Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of July 2020

July 1, 2020

An Officer was dispatched to assist Franklin County Sheriff's Office on an overdose at the 6900 block of Rings Road. A female was transported to Dublin Methodist Hospital in stable condition.

July 2, 2020

Officers were dispatched to assist Sharon Township on an individual that was passed out behind the wheel. Sharon Township arrested the person for physical control and taken to Franklin County Jail. It was later determined that the vehicle the subject was asleep in was stolen out of Columbus. The vehicle was released to the owner.

July 2, 2020

An Officer on patrol in the area of Hayden Run Rd and Bethel Road came across an injury crash in the Columbus Police jurisdiction. Officers assisted on scene with traffic control until the roadway was able to cleared.

July 2, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 700 block of Old Woods Road on an alarm in Sharon Township for mutual aid. Officers arrived and found an unlocked door. Officers searched the interior and found the home to be in order and no one inside. Officers were able to secure the home prior to leaving the scene.

July 4, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Olde Hill Ct South on an unknown nature, with a person possibly down outside in the parking area. Officers arrived and searched the area but did not locate any one matching the description given and the caller refused to be seen.

July 5, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Clubview Boulevard South on a business alarm. Officers arrived, found an unlocked door, but after checking the interior found nothing disturbed and no signs of forced entry. Officers were able to secure the building.

July 5, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 4700 block of Schuster Road on a business alarm. Officers arrived and checked multiple exterior buildings. One building was found unlocked. The interior was checked and there were no signs of forced entry. The key holder returned to reset the alarm.

July 6, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the area of Snouffer Road on a property land dispute. Officers spoke with all parties involved and they were advised to contact the Franklin County Engineer's Office.

July 7, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the area of 2075 W. Dublin Granville Road, on a disabled vehicle blocking traffic. Officers arrived in the area and could not locate the vehicle.

Officers were dispatched to area of Riverside Drive and Lane Avenue on a disabled vehicle. July 9, 2020

An Officer on patrol in the area of Snouffer Road and Smokey Row Road came across a blocking disabled vehicle. The Officer stopped to check on the motorist who stated the vehicle died. The Officer was able to push the car out of the roadway to a safe location and request a tow truck.

July 10, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of Candlewood Drive on a lockout. Officers arrived and the resident stated he accidentally locked the doors. Officers were able to unlock the vehicle for the resident.

July 10, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the area of US33/Riverside Drive on a tree down blocking the roadway. Officers arrived, located the tree and were able to remove it from the road to allow traffic to move freely.

Once on scene the homeowner stated his dog took off hours ago and he was not able to get him in the house. Officers made attempts to catch the dog unsuccessfully; Franklin County Dog Warden was called to assist.

Officers were dispatched to the area of 161 and Linworth Road on a construction crew striking a gas line. Worthington Fire arrived on scene and able to shut the gas line off. Three hours later officers got called again on the same issue.

July 15, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the area of Scioto View Lane on a burglary in progress. Officers were told that suspects were breaking into a neighbor's condo. Officers arrived and made contact with the suspects who were an authorized construction crew working on the condo.

July 15, 2020

July 15, 2020

An officer was sitting in traffic in the area of Sawmill Road and I 270 in a marked cruiser and was rear-ended by another vehicle. Columbus Police Department arrived and took a crash report.

July 16, 2020

An officer was flagged down in the 7000 block of Sawmill Road by a Columbus man wanting to file a traffic complaint concerning his daughter who worked across the street in Columbus jurisdiction. Officers explained that we would need to call Columbus police department to come and speak with him but he declined.

Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Highview Boulevard on an injured deer with a broken leg. Officers arrived on scene and indicated the deer was the same one from a previous call days earlier. The deer was able to walk and jump over fences and ran away as officers approached.

Officers were dispatched to the area of US33/Riverside Dr and Stratford Dr on a disabled vehicle. Officers arrived and were able to assist with getting a tow truck to come change a tire for the stranded motorist. The Upper Arlington woman was then able to continue on her way.

July 17, 2020

July 18, 2020

July 21, 2020

An officer observed a disabled vehicle at Federated and State Route 161 while on routine patrol. The officer stayed with the motorist until help arrived.

July 22, 2020

Officers were dispatched to Perry Township Police Department to assist the Ohio State Highway Patrol on a person driving while intoxicated. Officers arrived and gave assistance. The intoxicated person was taken into custody by the State Highway Patrol.

July 23, 2020

A Columbus man was stopped for a speeding violation in the area of McVey Blvd and McVey Blvd West. After further reviewing the driver's information he was found to not have a valid driver's license. Franklin County Sheriff's office dispatchers also verified a valid warrant thru the City of Dublin. The man was cited for the appropriate violation and then transported to be slated at the Franklin County Jail.

July 23, 2020

Officers were dispatched to Perry Township headquarters on property found. The found items were a cell phone and a wallet. The wallet contained identifying information. Officers were able to locate the owner and return all the property.

July 24, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 7000 block of Candlewood Dr on report of possible fraudulent activity. Officers arrived and spoke to the caller who received Key Bank cards in their name that were attached to the Illinois Department of Unemployment that they did not order. They were advised by their bank to file a police report and the bank said they would put additional security on their accounts.

July 25, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the area of 6000 block of Merwin Road to assist Worthington Medics on an injured person from a fall. Officers arrived on scene and medics forced entry into the home when there were cries for help. The injured person was located and transported to the hospital officers cleared and went back on patrol.

July 25, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the Brookside Country Club on a report of an alarm. Officers arrived and determined that employees were still working and the alarm was false.

July 27, 2020

Officers were dispatched to contact via phone a resident in the 3000 block of Brookdown Dr on a barking dog complaint. Officers spoke to the man over the phone who stated he has attempted to correct the issue on his own by mailing the dog owner a letter about the barking, but the dog owner has not been responsive. The resident was looking for some guidance on how to proceed. He was told to call the Police when the dog is barking so Officers can make contact with the dog owner concerning the noise ordinance.

July 28, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the area of Hayden Road and Riverside Drive on a subject passed out in the driver's seat with a gun in his hand. Officers made contact with the subject and vehicle. Officers were able to safely disarm the subject while he was still passed out. The male subject was taken into custody and was given medical treatment by Columbus Fire Department Medic 11. The vehicle was reported stolen and the hand gun was reported stolen as well. Because of where the vehicle was located, inside the jurisdiction of the City of Columbus, the Columbus Police Department was notified. They arrived after the suspect was in custody and took the vehicle and male subject into their custody.

July 31, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 7000 block of Greenside Lane on report of a residential alarm. Offices arrived and made contact with a cleaning service that accidentally set the alarm off.

July 31, 2020

Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Bethel Road on a theft from a motor vehicle. Offices arrived and found evidence of forced entry into the victim's vehicle and several high dollar items missing. All information was collected to be forwarded to the detective's bureau.

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Riverside Dr on threats made to the resident. The Officer arrived and spoke to the caller who stated he received threats via Instagram from a co-worker. Information was taken for documentation purposes.
