Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of September 2018

September 2, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 800 block of Clubview Blvd North on report of a missing runaway juvenile. Officers arrived on scene and spoke with the parents who stated their 17 year old daughter left home in a silver Honda and had not returned home at the required time. The juvenile had not made contact with her parents at all. A possible address in Columbus where she could have been was searched and she was not located.

September 2, 2018

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and Portland Street after random registration check revealed the owner's license was suspended. After verification of the driver's identity and driving record she was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

September 2, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and Sawmill Road for an expired registration violation. After further reviewing the drivers Information the Officer determined he had also allowed his driver's license to expire. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

September 3, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 5000 block of Henderson Heights on a call for assistance to the medics. The Officer arrived on scene and medics already had the patient loaded to transport to an area hospital.

September 3, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Bethel Road on a business alarm drop. Officers arrived on scene and found two young men in a vehicle stuck behind the parking lot gate from attempting to turn around. They attempted to go into the building to make contact as the signage instructed but the business was already closed for the day. When attempting to do that they set the alarm off as the business was not properly secured.

September 3, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 3600 block of Snouffer Road on a report of a possible suicidal woman who had left the scene. Officers arrived and made contact with the caller who was the boyfriend of the suspect. The man stated he and his girlfriend had an argument and she told him she no longer wanted to live and was planning to kill herself then left in a car. Officers took all information and called in the detective to take over the investigation. Through the investigation the woman was found safe later the same day at her home.

September 3, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Olde Hill Court North on a neighbor dispute. The caller stated one neighbor was constantly beeping his horn for approximately 15 minutes. The man became belligerent after the caller asked him to stop because it was almost midnight and

he woke their children. Officers arrived on scene and were able to settle the dispute for the evening. Both parties were told to contact their property management concerning any further non-criminal issues

September 4, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1200 block of Candlewood Dr on a 911 hang up. When Officers arrived to see what the issue was, the Principal advised the she had a disruptive child and he must have called 911 by accident.

September 4, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 5300 block of Banbury on a vehicle lockout. The Officer unlocked the vehicle for the resident.

September 4, 2018

Officers made a traffic stop on Sawmill near Abby Church for an expired tag violation. The registration ended up being renewed however the license was expired. The individual was cited for not having a license and someone with a valid license came to drive the car away.

September 6, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Clubview Blvd North on a traffic complaint. When the Officer arrived on scene the caller explained that a commercial vehicle almost hit him while backing out of a driveway. The man stated he hurt his ankle and just wanted to report the incident in case he needed to see a doctor.

September 7, 2018

A Columbus juvenile was stopped in the area of McVey Blvd and Merwood Rd for a speeding violation. After reviewing the driving record the officer determined that the juvenile had a suspended license with certain privileges in place. The juvenile was found to be driving outside of those stated privileges. The juvenile was then cited and summons to appear in court. The juvenile was then released to a parent.

September 8, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Blindbrook Drive on a well-being check of the resident. When the Officer arrived he was met by some of the neighbors. The neighbor stated that the resident was unconscious inside the home. Medics arrived on scene and pronounced the resident deceased. Further investigation showed no foul play. The coroner's investigator determined the cause of death to be natural.

September 8, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Clubview Blvd South on a business alarm at the Worthington Hills Country Club. When the Officers arrived on scene they were met by the manager of the pro shop who advised he accidentally set the alarm off.

September 8, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2600 block of McVey Blvd West to assist paramedics. When the Officer arrived on scene he assisted medics with lifting the resident and getting her back in bed. Paramedics checked the woman and found she was stable but had just fallen from the bed.

September 9, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 800 block of Clubview Boulevard North on an unruly juvenile. Dispatchers also informed the officers the juvenile had made threats to her appearance and assaulted the caller as well. When the Officers arrived on scene and evaluated the situation the juvenile was placed under arrest for domestic violence assault and aggravated menacing. The juvenile was then transported to the Franklin County juvenile detention center.

September 10, 2018

A Dublin woman was stopped in the area of Riverside Drive and Lane Avenue for a speeding violation. After further review of the driver's information she was found to not possess a valid driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

September 11, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of Clubview Boulevard North and Oakbourne Drive on report of 2 drivers from separate motor vehicles screaming at one another. Officers arrived in the area, and after searching for some time, were unable to locate anyone matching the description given or anyone yelling in the area.

September 11, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1600 block of Keats Court on a group of suspicious men digging holes in the caller's backyard. Officers arrived on scene and spoke with the group of men who stated they were contracted by AT&T. The Officer was able to verify the information and informed the caller of this information. The caller was still upset due to them working so late at 7pm and the Officer advised him they were contracted and working within the legal rights of the easement.

