Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township  
**Month of October 2018**

**October 2, 2018**

An Officer made a traffic stop for a red-light violation near Riverside Drive and Cranston Drive. It was discovered that the individual had only a passport from another country. She was cited for not having a license and red light violation. The vehicle was released to a valid driver.

**October 2, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 1500 block of Clubview Blvd on a suspicious person handing out flyers and looking and checking packages on the porches. Officers spoke to the individual and found out he was handing out door flyers for someone running for the Ohio Senate.

**October 4, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and Godown Road for multiple equipment violations. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**October 4, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the Worthington Hills Elementary School on a juvenile complaint. A teacher on the behavioral unit was having an issue with a student making threats to harm another student. After speaking with the Officers and all parents involved with both parties, it was determined that his threats held no validity.

**October 5, 2018**

A resident from Perry Township came to the Perry Township Police headquarters with a bag of unused ammunition. The resident state he was cleaning his home to prepare for relocation and he found the rounds of ammunition. He decided to bring them to police headquarters for proper disposal.

**October 5, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Henderson Road and Sawmill Road for an expired registration violation. After further evaluating the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**October 6, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and Olentangy River Road for multiple turning violations in the roadway. When asked to provide a driver's license the man did not have one; he only possessed a Mexico passport. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**October 6, 2018**

An Officer was dispatched to the area of US 33/Riverside Drive and Lane Road on a disabled vehicle. The Officer arrived in the area and located the motorist who stated she had a dead battery. The Officer was able to assist the motorist with getting back on to the road by jump starting her vehicle.

**October 8, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to Riverside Drive and Hayden Run on an auto accident. When Officers arrived, it was determined that the crash occurred in the city of Columbus. Both drivers exchanged information, and refused a report from Perry Twp Police.

**October 8, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 6500 block of McVey Blvd on a theft. Upon arrival, the victim stated that Pay Pal contacted her about a charge on her account which she never purchased. Pay Pal was able to remove the charge on her account and credited back the money.

**October 10, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 6600 block of Merwin Road on a theft report. The resident reported that they had given a contractor a deposit to purchase materials to start a renovation project. The contractor had never returned and cannot be reached by phone or email.

**October 10, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to Worthington Hills Elementary School on a complaint of a distraught adult. Officer arrived along with Worthington medics. The adult was transported to the hospital for medical evaluation.

**October 10, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to Worthington Hills Elementary School on a complaint of a student who threatened to cut another students hair with a pair of scissors. When Officers arrived, they were informed the incident was being handled by school officials.

**October 10, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 3500 block or Riverside Drive on the report of a two-car accident. Upon arrival Officers found the drivers of the vehicle involved in the crash talking with an Upper Arlington Officer. It was determined that the crash occurred in a parking lot within Upper Arlington' jurisdiction. Perry Township Officers cleared the scene and returned to patrol.

**October 11, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the area of US 33/ Riverside Drive and Lane Road on report of a blocking disabled motorist. The Officer arrived on scene and located the vehicle. The owner was inside the vehicle and stated a tow truck was already in route. The Officer stayed on scene until the tow truck arrived due to the unsafe location and lighting.

**October 11, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of West Dublin Granville Road on a person having trouble breathing in the roadway. Officers arrived on scene along with Worthington medics who were able to assist a Columbus man who appeared to be having a panic attack.

**October 11, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the intersection of State Route 161/West Dublin Granville Road and Linworth Road on report of a blocking non-injury crash. When the Officers arrived on scene they located a crash that had very minimal minor damage. Both parties on scene had exchanged information and a crash report was not needed.

**October 12, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Scioto View Lane to assist the medics on an injured person. Officers and medics arrived on scene and a Columbus man was transported to Riverside hospital after falling down his front steps.

**October 12, 2018**

An Officer was dispatched to Perry Township headquarters to meet with OSP. The Officer arrived on scene and allowed the Trooper into the building to use BAC machine to administer a test to his suspect. After the Officer cleared and left headquarters, dispatch again advised the Ohio state trooper needed assistance for a second time due to having to arrest the driver for OVI who had driven to pick up his 1st suspect.

**October 12, 2018**

An Officer on patrol in the area of US 33/Riverside Drive and Lane Avenue came across a disabled vehicle. The Officer stopped to check on the driver who stated the vehicle was out of gas. The Officer then assisted the driver by giving her a ride to the gas station and back to her vehicle with fuel.

**October 14, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of McVey Blvd and Merwood Rd for a speeding violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to have an expired driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**October 15, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to a house in the 3600 block of Snouffer Rd multiple times during a 12 hour period on reports of threats made over the phone. Officers arrived on scene and each time spoke with the victim who was unable to give any information on the person threatening him other than a first name. Multiple reports were taken and the caller was referred to the prosecutor's office.

**October 16, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to Riverside Dr and Canterbury on an obstruction in the street. When Officers arrived there was a person picking up plastic bottles which he was taking to be recycled.

**October 16, 2018**

Officers made a traffic stop on Dierker near Bethel Road. It was determined that the driver had no license and the plates were expired. The vehicle was impounded by Capital Towing and the driver was cited for not having a license and expired plates.

**October 17, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to 1200 block of Candlewood Drive on a complaint of a student who was using his finger to simulate a gun in hopes of being sent home from school early. No threats were made to any student and the individual was made to stay in the Office until the end of the day.

