Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township  
**Month of July 2019**

### **July 1, 2019**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Henderson Road west of Charlbury Dr for a speeding violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to have several open suspensions on his license. The man was then cited and released with a summons to appear in court.

### **July 2, 2019**

Officers responded to a resident who is worried about their neighbor on Colony Way. The neighbor is acting strange when she is outside. The Officer contacted a family member, who is aware of the issue. The Officer informed the resident that extra patrols will be done on all shifts.

### **July 2, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to an accident on Hayden Run and Riverside Drive. Officers arrived on scene and worked traffic for Columbus Police while they worked on the accident report. Officers then cleared.

### **July 3, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to an accident in the 2700 block of W Dublin Granville Road. Upon their arrival, one of the parties involved stated that the driver of the other vehicle involved provided info then drove off. The individual just wanted something documented on a report.

### **July 3, 2019**

An Officer was dispatched to the 6600 block of Merwin Road on a disabled vehicle. The driver wanted the Officer to push his vehicle into another driveway. Because the driver had pulled into the yard of a private resident, the Officer was not comfortable driving through the yard. The Officer offered to call a tow truck, however the driver called for a private tow.

### **July 3, 2019**

An Officer conducted a traffic stop for an expired plate violation. It was discovered that the driver had an expired license as well. The driver was charged with not having a license and expired plates.

### **July 5, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of Oakview Drive on report of a theft from a motor vehicle. When the Officer arrived on scene it was explained that overnight sometime, someone entered two unlocked vehicles in the driveway. Several small valuable items were reported stolen.

**July 5, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of Clubview Boulevard on vandalism and theft from a motor vehicle. When the officer arrived, the homeowner stated her vehicle was entered and CDS were stolen. There were also multiple items damaged including the vehicle's exterior and other recreational items in the driveway.

**July 5, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 6000 block of McVey Boulevard regarding found property. Once on scene the Officer was met by the caller who stated when she returned home, she found a purse at the end of her driveway. The Officer took the purse for safekeeping. An attempt to locate and return the purse was unsuccessful. The purse was impounded until the owner can be located.

**July 5, 2019**

An Officer on patrol in the area of US 33 / Riverside Drive and Hayden Run Road came across a stranded motorist partially blocking the roadway. The Officer made contact with the motorist who stated that the vehicle just died, so a tow truck was contacted. The Officer laid flares behind the vehicle as a precautionary until the tow truck could arrive.

**July 6, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 6700 block of McVey Boulevard at the Brookside Elementary School on a complaint of juveniles playing on the playground and setting off fireworks. The Officer arrived and did locate juveniles who were playing on the playground and made contact with them. The juveniles acknowledged having set off some firecrackers and a bottle rocket but stated they didn't have any more and apologized for causing a problem. They were advised to not let off firecrackers in the future. They acknowledged they understood and they all left to head home.

**July 6, 2019**

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of 6700 McVey Boulevard for a speeding violation. After further reviewing the driver's information she was found to have a suspended driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**July 7, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Colony Way on a dispute between neighbors.

**July 7, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 6000 block of McVey Boulevard on a nature unknown call. Officers were sent from a transfer from Columbus Police Department on an open line with a woman in the background who sounded distressed. Officers arrived and were unable to make contact with anyone at the address that was given. Dispatchers were able to contact a female on the number but she was very uncooperative and would not give a correct address and stated she was fine and going to bed.

**July 8, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 2700 block of West Dublin Granville Road at the Brookside Country Club on a business alarm. Officers arrived and checked all exterior doors and windows. An unlocked door was located and officers made contact with the kitchen manager once inside. The manager was in the process of closing procedures and tripped the alarm due to the door being left slightly open. The kitchen manager then secured the door and locked up for the night.

**July 9, 2019**

An Officer was dispatched to the 1000 block of Circle on The Green on an assistance. The driver had locked himself out of his truck. Upon arrival the Officer gained entry to a locked Fed Ex truck, the driver's keys were inside.

**July 9, 2019**

An Officer was dispatched to Riverside Drive and McCoy Road on a traffic light complaint. Upon arrival the Officer noticed the traffic light partially obstructed by a tree branch. The Officer asked dispatch to notify ODOT to have the matter resolved.

