Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of June 2020

June 1, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Darwin Dr on an outside disturbance. Officers arrived and found no disturbance. The homeowner stated her step child's parent was honking and beating on the door in an attempt to hurry the child along. Eventually the child got ready and left with the other parent.

June 1, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 8000 block of Golfview Court on a 911 hang up. Officers arrived and spoke to the elderly homeowner who stated she was OK and accidentally dialed 911 when trying to call 411.

June 1, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the area of 1300 Candlewood Drive on children playing with fireworks. Officers arrived, checked the area and found no children and no fireworks anywhere.

June 1, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of W. Dublin Granville Road to assist Worthington medics. Officers arrived and assisted until medics cleared the man who may have struck his head after suffering a medical attack. Officers parked his car and a family member arrived to pick the Columbus man up.

June 1, 2020

An Officer on patrol in the area of US33/Riverside Dr and Henderson Road came across a traffic signal not cycling properly. This has been an ongoing issue over the last few days. An ODOT supervisor was contacted and the light temporarily placed on red flashing in all directions till morning when ODOT will address the problem.

June 2, 2020

Officers were dispatched to Riverside Drive and Hayden Run on a suspicious person walking around covering his ears. Officers found the subject and discovered that he walked away from a learning center. The teacher called his mother and his mother picked him up on scene.

June 2, 2020

Officers were dispatched to a noninjury accident on Linworth Rd and 161. The at fault driver had no valid driver's license. He was cited for not having a license and ACDA.

June 3, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of W. Dublin Granville Road on a suspicious vehicle in the parking lot. There was a note on the windshield indicating that the vehicle broke down and will be towed away in the near future.

June 3, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of Candlewood Drive on a fireworks complaint. The caller stated that two boys were in her back yard in the woods letting off fireworks. The area was checked and two juvenile females were located by the creek, but no fireworks were found. Worthington City Schools were notified about possibly posting no trespassing signs since they own the property.

June 4, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the area of Hard Road and Smokey Row Road to assist a motorist with removing a cat from their engine. Officers arrived and with the assistance of several other people the kitten was successfully removed.

June 4, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Riverside Dr on report of a stolen bike. Information was collected to be passed on to the detective bureau for further investigation.

June 4, 2020

Information was passed on to officers concerning a business in the 2800 block of Riverside Dr. receiving threats. Multiple departments were notified just as a precaution.

June 5, 2020

An Officer on patrol in the area of I-270 and Sawmill Road and came across a disabled vehicle. The Officer was able to push the driver off the roadway to a safer location until the tow truck arrived.

June 5, 2020

The man was subsequently arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs. He was processed and charged then was released to a sober party.

June 5, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 4700 block of Shuster Road on a business alarm. Once on scene Officers were met by the cleaning crew who accidentally set the alarm off.

June 6, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 2700 block of W. Dublin Granville Rd on a business alarm. Officers arrived and found the club manager who stated everything was fine and the alarm being tripped was accidental.

June 6, 2020

Several juvenile victims were located and stated when they came across the adults fighting, the suspects chased them with a knife and pepper sprayed them. June 10, 2020

Officers were dispatched to an address in the area of W. Dublin Granville Road on a person with mental health issues. Franklin County Critical incident response team arrived and provided help and transported a person to a healthcare facility for help.

June 10, 2020

Officers were dispatched to several locations throughout the Township regarding storm damage downed powerlines, downed trees and a downed power transformer in the areas of Riverside Drive and McCoy Road, W. Dublin Granville Road, Brookbend Road, and other areas of Riverside Drive. The Road Department and the power company were notified and the area is being checked and cleared for citizen safety.

June 10, 2020

June 12, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the area 2300 block West Dublin Granville Road on a domestic dispute in a motor vehicle. Officers arrived and spoke to both parties who stated there was nothing physical. The female party just wanted the male to exit and separate for now. Officers provided the male a courtesy transport to another location and the female left the scene.

June 13, 2020

Officers helped with traffic control on a fatal accident involving a motorcycle in the area of Sawmill Road and Snouffer Road. Officers stayed on scene until they were relieved by the Columbus Police Accident Investigation Unit.

June 14, 2020

Officers were dispatched to a 911 call from a male that stated "never mind". Officers were not able to locate where the call came from and Columbus Police Dispatch was only able to give a location of somewhere close to the Worthington Hills Country Club. Officers checked the area and went back on patrol when they could not locate any trouble.

Officers were on patrol and on their way to Worthington Hills when Officers found a bicycle on the interstate I-270 just East of Sawmill Rd. The bicycle was removed from the lanes of travel and the Columbus Police Department was notified to retrieve the bicycle.

Officers were doing a vacation house check on a home located in Brookside Estates and found an open door. Officers made contact with the resident who stated that all was OK and they just finished moving in a few weeks ago. They asked to be removed from the house watch check list.

June 17, 2020

An Officer was dispatched to Riverside and Eastleft on a dead possum in the roadway. The Officer contacted dispatch to notify ODOT. The possum was not causing any traffic issue.

June 18, 2020

Officers were called to assist Dublin Police on a hit skip accident that occurred at Riverside and Martin Road. Officers were unable to locate the vehicle in question.

June 19, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the area of US33/Riverside Drive near West Case Road on a disabled vehicle. The Officer arrived and spoke with the motorist who stated he had a tow truck on the way because his car would not start. The Officer stood by until the tow truck arrived.

Officers arrived and spoke with the homeowner and her roommate concerning multiple dog attacks by the same dog in the area. The callers wanted police to be aware. On multiple occasions on this date, an Officer was dispatched to the Perry Township Police headquarters to assist Ohio State Highway Patrol with building access to use the alcohol breath testing machine on their arrestees. After the test were completed the Officer returned to patrol.

Officers were dispatched to the 1200 block of Northport Dr on a well-being check on a vehicle owner whose vehicle was found in a parking lot. Officers arrived and were able to make contact with the neighbors. They stated the person in question was just at home a moment before to pick up a second set of keys as she locked herself out of her vehicle. She was then contacted via phone and she was thankful to the department for checking on her.
