Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township  
Month of May 2018

### **May 1, 2018**

An Officer was dispatched to St. Peter's Church on Smoky Row on a well being check. An individual there stated that he was from Kansas and meeting someone one to give them \$2000.00. It was determined that it was a scam and no money was sent.

### **May 1, 2018**

An Officer made a traffic stop for a u-turn violation. It was discovered that the driver had no license. Both the driver and the individual who let him borrow the vehicle were cited and released on a summons to court.

### **May 1, 2018**

An officer entered a registration of the vehicle in front of him. The owner can back with just an ID card. The car was stopped and found to be operated by the registered owner. He was cited for not having a valid driver's license. The owner's brother came to drive the vehicle away.

### **May 1, 2018**

An Officer made a traffic stop near Sawmill Rd and Abbey Church. It was discovered the individual owed a reinstatement fee. While the officer was writing the citation, they had already paid the fee and they were valid again. The officer cited her for driving under suspension, no license and failure to display.

### **May 1, 2018**

An Officer made a traffic stop for not having a visible plate and illegal window tint. During the stop it was determined that the driver's driving privileges were suspended. The driver was cited for the window tint violation, driving under suspension, and not having a valid license.

### **May 3, 2018**

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road and West Case Road for an expired registration violation. After further reviewing the driver's information she was found to have a suspended driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to court.

### **May 3, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area Sawmill Road and West Dublin Granville Road after a random registration check revealed a drivers license suspension on the registered owner. The driver of the vehicle matched the description of the registered owner. After a traffic stop was initiated, the driver's identity was verified as the registered owner. He was then cited and released on a summons to court.

**May 4, 2018**

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road and Bethel Road for headlight violation after sunset. After further reviewing the driver's information she was found to have a suspended driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to court.

**May 4, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the area of Clubview Boulevard South and State Route 315 on a possible drunk driver. A Sharon Township Officer was already in the area and able to locate the vehicle which was northbound on State Route 315 nearing the county line. The Sharon Township officer was doing field sobriety test when Perry Township officers arrived in the area. Sharon Township Police subsequently arrested the driver for OVI.

**May 4, 2018**

An officer on patrol in the 3000 block of Riverside Drive was flagged down by a Columbus man. The man reported that his 16 year old daughter, who is suffering from depression, made suicidal threats and he was now unable to locate her. Officers from Columbus Police Department and Perry Township Police Department searched the surrounding areas of US 33/Riverside Drive and west of the Scioto River. The search was unsuccessful and using the iPhone app to locate the last known location for the 16 year old was further away in the city of Columbus. CPD officers radioed the information and took a missing persons report at that time.

**May 4, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of Scioto View Lane on a report of suspicious person and vehicle. The caller stated a female was looking in windows and when questioned stated she was looking for someone and had the wrong apartment. Officers arrived in the area and spoke with the caller and several other residents nearby. They all stated the female got into a white van, circled around the area and disappeared. One of the residents pointed out an area where he saw a white male going back and forth and he did not look to be a maintenance man and was not carrying any tools. The officers went over to that area and did find a man crouched down doing something on the ground. The man was then temporarily detained for further investigation. After attempting to identify the subject he was found to have given incorrect information to avoid arrest and subsequently arrested for obstruction of official business. After being placed under arrest he was then searched and many different identifications cards and social security cards were found on his person along with large amounts of foreign currency, jewelry, pocket knives and other valuables. These items were later determined to all be stolen property. As the officers were dealing with the male suspect, the white van, driven by the female, drove past their location. She was stopped and determined to be associated with the male who was now arrested, and the van was also determined to be stolen. Both the male and female were arrested and slated for receiving stolen property and obstruction of official business.

**May 4, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Scioto View Lane on a report of property that was recovered in the area. The officer arrived on scene and spoke with the caller who stated she saw officers earlier in the day doing something and when she went around her condo she found a laptop and a bag behind her air conditioning/heat pump. The property was determined to be connected to an earlier burglary thru stolen property reports.

