Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of June 2018

June 1, 2018

An Officer who was in the area of US 33 and Hayden Run Road came across a blocking disabled shuttle bus. The Officer was able to use the push bumper to push the vehicle onto the parking lot of Premier gym where the driver was able to call and wait for a tow safely.

June 1, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of US 33 and just north of Fishinger Road on a report of flooding. ODOT was notified to come and place high water signs in the area along several spots of US 33.

June 1, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Riverside Drive on report of a possible domestic dispute outside. When Officers arrived on scene they were met by Upper Arlington officers who stated this started from an earlier traffic stop involving a resident of Arlington Pointe Apartments. There is a current custody battle between two people and a dispute came about after the traffic stop. By the time Perry Township officers had arrived on scene Upper Arlington had already dealt with both parties and they had them disperse.

June 2, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1500 Block of Blackstone Drive on a well-being check of the resident. When the Officers arrived on scene they attempted to make contact but were unsuccessful in doing so. The home was then checked and found secured with a couple of dogs seen thru the window running loose on the inside of the home. The Officer made contact with the requesting party and explained what was observed. He then stated his parents were on the way to come into the home and check on his sister.

June 2, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6000 block of Merwin Road on a report of an injury crash. When the Officers arrived on scene they found the driver who had been involved in the crash. As Officers were speaking to the Columbus man they detected a strong odor of alcohol on or about his person. After a series of tests the man was subsequently arrested for operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol. The man was booked and processed at Perry Township headquarters. The man was then cited and released to a sober person's care on a summons for court.

June 3, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of US 33 and Fishinger Road on an injury crash. As the officers were reviewing both drivers information for the crash report one of the drivers was found to have an expired driver's license. The Columbus woman was then cited and released on a summons to court.

June 4, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road and Bethel Road for an expired registration violation. After further review in the driver's information he was found to not have a valid driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

June 4, 2018

An Officer was dispatched to the 3500 block of Riverside Drive to meet with Upper Arlington Police Department to pick up a prisoner wanted for a failure to appear warrant. The Columbus man was then transported to the Franklin County Jail where he was slated on that warrant.

June 4, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1400 block of Oakbourne drive on report of domestic violence. Officers arrived on scene and spoke with all the involved parties and subsequently made an arrest on a Columbus man who was one of the residents in the home. The man was then transported to the Franklin County Jail and slated for domestic violence

June 7, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of State Route 315 just north of Bethel Road on assistance to Sharon Township Police Department with an injury accident. Officers arrived on scene and assisted with blocking traffic.

June 7, 2018

An Officer that was patrolling in the area of 1010 Bethel came across a vehicle that was stuck behind the gate that encloses the parking lot at 1010 Bethel. The officer assisted a Columbus woman with exiting the parking lot after being stuck behind it for 45 minutes.

June 7, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Billingsley Road and Sawmill Road after random registration check showed the owner's driver's license as being suspended. The driver matched the description of the registered owner. After verification of identification the driver was cited and released on a summons to court.

June 8, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bethel Road near Jasonway Boulevard for an expired registration violation. After further review of the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was in cited and released on a summons to court.

June 9, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area Riverside Drive and Old Bethel Road on a blocking disabled vehicle. When the Officer arrived in the area no vehicle was located blocking the roadway or disabled.

June 9, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of US 33 and Zollinger Road on a possible drunk driver headed Northbound. Officers arrived in the area and searched but were unable to locate any vehicles matching the description given.

June 9, 2018

An officer observed a motor scooter driving on the roadway in the area of Linworth Rd at Olentangy River Road without displaying a license plate. A traffic stop was initiated and contact was made with the driver. When asked for her driver's license, the driver said she didn't have it with her. She was then asked for her name, date of birth, and her social security number. The woman provided the officer with a name and date of birth but said she did not know her social security number. After running the information she provided through LEADS, the Officer was unable to verify the validity of the information provided. When the driver was questioned, she admitted to giving a false name and date of birth. After providing the correct information it was discovered that the driver had three active warrants for theft out of Franklin County. The woman was arrested and charged with Giving False Information to Police, No Ops and No License Plates on a Motor Vehicle. She was transported to the Franklin County Jail and the scooter was impounded.

