Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of June 2022



Jun 2

Officer was flagged down in front of headquarters by a motorist who asked the officer for directions to the nearest hospital. Driver was from out of town, so officer guided the motorist to Riverside Hospital personally. Officer cleared the scene after they were checked in to the hospital.

Jun 3

Officers responded to a multi-vehicle accident on US 33 near Quarry Ln. A vehicle failed to notice traffic slowing or stopping ahead and rear ended the vehicle in front of them. No person involved stated they were injured. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for ACDA.

Jun 4

Officers responded to a non-injury accident on US 33 near McCoy Rd. One driver failed to notice stopped traffic and rear ended a vehicle in front of them. All parties declined medical assistance. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for ACDA.

Jun 4

Officers responded to a single car injury crash at the intersection of US 33 and West Case Rd. Officers arrived on scene and conducted a crash investigation and determined that the driver of the vehicle was intoxicated. The driver was placed under arrest for operating a vehicle while under the influence of alcohol.

Jun 5

Officers responded to a multi-vehicle accident on US 33 near Fairfax Rd. A driver failed to notice the vehicle ahead of them stopped for traffic and rear ended them, pushing the second vehicle into a third ahead of them. No injuries were reported at the scene and the at-fault driver was issued a citation for ACDA.

Jun 6

While on routine patrol, officer noticed two dirt bikes waiting to turn onto Hayden Run from US 33. One dirt bike continued on while the other stalled at the corner. As off-road motorcycles are not permitted on roadways, officer initiated a traffic stop. The rider of the stalled bike had no valid operator license and admitted to having a suspended license as well as not being the owner of the dirt bike. Officer cited the rider for driving under suspension, no motorcycle endorsement, and prohibited operation of an off-road vehicle on a roadway.

Jun 7

Officer responded to a report of a male with no shirt on walking up US 33. Officer made contact with the individual on US 33 at Clifton Rd. The man stated that he was from Columbus and was headed to Columbus Grove for his cousin's graduation. The man was cooperative. Officer cleared the scene.

Jun 9

Officers were dispatched to the intersection of US 33 and Hayden Run Rd on an injury accident. A vehicle failed to yield when turning left and struck a second oncoming vehicle. The driver of the second vehicle was transported to Riverside Hospital in stable condition and the driver of the at-fault vehicle was treated on scene. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for failure to yield.

Jun 10

Officers responded to a non-injury accident on US 33 by Zollinger Rd. One vehicle sideswiped another while attempting to stop and avoid a collision with traffic that was slowing ahead of them. No injuries were reported on scene. The at-fault driver was issued a citation a marked lanes violation.

Jun 11

Officers responded to multi car accident on US 33 at Henderson Rd. One vehicle was rear-ended by another vehicle after they began to slow down, under the impression a collision with the other vehicle had already occurred. The driver of the at-fault vehicle was determined to be driving under the influence and was arrested for OVI.

Jun 12

Officers were dispatched to the Speedway Gas Station at 3750 W Dublin Granville Rd on a mutual aid request by Dublin Police on a non-injury accident. Dublin Police requested Perry Officers to have the involved parties exchange information. Both parties exchanged information and stated they were fine. Both were referred to the Columbus Police website to file a report since it occurred in their jurisdiction. Officers cleared the run and resumed patrol.

Jun 13

Officers responded to a non-injury crash at the intersection of US 33 and McCoy Rd. The at-fault driver said that his foot slipped off the brake while waiting for the stop light, causing his car to roll forward into the vehicle in front of him. Both parties declined medical attention and a citation for ACDA was issued.

Jun 14

Officers responded to assist Sharon Township on a multiple car crash on I-270 at SR-315. Perry officers blocked the left two lanes on I-270 to protect fire personnel and to prevent any further crashes due to the flooded roadway. After the scene was secured, Ohio State Patrol took control of the crash investigation and Perry Officers cleared the scene.

Jun 14

Officer was dispatched to the 6700 block of McVey Blvd on an identity theft report. Officer met with the victim and took a report. Officer advised the victim to contact Perry Township Police should they notice any other fraudulent activities.

Jun 15

Officer was dispatched to the 1200 block of Blind Brook Dr on an identity theft report. Officer met with the victim, who explained they were a victim of fraud. Officer took a report for the victim.

Jun 15

Officer was dispatched to a non-injury accident the intersection of SR-161 and Linworth Rd. One vehicle rear ended another while stopped at the stoplight. Damage was minor and neither party requested medical attention or a tow truck.