**May 4, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Scioto View Lane on report of a burglary. The caller stated an unknown person broke through her back door. When the officers arrived on scene, the victim was able to produce a video from her home security camera showing the suspects that broke into her home. Based on the security camera footage, officers were able to determine the suspects that were arrested earlier in the day for receiving stolen property and the stolen vehicle were also linked to this burglary and the property that was found abandoned that same day.

**May 5, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 8000 block of Golfview Court on report a suspicious person knocking on their front door. Officer arrived in the area and were unable to locate anyone on foot or knocking on doors. The officers circulated the area for a while to ensure they did not overlook anyone.

**May 5, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of West Dublin Granville Road at the Brookside Country Club on a business alarm. When officers arrived they were met by the tennis manager who stated that the door was not secured properly when they were checking doors. It was then secured before all employees and the officers left the scene.

**May 5, 2018**

A Dublin man was stopped in the area of Smokey Row and Slaton Court for an expired registration violation. While speaking with the driver, he advised the officer that he did not have a driver's license in Ohio, only an identification card. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court.

**May 5, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 6700 block of McVey Boulevard on report of suspicious person walking a dog through their backyard. Officers arrived in the area and were unable to locate a person matching the description given.

**May 5, 2018**

A Spanish-speaking officer was requested to assist Ohio State Patrol in the area of Dublin Road and Hayden Run Road on a possible drunk driver. The Officer arrived on scene and he translated the field sobriety test as the State Trooper gave the instructions. The Trooper then requested to do BAC testing at Perry Township Police headquarters. The officer then assisted in translating in the BAC room for testing and returned to regular patrol after it was completed.

**May 6, 2018**

Officers were dispatched US 33 / Riverside Drive near Fishinger Road on a possible traffic crash. When officers arrived on scene they actually determined that the vehicle was a blocking disabled motorist. While speaking with the driver a Columbus woman admitted to the officers she had no driver's license. The disabled vehicle was impounded and the woman was then cited and released on summons to court.

**May 7, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road and Snouffer Road for an expired registration violation. After further review of the driver's information he was found to be driving without a valid driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court.

**May 7, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Circle On the Green on an anonymous neighbor complaint concerning loud music. Officers arrived in the area and determined the noise that could be heard outside was in the range of normal conversation with the help of a decibel meter. Based on this observation the complaint was considered unfounded.

**May 8, 2018**

Police were dispatched to the 6000 block of Riverside Drive on a menacing call. Upon arrival the officer spoke with an employee of the property owner. She stated that an individual came to the house saying she was the property owner and that the victim needed to leave or she would be hurt. The suspect left the scene before officers arrived. This investigation is ongoing.

**May 8, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 2600 block of Billingsley Road on a suspicious vehicle that was wanting out of the gated area. Officers spoke with the driver, who states that he followed a vehicle in the storage garages and now he can't get out because he does not know the code. The vehicle belonged there. The code would not work because his bill was past due. The manager let him out with the agreement that he was going to be current on his payments.

**May 8, 2018**

Officers responded to an Officer In Trouble call put out by Columbus Police 174. A search of the area was made. No suspects were found. The Officers went back on patrol.

**May 10, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the area of US 33/ Riverside Drive and Henderson Road on a report of an injury crash. When the Officer arrived on scene it was determined that the crash was not an injury crash and both parties had exchanged personal information prior to the officer's arrival. The victim declined a crash report and an incident report was taken to document the call.

**May 10, 2018**

An Officer was dispatched to meet with Dublin Police at Perry Township Police Headquarters to take custody of a prisoner with valid warrants out of Perry Township. The suspect was transported to Franklin County Clerk where she posted Bond on both warrants and was issued a new court date.

**May 11, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road and Abby Church for an equipment violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man further stated he has never obtained a driver's license before. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court.

**May 11, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Snouffer Road and McVey Boulevard for an equipment violation. While speaking with the driver he admitted to not having a driver's license. After the officer was able to verify the driver's identity, he was then cited and released on a summons to court.