June 10, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Riverside Drive on an unwanted person causing a disturbance. When Officers arrived they were informed of a previous domestic violence arrest concerning this person who was notified to stay away from the caller due to this case. The man was found hiding in a laundry area in the basement of the apartment building. He was then arrested for criminal trespassing and slated at the Franklin County Jail.

June 11, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of State Route 161 near McVey Blvd on a disabled vehicle. When the Officer arrived in the area, the vehicle was actually at the intersection of State Route 161 and Brookdown. The driver had been pushing the vehicle westbound and was on the phone with the insurance company to get a tow. The vehicle was cleared from the roadway and the Officer left the scene. Approximately two hours later, Officers were again dispatched to the same area but just a few blocks down on a report of the owner was again pushing the car by hand. When the Officers arrived on scene they found the same vehicle from the previous call and assisted the owner with getting the vehicle pushed onto the Tansky Toyota dealership lot.

June 11, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2700 block of West Dublin Granville Road at the Brookside Country Club on a business alarm in the athletic facility. When the Officers arrived on scene they were met by an employee who stated the alarm was accidentally triggered when he entered as he was told by the manager it was turned off. The employees were then able to deactivate the alarm.

June 12, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2700 block of Snouffer Road on a well-being check of the homeowner. When the Officers arrived they spoke with the homeowner who stated he was fine and he was just dealing with a breakup.

June 12, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Riverside Drive on a report of a theft from a motor vehicle. When Officers arrived on scene they met with the caller who stated sunglasses and \$10 and some change were removed from an unlocked vehicle.

June 13, 2018

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and Sawmill Road for an expired registration violation. After further review reviewing the driver's information she was found also have a suspended driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

June 13, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of Beechlake Drive on property found. The Officer arrived on scene and spoke with a caller who stated a wallet was left on the trunk of his vehicle after being parked in a Neil Ave garage in Columbus. So the caller decided to call the police when he made it home to turn it in. An attempt to locate the owner of the wallet via public service was unsuccessful. The wallet was then placed in a property locker for safekeeping.

June 13, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 3000 block of Greenvale Drive on a residential alarm. Officers arrived and found the exterior garage door was left open. All other exterior doors and the interior garage door were checked and found to be secure. The Officer was able to close and secure the exterior garage door and left a notice for the homeowner.

June 13, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of Clubview Boulevard South on report of a suspicious vehicle in the area. The caller thought the occupants were doing drugs or having a medical emergency. Officers arrived in the area and found a vehicle that matched the description given but it was unoccupied and legally parked on the roadway.

June 13, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road and Abbey Church Drive for an equipment violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to never have possessed a driver's license to operate a motor vehicle. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

June 14, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1200 block of Candlewood Drive at Worthington Hills Elementary School on a group of suspicious individuals. Officers arrived and spoke with 4 juveniles who were not from the area. They were told to leave the property and not return.

June 14, 2018

A Dublin man was stopped in the area of US 33 Riverside Drive and Wickliffe Road for a speeding violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to have an expired driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court.

June 14, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 3500 block of Snouffer Road on a possible deceased person. The Officers arrived and found a Columbus man deceased in the home.

June 15, 2018

A Dublin woman was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road and Gold Leaf Lane for an expired registration violation. After further checking the driver's information she was found to have a suspended driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to court.

June 15, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1400 block of Candlewood Drive on report of domestic violence between husband and wife. Officers arrived on scene and spoke with all parties and a Columbus man was subsequently arrested for domestic violence and assault. The man was then processed and transported to and slated at the Franklin County Jail.