September 11, 2018

An Officer was dispatched to the 2500 block of Scioto View Lane on a theft report. The Officer was met on scene by the caller who stated she hired a long time friend to do some work within her home. She provided him a key to do this work while she was out of town. When she returned home, multiple items of high dollar value were missing and the hired person was nowhere to be found along with no work being completed.

September 11, 2018

A Dublin woman was stopped in the area of Smoky Row Road and Smoky Meadow for a speeding violation. After further reviewing the driver's information she was found to not possess a valid driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

September 12, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of US 33 / Riverside Drive and Hayden Run Road on a blocking disabled vehicle. The Officer arrived on scene and found the vehicle with the driver inside. The driver stated that her battery had died and she was waiting for her husband to arrive with a new one. The Officers were able to push the vehicle off the roadway so that the mechanical issues could be dealt with in a safe location.

September 12, 2018

An Officer on patrol in the area of State Route 315 near Bethel Road, observed a man riding his bicycle on the right shoulder of the highway. Since it was nighttime, the Officer did not see the man until he was very near him since he was wearing dark clothing and had no reflectors or lights on his bicycle. The Officer stopped to make contact with the man who stated he just moved here from Georgia in was not aware that he was not allowed to ride his bicycle on the highway. The Officer verified the man's identity and gave him a courtesy transport to his home.

September 13, 2018

An Officer was dispatched to the Brookside Country Club on an assistance to the medics. When the Officer arrived near the front entrance, the manager of Pro Golf requested he wait for the medics and guide the medic to the 15th hole where the patient was down. After a few moments of waiting the Officer was advised that the medics were already on scene and he was no longer needed.

September 13, 2018

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bethel Road near Jasonway Ave for an expired registration violation. After further review of the driver's information he was also found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

September 15, 2018

An Officer was dispatched to the 6500 block of McVey Boulevard on a traffic complaint. The Officer arrived on scene and spoke with a group of residents who stated a small older model vehicle, appearing to be a Saturn, was driving at excessive speeds and not stopping for the stop signs. The Officer stayed in the area for a short time and was able to stop the vehicle that prompted the complaint. The Officer was also able to witness several other violations of traffic control devices and speeding violations in that same time period. Citations were issued to all offenders.

September 17, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of West Dublin Granville Road on a 911 hang up call. Officers arrived on scene and made contact with several church members who stated it was accidental and everything was OK.

September 17, 2018

An Officer was dispatched to the area of Riverside Drive, north of Lane Avenue on a blocking disabled vehicle. When the Officer arrived on scene, a Columbus police officer had already arrived and was taking care of the vehicle which was actually in the Columbus police jurisdiction.

September 17, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 6500 block of Estell Road on a suspicious tree trimmer. The caller stated they were worried the homeowner was being taken advantage of due to his age. The Officer arrived on scene and spoke with the tree company who had an active work order with proof of requested service by the home owner.

September 18, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Olde Hill Court N on a report of a suicidal individual. Officers made contact with the subject. He agreed to go to Riverside Hospital for an evaluation. He was then transported to the hospital.

September 18, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1100 block of Circle on the Green on an animal complaint. Upon arrival Officers spoke with one of the residents who stated his dog was attacked by his neighbor's dog. Animal control officers were called and they felt that this was not a case for them unless a check of shot records, dog license or the issue of a citation was needed.

September 18, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2700 block of Lone Court on a burglary. The reporting person did not know how entry was made, however an unknown person removed a leaf blower and a power washer from the garage.

September 18, 2018

Officers were dispatched to a non-injury accident at the 5200 block of Riverside Drive. Upon arrival it was determined that the driver had no license and was driving under suspension. He was cited for no license, driving under suspension, ACDA and driving under FRA suspension. The vehicle was impounded by Capital Towing and the driver was picked up by a friend.

September 18, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2600 block of Billingsley Road on two suspicious people living in the storage garages. Officers determined that one of the two were living there. Extra resources like Netcare were called for assistance in finding her a place to stay. Netcare is going to follow up in the morning.

September 20, 2018

An Officer on patrol in the area of Sawmill Road and West Case Road came across a blocking traffic accident. Just as the Officer was exiting his vehicle to check on the drivers, a Columbus police cruiser and Columbus Fire medics were pulling up. The Officer stayed to assist with traffic control until the intersection was clear.

September 20, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of West Dublin Granville Road on a 911 hang up call. The Officers arrived on scene and spoke with the pastor who said all was OK and it was believed to be accidental.