**May 12, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 4800 block of US 33 Riverside Drive on an assistance call with Upper Arlington Police Department. When officers arrived on scene it was determined by admission that three Columbus men had been smoking marijuana along the river. After search of all three men and a vehicle, no additional paraphernalia or marijuana were found. All three men were identified for future investigative purposes and released on scene.

**May 12, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to Perry Township Police Headquarters concerning a dispute over keys. When the Officer arrived it was determined that a Columbus man, who was arrested the night prior for driving impaired, could not find his keys. The arresting officer was contacted and gave the information of the whereabouts of the keys. The Columbus man then left.

**May 12, 2018**

An Officer who was on a traffic stop in the Micro Center parking lot on Bethel Road requested assistance from another officer. The Officer arrived and the requesting Officer advised he was okay.

**May 12, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the Micro Center parking lot on Bethel Road for a red light violation. After further verifying the driver's identity and information he was found to be driving under suspension for a Failure to Reinstate status out of the state of Illinois. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court.

**May 12, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the area of US 33 / Riverside Drive and Hayden Run Road on a blocking disabled vehicle. The Officer arrived on scene and located an unoccupied vehicle blocking the left turn lane. No one was around the vehicle. The vehicle was then impounded by Capital Towing for safekeeping. The information was entered with Franklin County Sheriff's Department tow file.

**May 12, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Riverside Drive on a neighbor complaint concerning a resident who walks around his home nude. After speaking with the complainant and observing video the victim had taken, it was determined that the man was in violation of the law and charges will be pursued.

**May 12, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped the area Bethel Road and Jasonway Blvd for a speeding violation. After speaking with the driver and completing field sobriety testing he was subsequently arrested for operating after under the influence and underage alcohol consumption. The man was then transported to Perry Township headquarters processed and then released to a sober person on a summons to court.

**May 13, 2018**

A female Officer was requested to assist Worthington Police in the area of High Street and E. South Street. When she arrived she completed a search of multiple females who were suspected of concealing drugs.

**May 14, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the area of US 33 /Riverside Drive and West Dublin Granville Road as requested by Dublin Police Department to assist with traffic control in the area while they were completing an investigation.

**May 14, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the area of Olentangy River Road and Mulberry Drive on an assistance call to Sharon Township Police department with an injury crash.

**May 15, 2018**

An Officer made a traffic stop at Merwood and Mcvey Blvd. During the stop it was discovered that the driver's license was suspended. The driver was cited for no license and Driving under suspension. The vehicle was impounded by Capital Towing for safe keeping.

**May 17, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the 6900 block of Smokey Row Road after random registration check showed the registered owner was suspended for Failure to Reinstate and having several possible warrants for his arrest. The driver of the vehicle matched the description of the registered owner and a traffic stop was initiated. After further verifying the driver's information he was cited for the traffic violations and then transported to Franklin County Jail on multiple warrants from multiple jurisdictions.

**May 17, 2018**

An officer was dispatched to State Route 315 just south of State Route 161 to meet with a Worthington police officer. Once on scene the Officer took custody of a suspect that had valid warrants through Perry Township with no bond. The Columbus man was then transported and slated into the Franklin County Jail.

**May 17, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 1600 block of Oakview Drive on report of fraud. When the Officer arrived, the caller explained someone claiming to be with the IRS contacted him and he was concerned because his wallet had recently been lost or stolen. A report was filed for documentation in case of possible future identity fraud.

**May 17, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 2400 block of McVey Court on a residential alarm. When Officers arrived on scene they were met by the homeowner who stated she just got a new alarm system and accidentally triggered it with the key fob.

**May 18, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and State Route 315 for an equipment violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to not have a valid driver's license His last license expired in 2006. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**May 18, 2018**

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and Reed Road for an equipment violation. After further reviewing the driver's information she was found to have a suspended driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**May 18, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Clubview Boulevard South on report of a non-injury accident. After arriving on scene, Officers found two cars involved in a crash with very minor damage. Both drivers had exchanged information and declined an accident report.