June 16, 2018

An Officer exiting from Perry Township Police Headquarters saw an accident blocking the roadway in front of the 7000 block of Sawmill Road within Columbus Police Department's jurisdiction. The Officer assisted with traffic control so that both parties could pull off the road on to the gas station lot until Columbus Police could arrive to assist them with an accident report.

June 16, 2018

Officers were dispatched multiple times through the evening to the 2600 block of Riverside Drive to assist a man who was lying on the side of the roadway near guard rail. The man eventually agreed to be checked out after initially refusing medics. Medic stated he was okay and gave him water. After this, an Officer transported the man to a local gas station to make ride arrangements.

June 16, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of US 33 Riverside Drive and Wickliffe Road for a speeding violation. After further reviewing the driver's license information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to court.

June 16, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 7900 block of Fairway Drive on a residential alarm. Officers arrived on scene checked all doors and windows and found the home to be secure.

June 17, 2018

An Officer was in the area of State Route 315 and Interstate 270 just after a non-injury accident occurred and was flagged down. The Officer stopped to check on the involved parties just as Sharon Township police was being dispatched to the location. The Officer stayed on scene until Sharon Township Police and Worthington Police arrived and took control accident scene.

A Grove City woman was stopped in the area of US 33 / Riverside Drive and Lane Avenue for a speeding violation. After further reviewing the driver's information she was also found to have a suspended driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

June 17, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bride Water Boulevard and Snouffer Road for an expired registration violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to also have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

June 17, 2018

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of US 33 / Riverside Drive and Lane Avenue for a speeding violation. After further reviewing the driver's information she was also found to have a

suspended driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

June 17, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 3000 block of Brookdown Road on a neighbor dispute involving a loose dog. When Officers arrived on scene there were no dogs or people outside arguing. A homeowner then exited and explained the situation that happened with her dog. She said she called police as she was concerned that the argument over the dog was escalating and did not want a fight to take place. After speaking with the other neighbor involved it was determined by both parties the situation and argument was over with and no further action was needed.

June 18, 2018

A female Officer was requested to respond to the area of High St and Southington Dr to assist Worthington Police with a search of a female prisoner.

June 18, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the 900 block of Bethel Rd for an equipment violation. After further review of the driver's information he also found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

June 18, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2600 block of Scioto View Lane on report of theft of an air conditioning unit. When the officer arrived on scene the caller explained that when she returned from work her home was warm so when she went outside to look at her air conditioning unit it was missing. There was also an additional air conditioning unit missing that's usually in the spot beside hers. All information will be forwarded to the detectives for review.

June 18, 2018

Officers in the area of Sawmill Road and Billingsley Road came across an injury accident and called dispatched for an additional unit to respond as well. The accident occurred within Columbus Police jurisdiction so they were requested to respond as well. Both Officers stayed on scene until Columbus Police arrived.

June 18, 2018

An officer who was in the area of State Route 315 and Hard Road heard a dispatched call for Sharon Township Police to respond to the area for an injury accident. The Officer was already in the area so he responded as well. When the Officer arrived on scene he assisted with traffic control until the vehicles were cleared from the roadway.

June 19, 2018

An Officer was dispatched to the 6500 block of Worthington Galena Rd to meet with Worthington Police. When the Officer arrived on scene, custody of a Suspect with a valid warrant out of Perry Township Police Department was transferred. The Columbus man was then transported down to the Franklin County clerk's office to pay the bond and the citation on the warrant.

June 19, 2018

Officers were dispatched to US 33 / Riverside Drive and Fishinger Road due to the traffic signals being non-functional. When the officers arrived they found the traffic signals flashing in

all directions and traffic very heavy. The Ohio Department transportation was advised and prior to their arrival the traffic signals were reset and functional a short time later.

June 19, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2600 block of Scioto View Lane on report of a theft. When the Officer arrived on scene he was met by the caller who stated that a person or persons unknown stole the exterior AC condenser unit.

June 20, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1400 block of Oakview Drive on a traffic complaint concerning a car driving through the neighborhood at a high rate of speed. Officers arrived in the area and circulated but were unable to locate a vehicle matching the description given.

