Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township  
**Month of October 2022**



**Oct 1**

Officer was dispatched to the 3400 block of Woodview Pl on a report of a theft. Officer met with the victim who explained that someone entered their unlocked vehicle that was parked in the driveway and stole their wallet.

**Oct 1**

While on routine patrol, officer was flagged down by a mailman. The man asked if the officer could do a wellbeing check on a house at Keats Ct because the resident's mailbox had been full for the past few days. Officer agreed and arrived on scene. Officer met by a neighbor, who advised she had not seen the resident for a few days. Officer walked to the back sliding door and observed a woman laying on the ground, barely moving. Officer radioed for medics and requested backup. Officers made a forced entry and Worthington Medic 101 arrived on scene. The resident was transported to the hospital in critical condition.

**Oct 1**

Officers were requested to the area of Doolin Dr in Dublin on a mutual aid request by Dublin Police. Officer was requested on report of a suspicious vehicle in an apartment complex. Officer located the vehicle in question. Officer detected no odor of marijuana and explained the complaint received to the driver. Officer asked if the driver would be willing to move his vehicle. Driver agreed and the officer cleared the scene and went back to patrol.

**Oct 1**

Dublin Police requested that officer transport a driver out of an accident to their home due to the department having pending calls for service. Officer agreed to assist and transported the driver to their residence without incident.

**Oct 2**

Officers assisted Sharon Township with a traffic stop on US-23 south of Flint Rd. Sharon Township officer had conducted a traffic stop and placed the driver under arrest for operating a vehicle while intoxicated. Upon arrival, officer assisted Sharon Township officer with forms. Suspect complained of trouble breathing and Columbus Medic 33 was called to the scene. Suspect was transported to the hospital for further medical treatment. Officer stayed on scene until Capital Towing arrived. Capital Towing took possession of the vehicle and officer cleared the scene without incident.

**Oct 2**

Officers were dispatched to assist Sharon Township while they impounded an ATV. The owner of the ATV was not being cooperative. Officers stood by to make sure the scene was safe.

**Oct 3**

Officer was dispatched to assist Sharon Township on report of someone knocking on a residence's back door. Officers arrived on scene and checked the area, finding nothing.

Approximately, two minutes later, the caller called back and stated the same thing occurred. Officers returned to the scene and again found nothing.

**Oct 3**

Officers were dispatched to the intersection of US-33 and Henderson Rd on report of a non-injury crash. A vehicle traveling northbound on US-33 ran a red light and collided with a vehicle turning off of Henderson Rd. The at-fault vehicle fled the scene. Officers discovered the driver of the other vehicle did not have a valid license. They were cited and their vehicle was impounded.

**Oct 3**

Officer responded to a traffic accident at the intersection of Merbrook Rd and Millbrae Rd. The driver stated that he began backing to an address to deliver a package and went off the left side of the roadway, striking the stop sign at the intersection. The driver was cited for improper backing.

**Oct 5**

Officer was dispatched to the 1400 block of Candlewood on a lock-out request for a resident. Officer arrived and was met by workers from Buckeye Dry Cleaners who were getting the homeowner's belongings to clean them after a recent fire. Officer was able to successfully unlock their vehicle so it could be loaded. The resident was grateful for the assistance and thanked the officer. Officer resumed patrol.

**Oct 5**

Officers responded to a non-injury accident at the roundabout of US-33 and SR-161. The at-fault driver entered the roundabout from the far-right lane from SR-161 and merged into the center lanes of traveling, striking another vehicle's passenger side. The at-fault driver was cited for a marked lanes violation. Both vehicles were towed by Capital Towing.

**Oct 5**

Columbus Police requested assistance and needed a BAC operator. Officer met with a CPD officer at Perry Township Police Headquarters and performed the test. Upon completion of the test, officer observed CPD officer leave with the suspect in the back of their cruiser. Officer cleared the run.

**Oct 6**

Officers were dispatched to the intersection of US-33 and Hayden Run on a two car non-injury crash. One driver failed to yield when making a turn onto Hayden Run and was struck by a southbound vehicle. The at-fault driver was cited for failing to yield when turning left. Both vehicles were towed by Capital Towing.

**Oct 7**

Officer was dispatched to an accident on US-33 in the 4700 block of Riverside Dr. One driver rear ended another after failing to notice the vehicle in front of them. One party was checked out on scene by Upper Arlington Medic 71. The at-fault driver was cited for ACDA and one vehicle was towed by Capital Towing per the owner's request.

**Oct 7**

Officer responded to an injury accident at the intersection of US-33 and Hayden Rd. One driver made a left turn onto US-33 and tried to cross over to Hayden Run Rd, failing to yield to oncoming traffic. The driver of the second vehicle was treated on scene by Norwich Township

Medic #83 and transported to the hospital for further medical treatment. The at-fault driver was cited for failure to yield on left turn. Both vehicles were disabled and towed by Capital Towing.

