Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township  
**Month of January 2019**

**January 1, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 8000 block of Golfview Ct on a suspicious person knocking on windows. When Officers arrived, they found no signs of anyone in the area. High winds were reported that day. The homeowner was asked to call if she heard anything again.

**January 1, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 1100 block of Clubview Blvd on a mailbox that was struck by a vehicle. Security cameras caught the vehicle description but not the color or the plate number.

**January 3, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 6600 block of Millbrae Road after the resident called the Administrative Assistant reporting a domestic dispute. Officers spoke to caller who stated she and her daughter were having a verbal argument and denied any physical violence. She was given some pamphlets and referral information for family assistance.

**January 4, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to 7000 block of Candlewood Lane as requested by ICAC to standby while a search warrant was being executed.

**January 5, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Clubview Blvd South on a business alarm. Once on scene all doors and windows were checked and all was found to be secure. An alarm notice was left on the front door.

**January 5, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the area of Fairway Dr and Park Ridge Dr on a report of a suspicious male walking around. Officers arrived and searched the area but were unable to locate anyone matching the descriptions given.

**January 5, 2019**

An Officer was dispatched to the area of Hayden Run Rd and Riverside Dr on a non-injury crash. The Officer arrived, found the crash within the City of Columbus and spoke with both drivers. They both acknowledged exchanging information but the non-at fault driver wanted an Officer to see what happened. The officer noted no visible damages and told the driver he would have to contact Columbus Police since it was in their jurisdiction. At that time, she stated she didn't want to wait on Columbus Police to respond.

**January 5, 2019**

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Sawmill Rd and SR 161 for a traffic control violation. After further review of the driver's information she was found to be driving on a temporary permit. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court after a licensed driver over the age of 21 arrived.

**January 8, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Drive and Lane Ave on an accident. Upon arrival it was determined that a vehicle struck a deer. The individual that struck the deer refused an accident report. Both Officers cleared the scene.

**January 9, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to 3400 block Woodview Pl on a domestic dispute. The caller stated that her husband is verbally abusive towards her and is on a lot of drugs and is an alcoholic. The husband was not home at the time. The Officers provided her with information on how to get assistance.

**January 9, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to assist the county on an accident on 270 and 315. It was determined it was a one car accident. The Officers went back on patrol.

**January 11, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of McVey Boulevard on a trespassing complaint. When the Officers arrived on the scene, they spoke with the caller who requested to have another person given a trespass warning so this person would not return to his home or place of business. Contact was made with a Powell man who stated he would not return.

**January 11, 2019**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bethel Rd and Dierker Rd for an expired registration violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**January 12, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd on a disabled vehicle. Officers located a disabled US Postal Service truck on the side of the road. The employee stated a tow truck would be coming at a later time to take the vehicle to get repairs. The employee was then given a courtesy transport back to the 6000 block of Emerald Parkway.

**January 12, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd on a report of suspicious people. The caller stated two males were attempting to break into a US postal service vehicle. Officers were dispatched to the area of Linworth Rd and Meeklyn Dr on a blocking disabled vehicle. Officers arrived and located a truck that was in the ditch and no one around it. The truck appeared to have slid off the roadway due to weather conditions. The owner was contacted and they stated AAA would be arriving hours later and they didn't have time to wait. Officers offered to call another tow for the owner and he accepted.

**January 14, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 5000 block of Henderson Heights Rd on report of a domestic violence complaint. Officers arrived and found evidence of a physical altercation which resulted in the arrest of a Columbus woman. The woman was then processed and transported to the Franklin County jail to be slated.

**January 14, 2019**

An Officer was dispatched to meet with a caller in the 6800 block of Perry Dr concerning a motor vehicle accident that happened at State Route 161 and Linworth Rd. The caller reported the crash as being a hit skip accident. The officer reported no visible damage could be seen at the time.

**January 14, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Dr and Lane Road on a disabled vehicle. Officers arrived on scene and located a Honda blocking the roadway. The Officer was able to call a tow truck for the motorist to get the vehicle moved out of the roadway.

**January 15, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 800 block of Blindbrook Dr on an alarm drop. Upon arrival it was discovered that the cleaning crew set the alarm off. Officers then cleared.

**January 16, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 4700 block of Shuster Rd on an alarm drop. When Officers arrived, they found employees were on scene. The employees were not sure why the alarm went off. Officers then cleared and returned to patrol.

**January 16, 2019**

Officers were dispatched the 7900 block of Fairway Dr on a 911 hang-up. When Officers arrived, they discovered that it was caused by a cordless phone with low battery.

