Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township  
**Month of November 2022**



**Nov 2**

Officer was dispatched to the 8100 block of Fairway on report of a forgery.

**Nov 3**

Officers assisted two individuals in the Perry Township parking lot with locating a lost dog and assisting one person with making a threats/harassments report.

**Nov 3**

Officers responded to an injury accident on Snouffer Rd. A westbound vehicle ran off the right side of the roadway and struck a utility pole and wooden fence, traveled through a backyard, then came out of another section of fence. The driver was treated on scene by Worthington Medic 101. The driver was issued a citation for failure to control.

**Nov 4**

Officers responded to a non-injury accident at the intersection of SR-161 and Hutchinson St. One vehicle rear-ended another at the intersection. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for failing to maintain assured clear distance ahead.

**Nov 5**

Officer initiated a traffic stop after observing a vehicle cross the right lane marker multiple times on US-33. Officer observed the driver had slurred speech and asked to perform standardized field sobriety tests. Driver refused. Officer placed the driver under arrest for operating a motor vehicle while impaired. Driver refused to submit to a BAC test. Driver was placed in the care and custody of a sober party.

**Nov 5**

Officers responded to a non-injury accident at the intersection of Lane Rd and US-33. One vehicle rearended the other at the intersection during a red light. The at-fault driver was cited for ACDA.

**Nov 6**

Officer was dispatched to the 2500 block of Riverside Drive on a well-being check.

**Nov 7**

Officer was dispatched to the 1600 block of W Case Rd on a neighbor complaint. Complainant explained that a neighbor, in Columbus's jurisdiction, was dumping leaves in her yard, in Perry's jurisdiction. Complainant was advised that Columbus Police were going to speak to her neighbor.

**Nov 7**

Officers responded to a non-injury accident on US-33. One vehicle rear ended another vehicle stopped for traffic. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for ACDA.

**Nov 9**

Officer responded to a report of a dog being attacked by two other dogs being walked without a leash. Officer made contact with the victim and referred them to Franklin County Animal Control. Officer then made contact with the owner of the two dogs. Owner admitted to walking the dogs without leashes and that they attacked the other dog. Officer informed him that he could potentially be subjected should Franklin County Animal Control be requested to respond to the incident. Officer provided CAD numbers and business card and cleared.

**Nov 10**

Officers responded to a non-injury accident at the intersection of US-33 and Hayden Run Rd. Two vehicles side-swiped each other while accelerating at a green light. The at-fault driver was unable to be determined. The damage to both vehicles was minor.

**Nov 10**

Officer was dispatched to the 1600 block of Keats Ct on a burglary in progress. Resident arrived at house and found two men in the house. Resident noticed items missing and put a stop to bank accounts.

**Nov 10**

Officers responded to a non-injury accident on US-33 north of Canterbury Dr. A southbound driver struck a deer, causing disabling damage to the vehicle. The driver was able to safely turn on to Canterbury Dr. Owner requested a tow. The deer was not located.

**Nov 11**

Officers responded to a non-injury accident at the intersection of US-33 and Zollinger Rd. A vehicle southbound on US-33 attempted a left turn onto Zollinger Rd and failed to yield. A northbound vehicle struck the southbound vehicle. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for failing to yield while making a left turn.

**Nov 12**

Officers responded to a non-injury accident on SR-161 near Bellbrook Pl. A westbound vehicle failed to stop for the vehicle ahead of them and struck the center rear. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for assured clear distance ahead.

**Nov 13**

Officers were dispatched to the 7000 block of Doolin Dr on a domestic complaint in Dublin on mutual aid because all Dublin units were assisting OSP. Officers arrived on scene and spoke to all parties. Dublin Police arrived. Officers provided information to Dublin Officers and allowed them to take over the run, then cleared the scene.

**Nov 14**

Officer was dispatched to the 8000 block of Markhaven Dr on a theft. Officer spoke with the victim and learned of a possible lead.

**Nov 14**

Officers were dispatched on report of domestic violence in the 2000 block of Dublin Granville Rd. Officer met with the victim and determined based on evidence at the scene that warrants should be filed for the suspect for assault and domestic violence.

**Nov 15**

Officers were dispatched to US-33 south of Henderson Rd on a blocking non-injury traffic accident. The at-fault party was found to be operating on a temporary permit with no licensed passengers and was cited for not having a valid driver's license and ACDA.

**Nov 16**

Officers were dispatched to the 7500 block of Chancery Dr to assist Dublin Police on a report of interference with custody. Officers assisted Dublin Police in searching the area. Officers resumed patrol after clearing the run.