**Oct 8**

Officer was on patrol in Arlington Pointe Apartments and observed an adult male dumpster diving. Officer observed for a few minutes and proceeded to check on the rest of the complex. The male then asked the officer if they could provide him a ride. Officer declined as the bike the male had would not fit in the cruiser.

**Oct 8**

Officers were dispatched to the 3700 block of Henderson Rd on an open back door. Officers were met by the resident, who stated that someone kicked in the back door. Officers entered the home and did a security sweep, finding no one inside. It appeared like someone kicked in a wood panel on the back door and unlocked it from the outside. The home still had personal belongings inside. The resident stated that nothing seemed to be missing. Officers advised the resident to contact the department if they noticed anything missing so it could be added to the report. The house was resecured, and officers went back on patrol.

**Oct 8**

Officers were dispatched on a non-injury accident on US-33 just north of Cranston Rd. One driver failed to maintain proper stopping distance and rear ended another vehicle. Neither party reported injuries and no towing was required. The at-fault driver was cited for assured cleared distance ahead.

**Oct 10**

Officer was dispatched to the 5000 block of Postlewaite Dr on a theft from a vehicle. Officer met the victim, who advised that on October 9 unknown person(s) entered his vehicle and removed credit cards and money from the vehicle. The victim was able to get all charges reversed and cancelled the cards.

**Oct 12**

Officer responded to the 2800 block of W Dublin Granville Rd to help an individual who had accidentally locked their keys in their car. Officer assisted the individual without incident and then cleared the run.

**Oct 12**

Officers were dispatched to the intersection of US-33 and Hayden Run Rd on a non-injury crash. A vehicle northbound on US-33 failed to yield when turning left onto Hayden Run Rd and struck the left side of a southbound vehicle. No injuries were report and neither vehicle required towing. The at-fault driver was cited for failure to yield.

**Oct 13**

Officer was dispatched to US-33 south of Fishinger Rd on report of a non-injury crash. One vehicle was entering US-33 from a parking lot and drove across the outside lane into the inside lane, striking a northbound vehicle. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for a marked lanes violation.

**Oct 13**

Officers were dispatched to the intersection of US-33 and West Case Rd on a non-injury blocking accident. A vehicle traveling northbound on US-33 failed to stop at the red light and struck a vehicle turning left onto US-33 from West Case Rd. The at-fault driver was cited for

failure to obey a traffic control device.

**Oct 13**

Officers responded to a non-injury accident at the intersection of US-33 and Hayden Run Rd. A northbound vehicle on US-33 failed to yield when turning left onto Hayden Run Rd and struck a southbound vehicle. All parties involved appeared okay and no one claimed injury. Norwich Twp Medic 83 responded and cleared all parties. The at-fault driver was cited for failing to yield on left turn.

**Oct 13**

Officers responded to the 2500 block of Riverside Dr on report of a threat or harassment between neighbors. Officers made contact with the victims/complainants. They stated that their neighbor came to their apartment and began yelling at them about noise they were making. Victims stated they were not being loud and this has been an ongoing issue. Officers then made contact with the neighbor. Neighbor confirmed he went to their apartment and asked them to be quiet, but the neighbor slammed the door in his face. Both parties were advised to contact apartment complex management to handle the issue in a civil way.

**Oct 14**

Officer was dispatched to the 900 block of Blind Brook Dr on report of harassment. Caller explained that a delivery driver rang the door many times multiple times and yelling for her to come to the door right now. She said the driver seemed agitated and left with her packages, but she was able to get outside before he left in his truck. He said he needed her ID to deliver the packages but would not wait. Officer advised the caller to contact FedEx to file a complaint.

**Oct 15**

Officer was dispatched to assist Sharon Twp with a traffic stop on US-23 near Northwoods Blvd. Sharon Twp Officer stated that he believed the driver to be impaired and wanted to do field sobriety tests. The driver refused and was placed under arrest. Officer assisted Sharon Twp Officer with the arrest. Driver refused BAC test at Perry Twp headquarters. After Sharon Twp Officer completed his investigation, issued the driver a court summons, and released the driver to the care and custody of a sober and valid driver, all officers cleared the run.

**Oct 15**

Officers were dispatched to the 5000 block of Riverside Dr to assist Upper Arlington with an abandoned stolen vehicle. Officers made contact with the owner, who advised it was stolen a month prior. UAPD advised the owner she was able to come get the vehicle. Officers contacted Dublin Dispatch advising them of the situation and they dispatched an officer to the scene. Dublin Officer spoke with the victim, who decided to have Dublin Police impound the vehicle and have it processed for evidence.

**Oct 15**

Officers were dispatched to a non-injury accident at the intersection of US-33 and Fishinger Rd. Both units were traveling northbound on US-33 when the driver in the left changed lanes to the right lane, striking the front of the other vehicle. Neither vehicle needed to be towed.

**Oct 16**

Officers were dispatched to the 7900 block of Fairway Dr on report of a burglary in progress. Officers made contact secured the exterior of the home and notified dispatch to have the homeowner allow them in. Officers learned that the homeowner heard someone arm the alarm system after hearing noises in the home. She stated the whereabouts of everyone who knew

the code and did not who could have been in the home. Officers rechecked the home before clearing the scene.

