**Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township**  
**Month of March 2019**

**March 1, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 5300 block of Riverside Dr on a domestic dispute. Officers arrived but were unable to make contact with anyone in the apartment in question. Officers also did not hear any noise or talking coming from inside. Officers contacted management concerning the complaint, they stated the actual complaint was earlier in the day and no other information was provided.

**March 1, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 8000 block of Evangeline Dr on animal complaint. Officers arrive and spoke with the homeowner who stated a skunk was dying in his driveway and he was not sure of how to deal with it. Officers assisted the man in taking care of it.

**March 1, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 6700 block of Merwin Rd East on a residential alarm. Officers arrived on scene and checked all exterior doors and windows. The home was found to be secure and an alarm notice was left for the homeowner.

**March 3, 2019**