**January 16, 2019**

An Officer conducted a traffic stop On Riverside Dr near Fishinger Rd. It was discovered that the owner was driving with a suspended license. He was cited for driving with a suspended license, not having a license and for not signaling. He was released on a summons to appear in court. The vehicle was released to his girlfriend.

**January 17, 2019**

A township resident came into Police Headquarters and dropped off paperwork belonging to his daughter's ex-boyfriend who she had a combative interaction with. He requested that the paperwork be left in police custody so that owner (the boyfriend) could pick them up there instead of the resident's home. The Columbus man was contacted to come in and pick up his paperwork. When

he arrived and his identification was verified, it was discovered he had an active warrant out of Franklin County Municipal Court. He was able to post bond on line and released with his paperwork.

**January 20, 2019**

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Sawmill Rd and Snouffer Rd after a registration check showed the owner as having a suspended driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**January 20, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 2300 block of W. Dublin Granville Rd on a residential alarm. Officers arrived, checked all the doors and windows, and found no evidence of entry and everything seemed to be secure. An alarm notice was left on the door for the homeowner.

**January 20, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 6000 block of McVey Blvd at the Brookside Elementary school on a business alarm. Officers arrived and checked all the doors and windows. They found the building to be secure. A notice at was left on the door for the building manager.

**January 20, 2019**

An Officer was on patrol in the area of State Route 161 and the railroad tracks when he came across what appeared to be a fire on the tracks. The fire department arrived and checked the area and found that CSX had started the fire via propane to warm the track switches to keep them operational. All departments cleared after it was determined to be a safe burn.

The driver of the snowplow stated his supervisor requested Ohio Highway Patrol take the crash report as their policy states that's who needed to do it. The Officer requested OSP to respond to the scene. OSP arrived and took a crash report.

**January 24, 2019**

An Officer was flagged down in the area of 7000 Sawmill Rd and was told a vehicle was blocking the intersection of Sawmill Rd and Billingsley Rd. The Officer went and checked on the vehicle and found it had been involved in a crash with a traffic sign, which caused the car to be immobilized. The Officer called for Columbus Police and waited on scene until they arrived.

**January 25, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 1500 block of Clubview Blvd North on a neighbor dispute. Officers arrived and spoke with a caller who stated her neighbor to the rear of her house came and complained about her dog barking. She also told Officers that her neighbor opened a rear door to her house and let the dog in. The caller just wanted the incident documented in case there were future issues.

**January 25, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 7000 block of Cimarron Station to assist Columbus Police Department on an individual with a knife. Once on scene, it was determined a Columbus man was attempting to harm himself. He was then transported to Riverside Hospital for a mental health evaluation.

**January 25, 2019**

A Westerville man was stopped in the area of Linworth Rd and West Dublin Granville Rd for an equipment violation. The owner's driver's license was expired and a check showed him having two possible felony warrants through Delaware County Sheriff's Office. The man was subsequently identified and placed under arrest for the felony warrants. He was then transported to a relay location where custody was transferred to the Delaware County Sheriff's Office.

**January 25, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of Darwin Rd on report of identity theft. The Officer arrived on scene and the caller explained someone had put a cable bill in his name in the city of Dayton. He called the credit company who advised him to file a police report.

**January 26, 2019**

Officers were on patrol in the area of Sawmill Rd near Hard Rd when they came across a non-injury crash within the City of Columbus. While speaking with a Columbus man, he stated he was driving one of the vehicles but did not have a driver's license. After checking his information, he was found to have a valid warrant thru the City of Hilliard. Columbus arrived and took the crash report as Perry officers took custody of the man with warrants. He was then transported to a relay location and custody transferred to the City of Hilliard.

**January 26, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 2400 block of Darwin Dr on an open door. Once on scene, Officers were met by a concerned neighbor who stated that the dog belonging to his neighbors is out running around. He stated he attempted to make contact with his neighbors via phone but was unsuccessful so he decided to call the police. Not long after, the homeowner arrived home and advised they must have accidentally left the door unlocked which ended up being blown open by the wind.

**January 26, 2019**

A Columbus man was stopped for a traffic control device violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**January 27, 2019**

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Bethel Rd and Reed Rd for an expired registration violation. After further reviewing the driver's information she was found to not possess a driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**January 28, 2019**

**A Dublin man was stopped in the area of US 33 / Riverside Dr and Lane Road after random registration checks showed the owner having a suspended driver's license. The owner was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.**

**Officers assisted the Columbus Police Department with the capture of two suspects who fled on foot through Brookside Estates.
