Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of April 2019

April 2, 2019

An Officer made a traffic stop near Sawmill Rd and Billingsley Rd for a tag violation. It was discovered that the driver had no driver's license and had two traffic warrants through Columbus Police. She was taken into custody and transported to Jackson Pike Jail. The vehicle was impounded by Capital Towing for safe keeping.

April 3, 2019

An Officer conducted a traffic stop near Sawmill Rd and Snouffer Rd for a traffic offense. It was discovered that the driver only had a temporary permit. The driver was cited for a marked lanes violation, no driver's license and a permit violation. The driver was cited into court. The vehicle was driven away by a licensed driver.

April 3, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the area of West Case Rd on a harassment call. The caller indicated that someone was attempting to pull him over that was not a police officer. The offense occurred in Sharon Township so the investigation was turned over to them. No further help was requested by the Sharon Township Police.

April 4, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the Brookside area on a door-to-door salesman. Upon arrival, Officers found a man hanging fliers on the doors. He was advised to stop until he received a permit. He agreed and left the area.

April 5, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the area of US 33 / Riverside Drive and Canterbury Road on a blocking disabled vehicle. The Officers arrived in the area and located the vehicle on the northbound side of the road. Officers were able to push the vehicle off the roadway to a safe waiting area until a tow truck arrived to.

April 5, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the 8400 block of Netherlands Place on a report of a suspicious person. Officers arrived and made contact with a man that was sitting in his vehicle on the street in front of the address. He was found to work for a painting company. After the information was verified, the Officer cleared the scene.

April 5, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the area of Newcomer Dr and Markhaven Rd on a report of shots fired in the area. Officers arrived and search the area surrounding the callers' home. Nothing was seen or heard during the time that the Officers were in the area.

April 6, 2019

An Officer located a cell phone case while working special duty in the area of US 33 and Fishinger Road. The cell phone case contained a driver's license and other personal information. The property was impounded for safekeeping.

April 6, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the area of 2500 Scioto View Lane on a suspicious person. Officers arrived and searched the area but could not locate anyone matching the description given.

April 7, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of Brookdown Rd on report of road rage incident that occurred on SR315; and then they were followed home. Officers arrived and spoke to the callers who had a license plate number of who followed them home. Contact was made with the owner and both parties agreed to make no further contact with the other.

April 7, 2019

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Linworth Road and SR 161 for a traffic control device violation. After further reviewing the driver's information she was found to have a suspended license and an active warrant out of Grove City Ohio. The woman was subsequently arrested and cited. After posting bond, she was released on a summons to appear in court.

April 7, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the 2300 block of West Dublin Granville Road on report of a gas leak. Police and Fire department personnel arrived on scene and it was determined to be sewage odor.

April 8, 2019

An Officer on patrol in the area of US 33/ Riverside Dr and Fishinger Road came across a blocking disabled vehicle. The Officer was able to assist the driver with getting the vehicle pushed off the roadway to a safe location to wait for tow truck to arrive.

April 8, 2019

An Officer was flagged down and notified about a man walking illegally in the roadway on US 33/Riverside Dr just north of Lane Road. The Officer located the person matching the description given. After checking the man's information through LEADS, he was found to have several active warrants for his arrest. He was arrested and slated at the Franklin County Jail.

April 9, 2019

An Officer conducted a traffic stop for a speed violation. While checking the driver through LEADS, it was discovered that the he was under a random selection BMV suspension. He was cited into court. The vehicle was impounded by Capital Towing for safe keeping.

April 10, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the 1100 block of Circle on the Green on a suspicious vehicle that has been parked in front of the residence for four days without moving. Officers placed a twenty-four-hour sticker on it. An attempt was made to contact the owner but there was no answer. A voicemail was left. The vehicle was moved by the next morning.