**Oct 16**

Officers were dispatched to a noise complaint at the 2500 block of Riverside Dr. Caller stated they could hear yelling and crying. Officers spoke with the resident, who stated everything was good and that he had a few friends over. One friend was getting out of hand and the others at the party asked him to leave, which he did. Officers cleared and returned to patrol.

**Oct 18**

Officers were dispatched to US-33 south of Henderson Rd on a blocking traffic accident with a possible impaired driver involved. A southbound vehicle drove left of center, collecting three additional vehicles in the accident. Multiple passengers were treated and released on scene by Upper Arlington Medic 72 and one individual was transported to the hospital by Columbus Medic 11. The at-fault party was issued a citation for marked lanes, OVI, and refusal to submit to a test.

**Oct 19**

Officers were dispatched to a possible burglary in progress in the 1400 block of Park Ridge. Officers observed a white SUV in the driveway. Officers entered the home and made contact with an electrician doing renovation on the home. The electrician explained he had lost track of time and provided the general contractor's information if needed. Electrician left the residence and officers cleared the scene.

**Oct 20**

Officers were dispatched to assist a member of the public in the 1300 block of Oakbourne Dr. Officers assisted the resident with transporting their sick dog to the car as it was too heavy for the resident to carry alone. Resident thanked officers and left for MedVet. Officers cleared the scene.

**Oct 22**

Officers responded to an injury crash on US-33 north of West Case Rd. Driver was traveling southbound and lost control of his vehicle, hitting a utility pole. Driver was treated and cleared on scene by Upper Arlington Medic 72 and AEP was notified of the damaged utility pole.

**Oct 22**

Officers were dispatched to a non-injury traffic accident at the intersection of Fishinger Rd and US-33. One vehicle failed to stop at the intersection and rear ended the vehicle in front of them. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for assured clear distance ahead.

**Oct 23**

Officer was dispatched to the 2400 block of Dublin-Granville Rd on report of a theft. Officer took a theft report from a worker on scene.

**Oct 24**

Officer spoke with a resident in the 8000 block of Park Ridge Ct per a request received by dispatch. Resident explained that an aggressive dog had lunged at their family and said dog had a history of aggressive behavior.

**Oct 24**

Officer was dispatched to a traffic accident on US-33 south of McCoy Rd. One vehicle rear ended another in stop and go traffic. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for failure to maintain assured clear distance ahead.

**Oct 25**

Officers were dispatched to a non-injury accident on US-33. One vehicle failed to maintain proper stopping distance and rear ended another vehicle in traffic. The at-fault driver was for ACDA and driving on temporary license restrictions.

**Oct 25**

Officer was dispatched to a non-injury accident in the area of McCoy Rd and US-33. One vehicle failed to maintain assured clear distance and ahead and rear ended a vehicle stopped at the intersection. The at-fault driver was cited for ACDA.

**Oct 25**

Officer was dispatched to the 6000 block of Borgata Way on report of an audible alarm coming from within a home. Officer met with the reporting person, a neighbor, who stated they believed no one was in the home. Officer contacted the homeowner via phone and Upper Arlington fire determined that a faulty smoke and carbon monoxide detector had triggered the alarm. All units cleared the scene.

**Oct 26**

Officer was dispatched to an injury accident on US-33 near Nottingham Dr. A vehicle trying to turn left from the Speedway driveway was struck by a vehicle traveling northbound on US-33. The at-fault driver was cited for failure to yield on a left turn.

**Oct 27**

While conducting a traffic stop on US-33 for a vehicle with no taillights, officer discovered that the driver had a suspended license. Officer issued a citation for driving under suspending and the vehicle was released to a valid driver after the taillights were able to be turned on.

**Oct 28**

Officer responded to an accident on Henderson Rd west of Henderson Hts Rd. One vehicle failed to maintain assured clear distance ahead and rear ended the vehicle ahead of them. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for ACDA.

**Oct 28**

Officers responded to the 2500 block of Shore Line Ln on report of someone sleeping in their car. Officers made contact the individual, who complied with a request to leave the area.

**Oct 29**

Officer conducted a traffic stop on SR-161 near Danbury Rd for speeding. During the stop, officer discovered that the driver had a suspended license. The driver was issued a citation for driving under suspension and the vehicle was impounded.

**Oct 29**

Officer responded to a non-injury hit/skip on Snouffer Pl. The vehicle drove off the roadway and struck a mailbox before fleeing the scene.

**Oct 29**

Officers were dispatched to the 2600 block of Billingsley Rd on report of a suspicious person attempting to access the storage facility. Officers met with the property manager who stated she was unaware of anybody attempting to break into the property. Officers inspected the property with the manager and located no one. Officers cleared and returned to patrol.

**Oct 31**

Officers responded to an injury accident at the intersection of US-33 and Zollinger Rd. A vehicle traveling southbound on US-33 attempted to turn on to Zollinger, failed to yield, and was struck by a northbound vehicle. Both drivers were transported to the hospital.