**Nov 17**

Officers were dispatched on an injury auto accident at the intersection of US-33 and Zollinger Rd. The at-fault driver failed to yield while making a left turn from Zollinger Rd onto US-33. Both parties were treated on scene by Upper Arlington Medic 71. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for failure to yield while making a left turn.

**Nov 18**

Officers responded to a non-injury accident in the 5500 block of Riverside Dr (US-33). The vehicle had struck a guardrail. The driver said that they had swerved to avoid an animal in the road. Officers discovered that the driver had no license and was driving with a suspended license. The driver was cited for no driver license, driving with a suspended license, and failure to control.

**Nov 18**

Officers responded to a report of an accident on Clubview Blvd N. A vehicle struck another on Clubview and proceeded to leave the scene of the accident. Information about the at-fault driver was relayed by dispatch. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for failure to control and leaving the scene of an accident.

**Nov 19**

Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of W Dublin Granville Rd to assist Worthington and Columbus Fire with an active house fire. Officers were requested to provide traffic control. Once the fires were extinguished, officers were asked to remain on scene while firefighters made sure the fire did not reignite. Once the initial investigation was completed, officers were advised that the roadway could be opened back up and all units could clear.

**Nov 19**

Officers responded to an accident on US-33 near Scioto View Ln. As one vehicle slowed to make a left-hand turn onto Scioto View Ln, a second vehicle struck its center rear. Both drivers were treated for minor injuries on scene by Upper Arlington Medic #72. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for assured clear distance ahead.

**Nov 20**

Officers responded to an accident on Clubview Blvd N. A driver struck an unoccupied vehicle parked in the 1300 block of Clubview Blvd N. The driver was issued a citation for failure to maintain reasonable control.

**Nov 21**

While on patrol, officer observed an electric pole in the 2300 block of W Dublin Granville Rd leaning towards the roadway and wires appeared lower than normal. Officer observed that the pole did not appear to be involved in a crash and there were no signs of criminal damage. There

appeared to be damage at the bottom of the pole due to stress. Officer contacted City Electric and indicated that they would respond to check on the pole for structural damage.

**Nov 21**

Officers responded to a report of a suspicious person at the Arlington Pointe apartments. Officers located the individual and he claimed that his vehicle was disabled. Officers confirmed he was a resident of the apartments. A well-being check request was sent to the county based on mental health concerns.

**Nov 21**

Officers responded to a hit-skip accident at the intersection of US-33 and Clifton Rd. According to the driver, while waiting to turn onto US-33 from Clifton, their vehicle was struck by another vehicle turning onto Clifton Rd. Said vehicle continued on Clifton Rd without stopping.

**Nov 22**

Officers assisted Sharon Township with a possible injury accident in the area of SR-315 and Hard Rd. The accident occurred in Columbus's jurisdiction. Officers cleared the scene while Sharon officers waited for CPD officers to arrive.

**Nov 22**

The Perry Township Road Department turned in a black volvo key fob located on the side of the road on Fairway Dr they found while doing leaf collection. Officer took control of the key fob and stored it in evidence for safe keeping.

**Nov 22**

Officers were dispatched to blocking disabled vehicle on SR-161 near McVey Blvd. Officers located the vehicle and made contact with the driver. Officers stayed on scene until Capital Towing arrived. Officers provided the driver a courtesy ride.

**Nov 25**

Officer responded to a case of financial fraud. Officer made contact with the victim and took a report of the incident. Officer advised the victim on next steps to protect their identity.

**Nov 27**

Officers responded to an injury accident on US-33 near the Griggs shelter house parking lot by Stratford Dr. According to both drivers, the collision occurred as one vehicle was turning out of the parking lot, but officers were unable to determine which party was at fault. Both vehicles were towed on scene and one party was transported to Ohio Health.

**Nov 27**

While on scene for an injury accident, a second non-injury accident occurred on US-33 at Stratford Dr. One vehicle failed to slow for the road closure and struck the rear of another vehicle. The at-fault driver was cited for assured clear distance ahead.

**Nov 28**

Officers responded to a non-injury hit-skip accident on US-33 south of Hayden Rd. One driver failed to yield while merging and struck the other vehicle before fleeing the scene. The driver of the second vehicle provided a description of the vehicle and the license plate number to officers.

**Nov 28**

Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Clubview Blvd N on a suicide attempt. Officers and Worthington Medic 101 arrived on scene and the victim was transported to the hospital

**Nov 28**

Officers were dispatched to the 3200 block of River Hallow Rd on a theft from a motor vehicle. Officer arrived on scene and spoke with the caller. Officer additionally spoke to a neighbor with a doorbell camera, but they had no video of the incident.