April 12, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the 2900 block of Snouffer Road on a domestic dispute. Officers arrived and were able to determine no violence had occurred. All parties come to agreement that it would be best if they just separated for the night. Two people was transported to a nearby gas station to meet a ride.

April 12, 2019

The officers checked the area but were unable to locate any vehicles matching the descriptions given.

Officers were dispatched to the Worthington Hills Country Club on a hold up alarm. Perry Officers and Sharon Township officers arrived on scene and found the Country Club to be secure.

April 12, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the 1600 block of Tennyson Court on report of bones behind the caller's home. Officers arrived and were able to determine the bones belonged to a large deer. No human bones or remains were found.

Officers were dispatched to an injury crash involving a motorcyclist in the area of 3300 Riverside Drive. Officers arrived and medics were already on scene and had 2 people in separate medic units. It was determined that the driver of the motorcycle was under the influence of alcohol prior to him being transported to the hospital. The Columbus man was cited and issued a summons to appear in court.

April 14, 2019

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road near Reflections Dr for a speeding violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to not have a valid driver's license. He could only provide the officer with a Guatemalan Identification Card. The man was cited and released on a summons to appear in court and his car was impounded.

Officers were dispatched to Brookside Elementary school on an alarm drop on West door number 3. The Officers arrived on scene and found the door to be locked but not completely secured which allowed the wind to blow it open. That door was re-secured. All other doors were checked and found to be secure.

Officers were dispatched to the 2700 block of McVey West on an open door found by the resident when they returned home. When Officers arrived at the house, they were met by the home owner who advised that the door was closed when she left and open when she returned. They checked the house and found no one in the house and nothing appeared to be missing. The Officers cleared the scene.

April 18, 2019

After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. An odor of marijuana was also detected and the man was subsequently arrested for possession of drug paraphernalia and marijuana. The man was cited and released on a summons to appear in court for the traffic and criminal charges. The vehicle was impounded.

April 19, 2019

An Officer was dispatched to the 5000 block of Riverside Drive on the possible mail scam. The Officer arrived and spoke with a caller who provided them with a letter from Columbia Gas which stated there would be an upgrade to their gas service. The homeowner felt this was suspicious since they did not have gas service at their home. The letter was impounded for further investigation. After contacting Columbia Gas, it was learned that this was a form letter sent to every address in this area to advise of impending gas line upgrades.

April 19, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the 2400 block of McVey Court on a residential motion alarm. When Officers arrived, they made contact with a homeowner who stated everything was OK and advised it was a false alarm.

April 20, 2019

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Bethel Road and Sawmill Road for a speeding violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court. His vehicle was impounded.

April 21, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the 8000 block of Fairway Dr on a barking dog complaint. The Officer arrived and spoke to both parties and was able to resolve the issue.

April 21, 2019

The items were collected by the Bomb Squad for future destruction.

April 22, 2019

Officers were dispatched to the area of SR 161 and Nicholas Drive on a crash. Offices arrived and found an elderly woman who had simply driven into the ditch. Assistance was provided to her and she refused to get checked at a nearby hospital. A caregiver was then called to pick her up.

April 22, 2019

Officers came across a four-car crash in the area of Sawmill Road at Sawmill Place within the city of Columbus. Columbus police were requested to respond to complete the crash report. Perry Township Officers assisted with traffic until the scene was clear.

April 22, 2019

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Henderson Road and Sawmill Road for a speeding violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to have a suspended license and valid felony warrants for his arrest. He was cited for the traffic violation and arrested, transported and slated at the Franklin County Jail on the felony warrants.

Officers were dispatched to this 6900 block of Smokey Row Rd on an accident that was blocking the roadway. Officers arrived and it was determined the crash occurred within Columbus City jurisdiction. The Columbus Police Department was notified and responded to the scene to complete a crash report.

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Sawmill Road and Krier Drive for an expired registration violation. After further reviewing her information she was found to have valid felony warrants. She was subsequently arrested and transported to and slated at Franklin county jail.
