Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of August 2018

August 2, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of Candlewood Boulevard and Clubview Boulevard South on a suspicious person. The caller stated they saw a person walking with a stick and did not feel it was safe. Officers arrived in the area and found a male who was walking home in the neighborhood.

August 2, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Drive at Hayden Run Road on a single vehicle injury accident. When the Officers arrived on scene, they found the operator of a motorcycle who explained there were slippery fluids on the road. He further stated he laid his motorcycle down in order to avoid striking another vehicle. The man declined medical assistance or a crash report.

August 2, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 5700 block of Hayden Run Road to assist Franklin County deputies with a residential alarm. When the Officers arrived on scene they checked all exterior doors and windows which were found to be secure.

August 2, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6600 block of Merwin Road on a suspicious person. Officers arrived in the area and did locate a door-to-door salesman. The man did not have a proper permit in place to sell door-to-door. The man agreed to leave the area until obtaining a permit.

August 2, 2018

August 2, 2018

August 3, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6600 block of Merwin Road on a possible suicide attempt. Officers arrived and spoke with the caller who stated extra medication and a suicide note from the prior week was found in her daughter's room. When Officers spoke with the adult daughter she stated the week prior she did feel somewhat suicidal and used the suicide hotline to receive assistance. She was not suicidal today and had not been suicidal since the week prior. Officers

told the woman if she started to feel suicidal or like harming herself to let her parents know or just reach out to us or the suicide prevention hotline again.

August 3, 2018

Officers were dispatched to meet with Upper Arlington Police to exchange custody of a Columbus man they arrested with active warrants through Perry Township Police. The Officer arrived on scene, took custody of the man and transported him to the Franklin County jail where he was slated.

August 3, 2018

An Officer was dispatched to the Perry Township Police headquarters to witness a child custody exchange. The exchange occurred without incident.

August 3, 2018

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of US 33/Riverside Drive and Lane Road for a speeding violation. After further reviewing the driver's information she was found to have a suspended driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

August 3, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6600 block of Merwin Road to assist Worthington Fire Department medics on an ill person. When the Officers arrived on scene, medics advised they were OK and did not require police assistance.

August 4, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of State Route 315 and I-270 on a possible male walking on the highway. Officers search the area but were unable to locate anyone walking on foot. While in the area, an Officer did observe a non blocking disabled vehicle and stopped to check on the driver of that vehicle. The driver stated he was out of fuel and had help on the way already.

Officers were dispatched to Snouffer Road and the railroad tracks on an injury crash. They advised and requested Worthington respond to take the crash report. Officers stayed on scene and assisted Worthington Police with traffic control until the scene was clear.

That's when a family member began to get heated about certain items. All parties were calm and said they would get along. No threat or assault took place.

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Riverside Drive on an accident. Upon arrival both parties indicated that the accident occurred at the Frisbee park. Officers advised that the accident took place in the City of Columbus. The both exchanged information.

The medics informed Officers that sometime during the night, the woman had passed away due to numerous health complications. Officers assisted the family with making notifications and contacting a funeral home.

August 9, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 8300 block of Fairway Drive on report of property found. When the Officer arrived on scene, the caller stated she had contacted her neighbor who was cleaning up glass from what appeared to be a broken window of their vehicle that was parked in their driveway. The neighbor explained that a black bag was missing and that was the exact property that was found. The Officer confirming the property belonged to the neighbor took possession and returned it to the owner.

August 10, 2018

While on patrol, Officers were flagged down by a resident of the 8000 block of Fairway Drive who reported the both of their unlocked vehicles were entered last night while parked in their driveway. Nothing was taken but the vehicles were rummaged through.

August 10, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 3600 block of Interchange Drive to meet with US Marshals to exchange custody of a female with an active felony warrant through Perry Township Police. The Officers arrived on scene and took custody of a Columbus woman and her property. She was transported to Perry police headquarters to be interviewed by detectives. The woman was then transported and slated at the Franklin County jail.

August 10, 2018

An Officer was dispatched to the 6200 block of McVey Boulevard on an animal complaint. When Officers arrived on scene, the caller stated the dog had already left but appeared to be just lost because it was too clean to be a stray dog. The caller stated she would call back if the dog returned.

August 10, 2018

An Officer was dispatched to Perry Township police headquarters to assist OSP with an intoxicated individual. The Trooper was requesting to use the BAC machine to test the intoxicated person's alcohol level. The Trooper was able to complete the test without incident.

August 11, 2018

An Officer was dispatched to the area of US33 / Riverside Drive and Lakehurst Road on report of a loose dog running in the roadway. Animal control was also in route with an ETA of 20 minutes. The Officers arrived on scene and the caller had actually caught the animal and secured it in her motor vehicle. Approximately 3 minutes later animal control arrived and took possession of the animal.

An Officer on patrol in the area of State Route 161 and Thompson Street observed a female bicyclist collapse on the side of the road. The Officer stopped to assist the bicyclist who appeared to be in distress. When speaking with the cyclist, she stated that she just needed to rest due to riding a very long time. The Officer assisted the woman with giving her a ride to her destination.

August 14, 2018

Officers were dispatched the Brookside Country Club on a business alarm. The alarm was from the kitchen in the athletic center. Officers arrived checked all exterior doors and found several to be unsecured. The interior of the building was checked and found to be undisturbed. All doors were closed and notification to the alarm company was made.
