault vehicle driver's information was checked and he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The driver was then cited and released on a summons to court.

April 19, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Riverside Drive and Lane Avenue for speeding violation. After further checking the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license then man was then cited and released on a summons to court.

April 20, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of McVey Boulevard on an animal complaint. The officer arrived on scene and spoke with the caller who stated his dog was attacked by his neighbor's dog because it was not on a leash. The resident also stated they did not want any action taken other than an officer to speak with them. The officer was able to come to a resolution between the two neighbors, which included advising the possible consequences for failure to control their animals.

April 20, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Riverside Drive at Henderson Road for an expired registration violation. The driver was unable to furnish a driver's license and the officer was unable to find any record with dispatchers matching the driver's information. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court.

April 20, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6500 block of Riverside Drive at the Marriott Hotel to assist Dublin Police with a possible drug issue within one of the rooms. Officers arrived on scene & met up with the Dublin officer and all officers proceeded to the room in question. After speaking to everyone in the room and checking for warrants, Officers were able to determine no arrestable offenses were occurring at that time. The hotel management requested all persons be removed from the property. Officers stood by until everyone in the room could gather their belongings and exit the hotel to wait for a cab.

April 22, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and Jasonway Blvd after a random registration check showed the owner as having an expired driver's license. The driver matched the description of the registered owner and after verifying the driver was the registered owner he was cited and released on a summons to court.

April 22, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Hard Road and Silver Fox Drive for speed violation. As the officer was making contact with the driver, a strong odor of marijuana was detected. After search of the vehicle was done several drug paraphernalia items and marijuana was found. The driver was then cited and released on summons to court for traffic and drug offenses.

April 22, 2018

An officer while on patrol in the area of Sawmill Road and Reflections Drive came across an accident that was determined to have injuries. Medics were requested to respond and the Columbus Police department was called as the accident occurred within their jurisdiction. The officer secured the scene until Columbus Police arrived.

Officers were dispatched to the 1500 Block of Blackstone Drive on report of a suspicious vehicle and suspicious persons around their home. Officers arrived in the area and located a van matching the description given. Officers were able to determine all involved parties were high school students participating in an activity known as senior tag. No criminal violations were found at this time so everyone's information was gathered just in case any damages are noticed at a later date. The driver and the occupants were then released.

April 23, 2018

An officer was flagged down about an accident in the UDF lot at Linworth and 161. The officer notified Columbus Police since it occurred in their jurisdiction.

Officers were dispatched to Riverside and Hayden Run on a disabled vehicle. The vehicle was cooling down when officers arrived. The car was then able to operate and drove away.

Officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of Beechlake Drive on a 911 hang up. Upon arrival they were met by the mother who said her adult son was having a syncopal episode and fainted, hitting his head on the counter. The individual refused a medic. He was advised to call medics if he experienced any symptoms related to the fall.

April 26, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 5300 block of Riverside Drive on a report of shots fired in the area. Officers arrived on scene and immediately started circulating thru the area. Officers did not hear any gunshots being fired in the area or anything resembling the sound of gunshots. Officers also spoke with several residents in the parking lot who stated they did not hear anything that sounded like gunshots in the last few minutes.

April 26, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of US 33 / Riverside Drive and Lane Avenue for a speed violation. After further checking the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released to a valid driver on a summons to court.

April 26, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2600 block of Darwin Road on a residential alarm. Officers arrived on scene and were met by a family caretaker who forgot the alarm code. The woman was there tidying up while the resident is currently in the hospital. The woman agreed to lock up the home until she picked up the resident from the hospital since the alarm automatically resets and would eventually be set off again.

Officers were dispatched to the 1400 block of Hickory Ridge on a residential alarm. Officers arrived and located the son of the homeowner working on the home. Officers were able to contact the homeowner who verified their son was authorized to be at the home to complete the repair.

April 27, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Henderson Road and Sawmill Road for an expired registration. After further checking the driver's information his driver's license was suspended for failure to reinstate. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court with a valid driver.

April 27, 2018

A Columbus juvenile was stopped in the area of Summit View Road and Shillington Road for a stop sign violation. The officer was able to detect an odor of marijuana coming from the car. Based on this observation the officer completed a search of the vehicle and found drug paraphernalia, a baggie that had remnants of marijuana in it along with a measurement scale. The juvenile's parents were contacted after the juvenile was placed under arrest. The Juvenile was then transported to police headquarters, cited and released to his parents on a summons to juvenile court.

April 28, 2018

An Officer on patrol in the area of Brookside Estates was flagged down by a resident. The resident stated that he was concerned about his neighbor after his inability to contact him. The officer attempted contact by knocking on the door; when no one answered he checked the door and found it unlocked. The Officer was able to go in and found the homeowner asleep on the couch and he woke up and stated he was fine.

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road and Cranston Drive for an expired registration violation. After further checking the driver's information he was found to have no driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court.