Jun 17

Officer was dispatched to the 2700 block of Dublin Granville Rd on a parking complaint. Officer spoke with the resident, explained he found two vehicles parked in his driveway. He stated that the two people in the vehicle were being rude and disrespectful and yelling slurs at him as they were leaving. Officer ran the registration and located the suspect's address. Officer arrived on scene and spoke with both individuals, who denied being rude to the caller. Officer gave told to not park there again and gave them a verbal trespass warning and advised that they could be arrested if they returned to the caller's property.

Jun 17

Officer was dispatched to Riverside Dr and Bethel Rd on report of a driver passed out behind the wheel. Dispatch advised that medics were enroute. Officer arrived and met with the driver who stated that they were fine and just having car trouble. They already had a tow truck on the way. Officer observed no indicators of impairment and remained on scene until the tow truck was clear.

Jun 19

While conducting traffic enforcement on Riverside Dr, officer observed a vehicle traveling roughly 60 MPH in a 45 MPH zone. Officer checked the speed with a laser, which returned a readout of 63 MPH. Officer performed a traffic stop and discovered the driver had a suspended license. Officer issued a citation for driving with a suspended license and had the vehicle impounded.

Jun 20

Officer responded to an accident on US 33. One driver attempted to make a left turn and failed to see a second vehicle, causing a collision. Officer issued the driver a citation for failing to yield while making a left turn. The second vehicle was towed at the driver's request.

Jun 21

Officers responded to a non-injury accident on US 33 approaching Shore Line Ln. One vehicle was attempting to turn left onto Shore Line and struck the front of an oncoming vehicle as a result of a failure to yield. Officer issued a citation for failing to yield when turning left.

Jun 22

Officer was dispatched to assist Dublin Police on searching a property search after a burglary attempt. Officer made contact with a responding Hilliard Police Officer, who advised that Dublin Police wanted them to hold the perimeter while they cleared the building. Officer was stationed outside. Officer cleared the scene once Dublin Police cleared the building.

Jun 22

Officers were dispatched to Riverside Dr near Fairfax Dr on report of a minor traffic accident. A driver failed to maintain assured clear distance ahead and rear-ended the vehicle in front of them. Driver was cited for ACDA.

Jun 22

Officer assisted Columbus Police with traffic control at the scene of an injury accident. After blocking Hard Rd for a short time to allow medics to evaluate injuries, CPD 175 and Sergeant S17 arrived and took over traffic control.

Jun 23

Officer responded to SR-315 North on reports of an injury crash to assist Sharon Township, Officer arrived on scene and observed a car against the median. The driver was checked by Worthington Medic 102 and cleared the scene.

Jun 23

Officers responded to an injury accident at the intersection of US-33 and Hayden Run Rd. One vehicle was turning left from US-33 onto Hayden Run Rd and was struck by a vehicle traveling southbound on US-33. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for failing to yield on left turn.

Jun 23

Officer was dispatched to the 2500 block of Scioto View Ln on complaint of juveniles drinking around the pool. The juveniles were released to their guardians and officers cleared the scene.

Jun 24

Officers responded to a multiple vehicle accident on US-33 near Clifton Rd. Three vehicles were involved. Two drivers were transported to Riverside Methodist Hospital in serious condition.

Jun 24

Sharon Township requested Perry Township perform a BAC test per the mutual aid agreement. Officer performed the BAC test at the Perry Township Police Department before the subject was released with paperwork.

Jun 25

Officers responded to an accident on US-33 at Edgecliff Dr. While attempting to make a left turn onto Edgecliff Dr from US-33, one vehicle was rear ended by another which had failed to slow down. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for failure to maintain assured clear distance ahead.

Jun 27

Officers responded to a severe injury accident on US-33. Witnesses state that a vehicle went left of center across the line and struck the front of another vehicle. A third vehicle was involved as they tried to avoid the crash. The drivers of the first two vehicles were transported to the hospital by Upper Arlington Medic.

Jun 29

While on routine patrol, officer made contact with a Columbus Police Officer, who informed him of a missing elderly woman. Perry officers searched the area to assist. The elderly woman was located at a hospital after being transported by CFD Medic.

Jun 29

Officers responded to a vehicle with the driver passed out behind the wheel at Linworth Road and SR-161. Officers arrived on scene with medics and Worthington Police. Officer performed SFSTs and based upon his evidence the driver was arrested for OVI. The driver's vehicle was impounded.

Jun 29

Officers responded to a possible injury accident on US-33 at Hayden Run Rd. A driver made an abrupt lane change and struck the front of another vehicle. The at-fault driver fled the scene, but the other driver was able to take a picture of the vehicle after it was in front of their car. The second driver was treated on scene by Upper Arlington medic.
