Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township  
**Month of March 2023**



**Mar 1**

Officers responded to an injury accident at the intersection of US-33 and Fishinger Rd. A southbound vehicle failed to yield on a left turn and struck a northbound motorcycle. The driver of the motorcycle was taken to the hospital in critical condition. The at-fault driver was cited for failure to yield on a left turn.

**Mar 1**

Officer was dispatched on report of a resident having their computer hacked. Officer observed the computer actively being remotely controlled by an unknown suspect. Officer instructed the resident to disconnect their computer from the internet. Computer was disconnected from the internet and suspect no longer had access.

**Mar 3**

Officers responded to an accident on US-33. According to the driver, a vehicle suddenly merged into their lane. They swerved to avoid a collision and lost control, driving off the roadway. The driver was transported to the hospital as a safety precaution. The driver was unable to provide a description of the other vehicle. No citation was issued.

**Mar 3**

Officers were dispatched on report of a possible domestic violence incident at Arlington Pointe. The caller stated they heard yelling and screaming from a nearby apartment but was unable to identify which apartment it was coming from. Officers checked multiple apartments but were unable to locate involved parties in the incident.

**Mar 4**

Officer was dispatched on a 911 hangup in the 8000 block of Netherlands Pl. Officer met with a resident, who stated her father was having trouble breathing but did not want medics to come out, but she and her mother did. Officers called for Worthington Medic 101 and cleared once they arrived on scene.

**Mar 5**

Officer was dispatched along with a Sharon Twp Officer on a mutual aid request by the Worthington Police Department. Officers arrived on scene and met the caller who was stranded and needed a ride home because of his phone was not working. The man was allowed to make a call but was given a warning about the use of 911 for non-emergency calls.

**Mar 5**

While on routine patrol, officer observed a vehicle traveling over the speed limit on US-33 south. Officer observed the license plate was expired in 2022. Officer discovered that the tag was expired, a BMV Stop Order had been issued, and the driver's license had been suspended by authorities. Officer initiated a traffic stop and learned from Franklin County clerks that the

suspect had an active warrant. Officer transported the suspect to jail for slating on the warrant and issued new charges for driving while suspended and driving with expired registration.

**Mar 6**

Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of W Dublin-Granville Rd (SR-161) on report of an elderly woman who did not know her address. Officers made contact with the caller and the elderly woman. The caller advised she found the woman walking around disoriented and stayed with her after contacting the police. Officers met the elderly woman, who appeared confused. Worthington Medic 101 conducted checks and verified she was not having a medical emergency and an officer provided the woman a courtesy ride home. No further action required.

**Mar 8**

Officer was dispatched to assist a resident regarding the potential theft of banking information. The resident explained that some of his belongings had been stolen, including bank information. Officer provided the resident identity theft information from the Attorney General's Office and assisted the resident in setting up house checks as a precautionary measure.

**Mar 9**

Officer responded to an accident at the intersection of Hove Rd and Fishinger Rd on mutual aid for Upper Arlington PD. A northbound vehicle rear ended another vehicle at the intersection. The at-fault driver was cited for ACDA.

**Mar 9**

Officer responded to an accident at the intersection of US-33 and Fishinger Rd. A southbound vehicle changed lanes and struck another vehicle. The at-fault driver was cited for a marked lanes violation.

**Mar 9**

Officers were dispatched to Arlington Pointe on an unknown call. Dispatched indicated that the individual had contacted OSU's help line pleading for help. Officers were able to make contact with the individual, who indicated that everything was alright, and she did not remember why she called. Officers left the scene.

**Mar 9**

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of US-33 and Zollinger Rd. The at-fault vehicle failed to stop in time and rear ended a second vehicle. The at-fault driver then performed a U-turn and fled the scene. The other driver remained on scene and provided details to responding officers.

**Mar 9**

Officers responded to an accident on SR-161. A westbound vehicle entered a left-hand turn lane but then swerved back to the right and collided with another vehicle. The at-fault vehicle continued west. The other driver was able to continue after changing a flat tire.

**Mar 10**

Officer responded to a complaint in Worthington Hills. Officer met with the subject of the complaint and discussed allegations of riding a bike through the neighborhood yelling and cursing at people and threatening dogs. The individual stated that this did not occur. He stated that he only asked people to put their dogs on leashes. The individual stated that he would not say things while riding through the neighborhood.

**Mar 10**

Officer conducted a traffic enforcement stop at the intersection of McVey Blvd and McVey Blvd W for failure to stop at a stop sign. Officer discovered the driver did not have a valid driver's license or insurance. Officer impounded the vehicle and provided the driver a courtesy ride home.

**Mar 13**

Officers responded to a hit skip accident at the intersection of US-33 and Zollinger Rd. The at-fault vehicle came left of center while traveling northbound and struck another vehicle. The at-fault vehicle then fled the scene.

**Mar 14**

Officers responded to a hit-skip accident on US-33. While attempting a turn into a driveway, one vehicle was struck by a northbound vehicle which did not attempt a pass at a safe distance. The at-fault vehicle fled the scene. The driver of the at-fault vehicle was later located and issued a citations and summons for unsafe passing and failure to stop after an accident.

**Mar 15**

Officers were notified an accident that occurred on US-33 at the intersection with Lane Rd. One vehicle failed to stop before striking the other vehicle in the rear. Both drivers exchanged information and were able to continue under their own power. Officers were notified later and a report was prepared.