Officers were dispatched to the railroad tracks at Snouffer Road near Snouffer Place on a suspicious person walking Southbound on the tracks. The officers arrived in the area and checked the railroad tracks between Snouffer and State Route 161 and no one was located on the tracks.

June 20, 2018

An officer on patrol in the area of Arlington Pointe community came across a black vehicle sitting unoccupied in the middle of the roadway. The Officer made contact with the owner who stated that he parked in a marked parking spot but the emergency brake had failed the vehicle rolled out of the spot. The caller was the adult daughter of the homeowner at this location stated her mother called crying and did not want a particular man at her house. After further speaking with the homeowner she stated that her adult daughter makes assumptions and confuses information sometimes.

June 22, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6800 block of Merwood Street on report of a suspicious male. Officers arrived in the area and made contact with a man matching the description that was given. The man was identified as an AEP employee who was working in the area replacing old meters.

June 22, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the intersection of Estel Dr and Darwin Road on complaints concerning a neighbor. The Officers arrived and spoke with one of the neighbors as the other neighbor did not want to speak with officers. It was determined that the complaints stated against that neighbor were unfounded.

June 22, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1100 block of Circle On The Green on assistance to the Fire Department and Medics. Officers arrived on scene and Medics were already loading a patient into the medic to be transported to the local hospital.

June 23, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Blind Brook Dr on an occupied suspicious vehicle. Officers arrived in the area and circulated but were unable to locate a vehicle matching the description given.

June 22, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 800 block of Clubview Boulevard North on report of a missing runaway juvenile. Upon arrival the Officer spoke with the parents of the missing juvenile concerning the last time she was seen and spoken with. This information was then given to radio dispatchers so she could be entered as a missing child in the law enforcement databases. This information was then forwarded to the detectives for investigation.

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Clubview Boulevard North to assist the caller who had locked herself out of the house. The caller, who was the mother of the resident, was house-sitting while the resident is away. Police and Fire departments were unable to open the door without breaking it so a locksmith was requested. Prior to the locksmith's arrival the caller was able to locate her key and able to let herself back into the house.

June 25, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of US 33 / Riverside Drive and Lane Avenue for an equipment violation on a motorcycle. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to not possess a motorcycle license. There was also no current registration or insurance for said motorcycle either. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

Officers were dispatched to the 6000 block of Merwin Road on report of vandalism. When the Officer arrived on scene, the caller stated his mailbox was knocked down and left in his front yard by a person or persons unknown.

An officer was dispatched to the Arlington Pointe complex on report of an unconscious man, possibly not breathing, who was blocking the roadway in his vehicle. When the officer arrived on scene with fire department and medics, the man was checked out medically and cleared. The man was subsequently arrested for operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol. He was then transported to the Perry Township Police Department for processing. The man was then released to a responsible adult with a summons to appear in court.

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of West Dublin Granville Rd on an unstable person. Upon arrival Officers spoke with an individual who was having a mental episode. He was transported to Ohio State Medical Center for observation.

June 28, 2018

An Officer on patrol in the area of Sawmill Road and Hard Road came across a non-injury multi-vehicle accident that occurred within City of Columbus Police jurisdiction. The drivers were told to move off the roadway into a parking lot and the Officer requested Columbus Police to respond to the location for an accident report.

When the officer approached to assist the motorist, he detected a strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. The driver was subsequently arrested and released on a summons to appear in court.

A Columbus man was stopped in the 7000 block of Sawmill Road after a random registration check revealed the vehicle having tags on it that did not belong to it. After further reviewing information about the vehicle it was determined that there was no proof of title transfer as well. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

Officers were dispatched to the 6600 block of Merwin Road on report of a theft of a garbage can. The Officer arrived on scene and found the trash can was accidentally placed at the end of the wrong driveway via the garbage company. The trash can was then returned to the rightful owner.
