Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of July 2018

July 1, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and Pickforde Road for an equipment violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to not possess a driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

July 1, 2018

Officers were dispatched to US 33 / Riverside Drive and Lane Road on report of a tree blocking the roadway. Officers arrived on scene and were unable to physically remove the tree. Officers requested Upper Arlington Fire Department come to cut the tree into pieces to be removed from the roadway. The roadway was then opened back up for travel.

July 1, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 8000 block of Park Ridge Court to assist Worthington medic 101 on an adult male who fell off of a 6-foot ladder. The Officer arrived on scene and stood by as Medic 101 assisted the man. He was then transported to Riverside Hospital in stable condition.