**May 19, 2018**

An Officer on patrol in the area of Hard Road near Smokey Row Road came across a multiple vehicle accident. The Officer stopped to assist and was informed that several suspects fled the scene on foot. The Officer requested additional units to assist in locating the suspects. The Officer also contacted Columbus Police Department since the accident occurred within their jurisdiction. The Officer stayed on scene and assisted until they were no longer needed.

**May 19, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 8200 block of Fairway Drive on a report of found property. The caller stated while on a walk he found a set of keys in the middle of Evangeline Drive. He wanted to turn the keys over to Officers for safekeeping. The Officer noticed a AAA card attached to the key ring with a name and was able to locate the name of the owner of the keys. The owner was contacted and the keys were then turned over to him.

**May 20, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and Jasonway Boulevard for an expired registration violation. After further reviewing the man's information he was also found to have an expired driver's license. He was then cited and released on a summons to court.

**May 20, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road and Interstate 270 for an expired registration violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was also found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**May 20, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the Worthington Hills Elementary School on a 911 hang up. Officers arrived on scene and spoke with the office attendant who stated it was accidental and everything there was fine.

**May 22, 2018**

An Officer was flagged down in the 700 block of Bethel Road. She stated she started her car and accidentally locked the doors leaving the engine running. She requested the Officer use his lockout kit to unlock the door.

**May 22, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Drive and Bethel Road on a non-injury accident. Once in the area they did not locate an accident at that location. After driving around they did locate an accident just east of Riverside Drive on Hayden Road within Columbus police jurisdiction. Columbus Police were then notified and both parties on-scene decided to exchange information instead of waiting for Columbus to arrive.

**May 23, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Bethel Road on a business hold up alarm. Once on scene Officers spoke with the owners who stated they were testing the alarm system and did notify the alarm company ahead of time. They further stated they would contact the alarm company again and inform them they are still in the testing process.

**May 24, 2018**

A Canal Winchester man was stopped in the area of Riverside Drive and McCoy Road for an equipment violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**May 24, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 1600 block of Shelly Court on report of a suspicious vehicle and person. Caller stated the driver stayed in the vehicle for approximately 30 minutes and when approached stated he was waiting on someone. He eventually left the court picking up another person at the end of the roadway. Officers circulated the area and were unable to find the vehicle matching the description given.

**May 25, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and Jasonway Road for an expired registration violation. His passenger was also the registered owner on the vehicle he was driving was found to have an active warrant out of the city of Worthington. The man was then cited and released. The Columbus woman was placed under arrest and custody was transferred to Worthington Police Department so she could pay Bond on the warrant.

**May 25, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Riverside Drive and Fishinger Road for an equipment violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**May 25, 2018**

An officer on patrol in the area Brookside Estates found a suspicious vehicle parked on the sidewalk at Brookside Elementary School. The officer could not locate anyone in or around the vehicle and attempted to contact the registered owner to find out why it was there. A Columbus woman exited the school building and stated it was her car and she was a school teacher there working late.

**May 25, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Riverside Drive and Nottingham Road for an equipment violation. After further checking the driver's information he was found to be driving on an expired driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court. A passenger inside the vehicle was also cited for failure to wear his seat belt.

**May 25, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the area of Clubview Boulevard North and Circle on the Green on a suspicious vehicle. Officers arrived on scene and located the vehicle that match the description given. The vehicle was unoccupied and had a flat tire. The vehicle was legally parked and locked. It was marked for 72-hour parking and will be towed if not moved within that time.

**May 25, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Clubview Boulevard North on a disabled blocking vehicle. Officers arrived on scene and located two males pushing the vehicle. The owner lived less than a block away and they were pushing it out of the roadway to return at a later time to pick the vehicle up.

**May 26, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 4900 block of Charlbury Drive on report of a possible underage drinking party. Officers arrived on scene and observed the home as very quiet and dark from the exterior. There was an excess of amount of cars parked on the roadway so officers spoke with one of the homeowners who stated they were just ending a birthday party but there was no alcohol involved. The officers did check each juvenile exiting the house and no alcohol was detected on any of the juveniles leaving the house.

