Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township  
**Month of September 2019**

### **September 1, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of Scioto View Lane on someone attempting to open the caller's door. Officers arrived and searched the area but could not locate anyone matching the description given. No signs of attempted forced entry were found.

### **September 1, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of Clubview Boulevard South on a tree that was blocking the roadway. Officers arrived and contacted Perry Township Road Department to cut up and remove the large tree so that roadway could be re-opened.

### **September 1, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the area of State Route 161 and Linworth Rd to assist with traffic control due to power lines down. Officers arrived and blocked the roadway so that AEP crews could replace the power lines and utility pole.

### **September 2, 2019**

Officer were dispatched to the 900 block of Clubview Blvd North on a business alarm. Upon arrival, Officers spoke with closing staff who stated they were not the normal crew and did not have the code to set the alarm since the cleaning crew would not be in.