**October 17, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 of Old Hill Ct N on a well being check. After speaking to the person in question, it was determined that everything was OK.

**October 18, 2018**

An Officer was dispatched to the area of US33/Riverside Dr on an injury crash. Once on scene information was gathered from all involved parties. The at fault driver, a Cleveland man, was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court. A crash report was also taken for the original call.

**October 18, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the area of US33/Riverside Dr and Lane Avenue on a possible drunk driver. As the officers were in route they received another call stating witnesses saw the same vehicle strike a parked vehicle. Moments later they were notified Upper Arlington Police had the vehicle and driver at her home address along with medics. The woman was checked out and then arrested by Upper Arlington police for disorderly conduct. There was no victim found concerning the parked car accident to file charges against the driver at this time.

**October 20, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 1400 block of Clubview South on a loud music complaint. The Officer arrived and spoke to the home owner who apologized and turned the volume down.

**October 21, 2018**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Billingsley Road and Sawmill Road for an expired registration violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**October 21, 2018**

An Indiana resident was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and Godown Road for an equipment violation. After speaking with him the Officer was able to determine he had no valid license. The registration on the vehicle had also been expired for numerous months. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**October 22, 2018**

Franklin County Sherriff Deputies were dispatched to the intersection of Pickforde and Bethel on report of someone stating they were Sheriff Baldwin over the phone. A Perry Township Officer was in the area and asked if they wanted assistance. When the Officer arrived it was determined the person making the calls was impersonating Sherriff Baldwin. This person was attempting to make the caller believe there were warrants out on him. Officers verified the man in fact had no warrants and requested Columbus Police to respond to file a telephone harassment report.

**October 22, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of West Dublin Granville Road on a residential alarm. Officers arrived and found multiple employees from BEST Supply making a delivery and accidentally set the alarm off.

**October 22, 2018**

Officers were dispatched the 2700 block of West Dublin Granville Road on a business alarm. Officers arrived on scene and found an open unlocked side door. The Officers checked the interior and found nothing appearing to be out of place. The building was then secured prior to Officers departure.

**October 22, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 800 block of Blindbrook Dr on a man sleeping in a vehicle. Officers arrived and located the vehicle but no one was inside sleeping. The owner was then located at a home doing some work he was hired to do. He stated he was reading a book in his car not long ago. The home owner verified the man was hired to work at their house for them.

**October 22, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the Worthington Hills Elementary School on report of a suspicious man in the parking lot sitting in his car. Officers arrived and located the man who stated his son missed the bus so he had to drive him but he did not have to be at work for another 30 minutes and he decided to stay parked and nap till he had to leave. The school did verify the student was a pupil enrolled there.

**October 23, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 5900 block of Dublin Rd on a deer that was struck by a vehicle. Upon arrival the deer was deceased. The officers cleared the call.

**October 23, 2018**

Dublin Police made a mutual aid request for a K9 to assist in tracking two suspects that fled from a stolen car. Our Officer and his K9 tracked them to a certain point but were unable to make an apprehension due to K9 losing scent.

**October 24, 2018**

An Officer made a traffic stop at the 7200 block of Sawmill and determined that the driver had no license. The driver was cited for two driving under suspensions, a traffic control device violation and operating a vehicle without a valid license. The vehicle was picked up by the owner.

**October 24, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of West Dublin Granville Rd on a suspicious person. It was determined that both parties knew each other and were confused as to when the business opened. They were asked to leave and return in the afternoon the next day.

**October 25, 2018**

An Officer was dispatched to Perry Township headquarters to assist OSP with entering the BAC room. Once at headquarters the Officer let the trooper and his arrestee in the building and completed a blood alcohol content test without incident.

**October 26, 2018**

Officers were dispatched to area of Fairway Drive concerning a traffic related issue. Once on scene, the Officer made contact the caller who stated an older male in a white van was driving at excessive speeds as he and his family were talking a walk. The license plate was recorded and the Sergeant on duty went to speak with the registered owner concerning the complaint.

**October 26, 2018**

An Officer on patrol in the area of 270 and SR315 came across a green station wagon that had stuck the guardrail. The Officer stopped to check on the driver who stated she was ok. The officer then contacted Sharon Township Police for a crash report, as it was within that jurisdiction.

Officers were requested to respond to the area of Linworth Road and Olentangy River Road to assist Sharon Township Police with an injury crash. While on scene Officers assisted with traffic control and clearing of the roadway as medics and Sharon Township took care of the involved parties.

A Columbus man was placed under arrest after causing an injury crash in the area of U33/Riverside Dr. and Hayden Road. After the Officers attended to all involved parties it was determined the he did not have a license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**October 28, 2018**

Officers were dispatched the 8300 block of Evangeline Dr on report of an open door. Officers arrived and spoke to the caller who stated she came to her parent's home to check on it while they are away in Florida and found the front door to be open. She stated the neighbors were also checking on the home while they were out of town. Officers entered and found no one inside and nothing appeared to be out of place at that time.

Officers were dispatched the 1300 block of Candlewood Dr on report of theft. The Officer arrived and spoke to the caller who stated she is checking on her mother's home while she is away in Europe. She further stated her mother hired some workers who were to do some home repairs that appear to not have been completed but the keys are now missing. Once on scene the Officers spoke to employees from Ross Drywall who stated they entered the building but did not get the alarm turned off fast enough.