**July 9, 2019**

An Officer was on routine patrol when he noticed a street sign at Kempton Run leaning into the roadway. A Columbus city crew was notified.

**July 9, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of W Dublin Granville Road on an alarm drop for Worthington Police. Officers met with a manager who said one of his employees accidentally set the alarm. Officers then cleared.

**July 9, 2019**

An Officer conducted a traffic stop due to not displaying a County of residence sticker. During the stop, it was discovered that the driver had a suspended license as well as a warrant through Dublin Police. She was cited for driving under suspension, no license, and not having a county sticker. She was taken to jail by Dublin Police.

**July 10, 2019**

An Officer was dispatched to meet with Columbus Police. They had responded to a verbal dispute and entered the individual via LEADS and discovered an active warrant through Perry Twp Police. The individual was transported to Franklin county jail.

**July 10, 2019**

An Officer was dispatched to the 900 block of Clubview Blvd. on a theft from a vehicle. Several items were removed from an unlocked vehicle. There are no known suspects at this time.

**July 10, 2019**

An Officer was dispatched to assist another agency of a non-injury traffic crash. The Officer directed traffic until the proper jurisdiction arrived.

**July 15, 2019**

An Officer on patrol in the area of Sawmill Road and Snouffer Road noticed wires hanging over the roadway. Columbus fire arrived shortly after and stated they were telecommunication lines so they were not going to take any action to secure them. There were also wires hanging on the other side of the road within the city of Dublin. Dublin Fire department was contacted and arrived to secure the wires, but did so on both sides of the roadway. A Columbus officer remained at the scene to wait for AT&T to repair the lines on the Columbus side.

**July 17, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 7900 block of Fairway on an alarm drop. Officers found an open door and did a search of the house and found no signs of forced entry.

**July 17, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Shoreline Dr on people trespassing and fishing. When Officers made identification of the two people, they found one having a felony warrant through another county. Officers arrested the subject and transported him to Franklin County Jail.

**July 18, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the area of 315 and Hard Road to assist Sharon Township with an injury crash.

**July 18, 2019**

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of 2000 Snouffer Road for an equipment violation. After further evaluating the driver's information she was found to have a suspended driver's license; the woman was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**July 18, 2019**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Snouffer Road and Sawmill Road for an expired registration violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**July 19, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Drive and Hayden Run Road on an injury crash. When the Officers arrived on scene it was determined the crash occurred within the city of Columbus police jurisdiction. Officers stayed on scene to assist with traffic control until Columbus police arrived and then cleared.

**July 20, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of Snouffer Road on a head on injury hit skip crash. The at fault driver took off on foot. When the Officers arrived, they found the crash had actually occurred within the City of Columbus jurisdiction. Officers were able to locate the at fault driver moments later and turned him over to Columbus police on their arrival.

**July 20, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 1100 block of Clubview Boulevard North on residential alarm. Officers arrived and made contact with the homeowner who stated their home alarm was no longer in use but still hooked up to a phone line. The alarm was determined to be accidental.

**July 20, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the Brookside Country Club on a business alarm on the fitness center. When Officers arrived on scene, they did find several doors left unlocked. The Officers went inside and searched the building and found everything appeared to be as normal. The food director was in the main building and walked over and was able to reset the alarm.

**July 22, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the area of I-270 and Sawmill Road on an Officer in trouble call involving a Columbus Police Officer that had a domestic violence suspect at gunpoint. The Officer's emergency response was canceled shortly prior to our arrival. The Officer stayed on scene until Columbus police stated they no longer needed assistance.

**July 22, 2019**

Officers were notified of an Officer in trouble call from Columbus Police in the area of 5900 Britton Parkway. The K-9 officer arrived and stayed on scene and assisted with a resisting suspect keeping the K-9 tethered throughout the incident.

**July 22, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the Brookside Country Club fitness center on a business alarm. Several doors were found to be unlocked. The officers searched the inside of the fitness center and found everything to be in place as usual.

**July 22, 2019**

An Officer who was on patrol in the area of Bethel Road and Godown Road did a random check on a black Jeep. The check returned showing the vehicle as stolen. The Officer pursued the vehicle and it ended up crashing in the area of Henderson Road and High street.