**Mar 16**

Officers were dispatched to a disturbance in the 5000 block of Henderson Heights. An unknown man was reportedly screaming outside. On scene, officers met with a man who stated that his son had been outside yelling not too long ago because he had been arrested for OVI and his car was impounded by Columbus Police. Officers checked the area to see if the son left with Columbus Police and were not able to locate him.

**Mar 16**

Officers responded to an accident on McVey Blvd. A vehicle coasted to the left side of the roadway and struck an electric speed limit sign. No injuries were reported.

**Mar 16**

Officer met with an individual at the Perry Township Police Department headquarters who wanted to report a domestic incident.

**Mar 17**

Officers responded to reports of a loud music complaint in the 1400 block of Clubview Blvd S. Officers located the residence and left a notice regarding loud music as they were unable to make contact with the resident.

**Mar 18**

Officers were requested to assist Sharon Township with a male subject who possibly had a gun. Officers responded to the 200 block of Rosslyn Ave. Officers confirmed the subject left the area. Once officers assisted in locating the suspect's information, they were advised by Sharon Township that they could clear.

**Mar 19**

While on routine patrol, officer observed a truck in excess of the posted speed limit. Officer conducted a traffic stop for speeding. The driver was found to have no valid license and had previously been cited by Worthington Police and Columbus Police. The vehicle was impounded and the driver cited for driving under suspension and speeding.

**Mar 19**

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Riverside Dr on report of a suspicious person. Officers searched the area but were not able to locate the individual.

**Mar 19**

Officers were dispatched to an animal strike on Henderson Rd. A deer crossed the road in front of an eastbound vehicle and struck the center front. The vehicle was towed from the scene at the owner's request. The deer was not located.

**Mar 20**

Officers responded to a vehicle accident at Riverside Dr and McCoy Rd. The at-fault driver failed to stop for traffic at the intersection and rear ended another vehicle. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for assured clear distance ahead.

**Mar 25**

Officers responded to a possible disturbance at Arlington Pointe. A resident reported hearing a possible female voice scream. Officers circulated through the building. The witness could not provide any further information and officers were unable to investigate further.

**Mar 25**

While on routine patrol at Arlington Pointe, an officer was flagged down for assistance with a neighbor complaint. Complainant stated that his neighbor's dog continuously barked through the day and night. Officer responded to the condo in question and rang the doorbell, but received no response. Officer left a warning on the door referencing Township Resolution 141-13(C)(6) regarding excessively barking dogs.

**Mar 26**

Officers were dispatched on report of a neighbor complaint in Worthington Hills. Officers interviewed both parties and learned there had been a dispute about the property line between their two properties. Officers prepared a report and took a statement.

**Mar 26**

Officers were dispatched to Arlington Pointe on report of a suspicious person banging on the door to the building. Officers arrived on scene and were unable to locate the individual on the property. Officers cleared and resumed patrol.

**Mar 27**

Sharon Twp officer requested a BAC machine operator perform a breathalyzer test on a subject arrested for a DUI. Perry officer operated the BAC test.

**Mar 27**

Officers responded to an injury accident at the intersection of Hayden Run Rd and US-33. The at-fault vehicle failed to yield while making a left turn on to US-33 south and was struck by an eastbound vehicle. The driver and passenger of the eastbound vehicle were transported to the

hospital by ambulance. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for failure to yield when making a left turn.

**Mar 27**

Officer responded to a complaint of dogs in the area of Circle on the Green without a leash.

**Mar 28**

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of US-33 and Hayden Run Rd. A northbound vehicle failed to yield while making a left turn onto Hayden Run Rd west and struck a southbound vehicle head on. The at-fault driver was cited for failure to yield and no license.

**Mar 28**

Officer was dispatched to a hit skip accident on May Ct. The caller advised that their mailbox had been hit and had observed the vehicle leaving the scene.

**Mar 28**

Officer conducted a traffic stop on McVey Blvd and discovered the driver did not have a valid license or insurance. The vehicle was impounded for safekeeping and the driver was cited for having no valid license.

**Mar 28**

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of US-33 and Zollinger Rd. A westbound vehicle failed to yield while making a lefthand turn onto US-33 south and struck a southbound vehicle attempting a turn onto Zollinger Rd. The at-fault driver (turning onto US-33) was cited for failure to yield while turning left.

**Mar 31**

Officers responded to an accident on Buck Ridge Rd. A vehicle backing from Scioto View Rd failed to notice a parked vehicle on Buck Ridge and struck the front of the second vehicle. The at-fault driver was cited for improper backing.

**Mar 31**

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of US-33 and Zollinger Rd. A vehicle on Zollinger Rd attempted to make a right turn onto US-33 and pulled in front of a northbound vehicle, causing a collision. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for failure to yield.

**Mar 31**

Officers responded to an injury accident at the intersection of US-33 and Hayden Run Rd. A southbound vehicle attempted a left turn on to Hayden Run Rd and was struck by a northbound vehicle. One driver was transported to the hospital in stable condition. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for failure to yield. The other driver was discovered to not have a valid license and was cited for the operation of a motor vehicle without a license.

**Mar 31**

Officers were dispatched to US-33 and Fairfax Dr on a suspicious individual. Officer arrived on scene and found a UAPD officer with the individual. The individual stated they were trying to return home and Officer provided a courtesy transport to a nearby gas station to assist.
