Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township  
**Month of November 2019**

### **November 1, 2019**

A Powell woman was stopped in the area of Hayden Run Rd and Riverside Dr after failing to stop for a red signal. After further reviewing the driver's information she was found to have a suspended driver's license. She further showed having active warrants for her arrest. She was subsequently arrested and posted bond on scene. She was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

### **November 1, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 6700 block of Merwin Road on a suspicious vehicle. The caller stated hours prior, the driver of said vehicle was slowly driving down the street attempting to open garage doors with a handheld garage door opener. The caller had no other information other than the vehicle being a dark color SUV. A report for documentation was taken.

### **November 1, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 6500 block of and McVey Blvd on a suspicious vehicle. The Officer arrived and spoke with a caller who stated she believed it was the father of a juvenile who assaulted her son. She stated the vehicle followed her to school that day but never made contact with her. An information report was taken for documentation.

### **November 1, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the area of State Route 315 North of Hard road on an assistance to Sharon township police with an injury accident involving a single car. Officers arrived and assisted until the roadway was cleared.

### **November 2, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 8400 block of Evangeline Drive on an assistance to the medics. Officers arrived and medics were already on scene assisting the homeowner. Medics stated Officer assistance was not needed at this time.

### **November 2, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 3000 block of Greenvale Drive on an animal complaint. Officers arrived and spoke to the caller who stated the neighbor's dog came running out and intimidated him but did not bite him. Officers made contact with a woman at the home where the dog resided who stated she was house sitting for the homeowners who were on vacation. She opened the door to exit and the dog ran out. She stated it was accidental and would not happen again. An informational report was taken for documentation.

### **November 3, 2019**

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of Sawmill Rd and West Dublin Granville Road for an expired registration violation. After further review of the driver's information he was found to have a suspended driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**November 4, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 3000 block of Greenvale Drive on a residential alarm. Officers arrived, checked all exterior doors and windows and found the home to be secure.

**November 4, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of Candlewood Drive on an assistance to the homeowner. The elderly homeowner requested a drive by to ensure the garage door was closed by his after-care home nurse. The Officer drove by and found the door to be closed.

**November 4, 2019**

A Columbus woman was stopped in the area of Henderson Road and Sawmill Road for a speeding violation. After further reviewing the driver's information she was found to not have a valid driver's license. The woman was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

**November 5, 2019**

An Officer responded to a Worthington Hills home on a fraud/forgery report. The victim was an 88-year-old male. Huntington Bank was notified. The Officer advised the victim that his case would be forwarded to the detectives to see if there is anything else that the police might be able to assist with.

**November 5, 2019**

An Officer conducted a traffic stop near Brookside Elementary School for a speeding violation. It was discovered that the driver had no driver's license and was also suspended. She was cited into court for driving under suspension, no driver's license and speed. The vehicle was impounded by Capital Towing.

**November 5, 2019**

An Officer responded to a report of an attempted fraud. The victim received a fraudulent check, but did not cash it. The Officer contacted the appropriate account holder of the check, who stated there has not been any loss of money at this time. Based on this, the account holder said there is no active investigations.

**November 5, 2019**

Officers responded to the 1300 block of Candlewood on an individual that was on the suicide hotline. His father transported the victim to Netcare to get mental health treatment.

**November 6, 2019**

An Officer assisted a Columbus Police Officer with an accident near 5900 block of Sawmill Road. The Officer held the scene until the proper jurisdiction arrived and assisted with traffic control.

**November 6, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 1600 block of Crusoe on a report of dogs being loose. Animal Control was the caller. The teenage resident advised she was unsure how the dogs got out. After speaking to the father of the teenage girl on the phone, he told us that it was probably his

black Lab who opened the door. The father stated the Lab has done this in the past. The dog was released to the daughter.

**November 7, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block Snouffer Place on a person suffering from mental illness. Upon arrival, one of the homeowners came to the door and stated the son was just extremely intoxicated and did not need Officer's assistance. After it was determined the man was safe, Officers then cleared the scene.

**November 7, 2019**

A Columbus woman came to Perry Headquarters to seek information on locating her missing brother-in-law who was staying in Lancaster, Ohio. She was advised to reach out to Fairfield County Sheriff's office to request a well-being check and to file a missing person report with them if he is not located.

**November 7, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the area of U.S. 33 and Fishinger Road on a disturbance in the roadway. Upon arrival they discovered a crash that resulted in the driver and a passenger in the other vehicle assaulting one another. All parties were separated, statements were taken and a report made for documentation. All parties were referred to the prosecutor's office. An accident report was taken and the at fault driver was cited.

**November 8, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Road on a disabled vehicle. Officers arrived and located a blocking vehicle and made contact with the driver who stated the battery died. An Officer stayed with the motorist until the tow truck arrived.

**November 8, 2019**

Officers were dispatched to area of 1300 Beechlake Dr on a suspicious vehicle and person. Officers arrived, located the home where this truck was parked and made contact with the homeowner who stated he hired outside contractors who owned the truck. The caller did not want to be seen.

**November 9, 2019**

Officers arrived and were met by a Dublin officer who stated it was domestic dispute only, nothing physical. Perry Officers stood by until additional Dublin Officers arrived on the scene.

Once on scene Officers began evacuating nearby houses for safety until the fire department and gas company arrived on the scene. After the Gas company arrived and was able to turn the gas off for the lines creating the large leak, homeowners were able to return to their homes without further incident.

An Officer conducted a traffic stop for a license plate violation at the 7100 block of Sawmill Road. A driver's license check revealed that the driver was driving on a suspended license. He was charged with Driving Under Suspension, not having a valid license, and expired plates.

The at fault driver, a Columbus woman, was found to be operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol. She was subsequently arrested, cited and summons to court. Multiple motorists were transported to area hospitals in stable condition for further evaluation.