September 21, 2018

Officers were dispatched to be 1000 block of Circle on the Green on a residential alarm. When the Officers and the Canine unit arrived on scene they did find the front door open. The home was searched but they found no evidence of forced entry and nothing appearing to be out of place. The home was then secured and alarm notice was left on the front door.

September 21, 2018

A female Officer was requested to respond to the area of Riverside Drive near Henderson Road to meet with Upper Arlington police. They were requesting for assistance and searching a female suspect that had been arrested out of a traffic stop. The Officer arrived on scene and completed a search of a female suspect. The suspect was cooperative and nothing illegal was found on her person.

September 23, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1400 block of Glenn Avenue on a domestic dispute. When the Officers arrived on scene and spoke with the caller, it was determined that the argument actually happened within the City of Upper Arlington. The complainant stated they attempted to go there but the building was closed. The officer went ahead and completed a report and then referred the caller to the Franklin County prosecutor's office for further mediation.

September 24, 2018

An Officer on patrol in the area of Bethel Road near Dierker Road came across an injury crash involving 2 vehicles. The Officer requested Columbus medics and Columbus police to respond. The Officer stayed until Columbus police arrived to take over the scene.

September 24, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of US33/Riverside Drive near Lane Avenue on report of a suspicious person. Officers arrived in the area and searched but were unable to locate anyone matching the description given.

September 24, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of West Dublin Granville Road on an auto accident. After further reviewing all the driver's information and investigating the accident, the at fault driver was found to have a suspended driver's license. The Westerville man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

September 24, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the area of us 33/Riverside Drive near Fishinger Road on a blocking disabled vehicle. The Officer arrived in the area and did locate the motorist on the southbound side of the roadway. The Officer was able to push the vehicle off the roadway to a safe location so that the driver could wait for a tow truck.

September 24, 2018

An Officer on patrol in the area of US33/Riverside Drive near West Case Road came across a vehicle off the side of the road and partially in the ditch. The Officer stopped to check on the driver who stated he hydroplaned off the roadway and had already contacted a tow truck company. The driver further explained he did not require any other assistance and did not want a crash report.

An officer was dispatched to the area of Riverside Drive and Fishinger Road to assist Columbus Police on a missing female. The Officer searched the area and found nothing.

An Officer made a traffic stop in the area of Sawmill Road and Bethel Road. It was determined that the driver had no license and the plates were expired. A licensed driver arrived on scene to drive the car away. The driver was cited for not having a license and expired plates.

September 27, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Snouffer Place on report of suspicious person looking through a truck with a flashlight. Officers arrived on scene and found the resident from across the street that recently purchased a new truck cleaning a spill with a flashlight in the front seat.

September 27, 2018

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Clubview Boulevard South to assist the medics. Officers arrived on scene and after a short time medics arrived as well. The medics transported a man in stable condition to OSU medical center.

September 28, 2018

An Officer on patrol in the area of Snouffer Road West of Smoky Row Road came across an accident involving two vehicles off to the side of the road. The Officer stopped to check on the drivers and gave them forms to exchange information. Both parties requested a police report so the Officer requested Columbus police to respond to the area. Columbus police arrived and took control of the scene.

Officers were dispatched to the 3600 block of Snouffer Road on a well being check. The caller stated the resident was sending pictures with a gun pointed to his head. When the Officers arrived on scene, the man appeared to be in normal condition. When asked about the pictures, he stated that he took them many days prior and was upset at that time period. The man stated he would call if he started feeling or thinking thoughts of self harm in the future.

September 29, 2018

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of SR 161/West Dublin Granville Road and Thompson Street for a fictitious tag violation. After further reviewing the driver's information she was found to have a suspended driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

September 29, 2018

An Officer was dispatched to the 4000 block of Riverside Drive on report of a non-injury accident. When the Officer arrived on scene he was met by both drivers who stated they had already exchanged information and neither wanted a police report filed.

September 29, 2018

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of US33/Riverside Drive and Nottingham Road for a speeding violation. After further reviewing the driver's information she was found to have a suspended driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

September 30, 2018

An Officer was dispatched to US33/Riverside Drive near Lane Avenue on a blocking disabled vehicle. When the Officer arrived on scene, he located the disabled vehicle which also had a Columbus police officer sitting behind it with overhead lights on since it was blocking. The Columbus Officer cleared the scene, and after the owner returned with gasoline, he was found to be driving on an expired registration. The man then received a citation and was then released to go about his way.

Officers were dispatched to the 3000 block of Woodview Place on a residential alarm. When the Officers arrived on scene they were met by a realtor who was holding an open house was given the wrong code for the alarm. After getting the correct code she was able to clear the alarm and turn it off.
