Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of February 2019

February 2, 2019

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of 1200 Candlewood Dr for expired registration violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

February 2, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the 1400 block of Clubview Blvd South on a report of shots being fired south of that address. Officers arrived and circulated thru the area but nothing was seen or heard.

February 2, 2019

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Trabue Rd and Lake Shore Dr after a random registration check showed the owner having possible warrants for his arrest. After the warrants were verified, the man was then subsequently placed under arrest and transported to the Franklin County jail.

February 3, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of Oakview Dr on a residential alarm with glass breakage. Officers arrived, checked the exterior of the home and found it to be secure and no glass broken.

February 3, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Riverside Dr on a disturbance. Officers arrived and found a male and female both intoxicated and outside. They were having a verbal dispute after a concert. The female was upset about her phone being broken. She stated she just wanted to go home. She was given a courtesy transport to a friend's home and released to a sober person.

February 4, 2019

An Officer was on patrol in the area of Hard Rd and Stanburn Rd when he came across what appeared to be a crash involving two vehicles. After stopping to check on the drivers, it was determined the crash was actually a pedestrian struck in the roadway. The crash occurred within the City of Columbus's jurisdiction, so Columbus officers and medics were called to the scene. The Officer stood by to assist until their arrival.

February 5, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the 1600 block of Crusoe Dr on an assistance for Delaware County. Officers were asked if a specific individual lived at that address. There was no one by that name living there. Officers went back on patrol.

February 7, 2019

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bethel Rd and Olentangy River Rd after random registration check showed the owner having a suspended license. After verifying the driver being the owner he was cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

February 7, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the Worthington Hills Elementary School to assist medics with a child who lost consciousness. After medics arrived and evaluated him, his mother arrived as well. Medics suggested the juvenile be released to the mother so she could have him examined by a doctor.

February 8, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Scioto View Ln on a theft from a motor vehicle. Officers arrived and were told a generator was stolen from a work vehicle that was parked in the parking lot.

February 8, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the 8200 block of Fairway Dr on a call to assist medics. The Officer arrived on scene and medics were already taking care of the patient and were ready to clear the scene so the Officer's assistance was not needed.

February 8, 2019

He said he had no money for the tow and he abandoned his vehicle and left the scene. The car was impounded by Capital Towing.