**July 23, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of West Dublin Granville Road on a 911 hang up. When Officers arrived, everything checked out to be OK. Officers cleared.

**July 23, 2019**

An Officer was conducting a business check at the 2500 Of Riverside Drive when he observed several vehicles that had the windows broken out.

**July 23, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Olde Hill Court on an assistance. The caller, who was not at this location, wanted the police to walk around her car to see if any damage was done. This request was out of a dispute with her roommate. Everything appeared to be OK.

Officers were dispatched to the 5000 block of Henderson Road on a missing person's report. The officers arrived on scene and began gathering information concerning the homeowner's adult daughter who was last seen the night before. While the Officer was there gathering information for a report, the daughter actually called and informed the parents that she was fine and would be home shortly.

**July 25, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 1100 block of Clubview Boulevard South on an assistance to the fire department. Dispatch stated the call was concerning an ill person that was unresponsive. Officers arrived along with Worthington medics. One of the homeowners was transported to a nearby hospital for evaluation in stable condition.

**July 25, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the intersection of Riverside Drive and Fishinger Road concerning a malfunctioning traffic light. Officers arrived and provided traffic control until the signal pattern could be corrected.

**July 25, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 7900 block of Greenside Lane on a residential alarm. Officers arrived and spoke with the homeowner's brother-in-law who stated he was asked to check on the home and he was unaware the alarm was on.

**July 25, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 3700 block of Snouffer Road on property that was found. The officer arrived and spoke with the new manager who took over the Store All and found a cremation box with human remains while cleaning. The funeral home information that was listed on the box was contacted by the Officer. The funeral director stated he would be willing to take possession of the remains and place them in a final resting place.

**July 26, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the area of US 33 / Riverside Dr and Fishinger Road on a complaint concerning the traffic signal malfunctioning. Officers blocked off the turning lane and notified ODOT to have a crew respond.

**July 26, 2019**

An Officer on patrol in the area of State Route 161 and Linworth Road came across a blocking disabled motorist. The Officer stopped to check on the motorist who stated his transmission went out and he had already called for a tow truck. Shortly after AAA arrived and was able to get the roadway clear.

**July 26, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 2600 block of Snouffer Place on a suspicious person. Dispatch stated the caller had a baseball hat with a head lamp attached while walking through his driveway. Officers arrived and circulated the area but were unable to locate anyone matching the description given.

Officers were dispatched to the 6800 block of McVey Boulevard on an assistance to Delaware County S.O. Officers were requested to make contact with a vehicle owner to request its whereabouts. That information was then passed on to Delaware County pertaining to their request.

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Blindbrook Drive on two incidents: an assault and a possible suicidal female. Officers arrived and spoke with all parties involved. The suspects in the assault are unknown at this time and fled the area prior to Officer's arriving. A female was transported to an area hospital for evaluation. A male was also transported to another hospital for injuries sustained out of the assault.

**July 28, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the Perry Township headquarters to assist Columbus police with access to the BAC machine. Columbus police arrived with their suspect and performed a breath test without incident.

**July 28, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Drive and Fishinger Road on an Officer in trouble call on a Columbus police officer with a suspect at gun point. Officers arrived and found Columbus police was able to take the suspect, who was resisting, into custody just before our arrival.

**July 28, 2019**

A Dublin man was stopped in the area of Henderson Road and Charlbury Drive for an expired registration violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to not have a valid license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**July 30, 2019**

Officer responded to an alarm drop at 6700 McVey Blvd. Workers were running wire in the administration office. The drop was accidental.

**July 30, 2019**

Officers were called to the area of Riverside Dr. and West Case Rd. on a traffic light complaint. When Officers arrived, the light was functioning properly.

**July 30, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 1600 block of Gables Court on a domestic dispute between mother and daughter. It was all verbal nothing physical. Both Officers cleared the scene.

**July 30, 2019**

Officer was dispatched to the 1500 block of Treadway Place on a theft from a vehicle. The caller states that she was at the pool. When she got home, she got a text alert indicating someone used her credit cards. There are no known suspects at this time.
