Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of March 2020

March 1, 2020

A Columbus man was stopped in the area of McVey Boulevard and Millbrae Road for an expired registration violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to also have an expired driver's license. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

March 2, 2020

A Columbus man was stopped in the 900 block of Bethel Road for an expired registration violation. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to be driving on a temporary permit. The man was then cited and released on a summons to appear in court.

March 2, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the area of US33/Riverside Dr and Lane Ave on a blocking tree in the roadway. Once on scene they found the tree had already been moved out of the roadway. No further action was required.

March 3, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 4700 block of Shuster Road. The caller stated that a gentleman was hired to work as a project manager. The individual was given \$3,600 in advance. The individual showed up for work one day and never returned. The case has been referred to the detectives.

March 3, 2020

The elderly resident fell out of her chair and the caregiver needed help in getting her off the floor. Officers and Medics assisted in getting the resident off the floor and into the Medic unit. She was transported to the hospital to be evaluated.

March 5, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of W. Dublin Granville Road on the report of a large pot hole that had caused damage to several vehicles. Officers arrived in the area and located the pothole. Cones and flares were placed around the hole and ODOT was called to fill the pot hole.