**May 26, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and Sawmill Road for turn signal violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. As the officer was speaking with the driver he detected a strong odor of marijuana. The man was placed under arrest and marijuana was found on his person and a multi colored glass pipe for smoking was found within the vehicle as well. The man was then cited for all traffic and criminal violations and released on a summons to appear in court.

**May 26, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the Brookside Country Club on a business alarm in the fitness center. Officers arrived on scene and spoke with a Columbus woman who identified herself as the cleaning crew. She stated the alarm was accidental.

**May 27, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and Sawmill Road after random registration check showed the registered owner is not having a valid driver's license. The driver matched the description of the registered owner. The man had moved to the state of Florida and returned to the state of Ohio so he was in possession of a Florida driver's license. After further reviewing the driver's Florida driving information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**May 27, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 8000 block of Greyrocks Way on a property report. Officers arrived on scene and the homeowner stated he found multiple boxes of ammunition that he requested the police department take possession of.

**May 27, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 6000 block of High Street to meet with Worthington Police. Once on scene the Perry Township Officer took custody of a suspect with valid warrants out of Perry Township Police Department. The woman was then arrested and transported to Franklin County Municipal Court to pay her bond to receive a new court date.

**May 28, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the area of High Street over Interstate 270 as requested by Sharon Township Police Department to assist with a blocking disabled vehicle. When the Officer arrived they determined the vehicle's condition was in such a manner that it could not be moved out of the roadway until the tow truck's arrival.

**May 28, 2018**

An Officer was dispatched to meet with a Hilliard Police Officer at the speedway located on the corner of Sawmill Road and State Route 161. The Officer arrived and due to a dispatch mix-up it was determined the suspect's warrant was not out of Perry Township but instead Prairie Township. The Hilliard officer then left to meet with a Deputy to take care of the warrant.

**May 28, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 2700 block of West Dublin Granville Road at the Brookside Country Club on a business alarm in the kitchen area. Upon arrival they were met by the head morning cook who stated her alarm code did not disable the alarm.

**May 29, 2018**

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of 1000 Bethel Road for multiple equipment violations. After further checking the driver's information she was found to have a suspended driver's license. The officer also observed two small children in the back seat without child restraint systems in place. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to court.

**May 29, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Snouffer Road and Bride Water Boulevard for an expired registration violation. After further reviewing the driver's information the officer determined his driver's license was also expired. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court.

When Officers arrived on scene the owner stated her vehicle occasionally overheats and she has to let it cool down before she can drive again. After allowing the vehicle to cool down she was eventually able to drive her vehicle again and went about her way.

Officers were dispatched to the 5500 block of Riverside Drive on a residential alarm. Officers arrived on scene and there appeared to be no one home. All doors and windows were checked and found to be secure.

**May 30, 2018**

An officer was in the area of U.S 33 and Fishinger Road when he came across a blocking disabled vehicle. The vehicle's battery had died and the driver needed a jump. The Officer was able to jump the vehicle and get the driver on his way.

**May 30, 2018**

Officers were requested to assist with a pursuit that was traveling along Interstate 270 near US 23. The driver was wanted for burglary out of Licking County Ohio and was also driving Eastbound in the westbound Lanes of traffic. Officers and Deputies were able to get the vehicle stopped and took two suspects into custody without incident.

**May 31, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 8000 block of Fairway Drive on a fire alarm to assist Worthington Fire Department. Once on scene it was noted there was no smoke or any signs of fire showing. Just as the fire department was attempting to make entry the homeowner arrived. The homeowner allowed the fire department to come in to check for any signs of past or current fire. The home was found to be okay.

**May 31, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 8400 block of Netherlands Place on a residential alarm. Once on scene Officers were met by the homeowner's son who stated he was outdoors cutting the grass and never knew the alarm was going off. He was then able to reset the alarm.
