Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of June 2023



June 1

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Eastcliff Dr. The at-fault vehicle failed to stop for traffic and struck the vehicle ahead of it. The impact pushed the vehicle forward into a third vehicle. The at-fault driver was issued a citation for failing to maintain assured clear distance ahead.

June 2

Officers received a call from a concerned resident in Worthington Hills regarding a dog in someone's backyard barking for an extended period of time. Officers arrived at the residence and observed the resident inside his home, unresponsive, and with an alcoholic beverage near him. Officers were able to gain his attention and officers verified that he brought the dog inside. Officers contacted animal control to allow for authentication of necessary animal licensure.

June 2

Officers were dispatched on mutual aid to assist Sharon Township with an accident at the intersection of SR-315 and Clubview Blvd. Officers secured and held the scene for Sharon Twp. Officers assisted with traffic control once Sharon Township officer arrived on scene. Officers cleared the run once the intersection reopened.

June 3

Officers were dispatched on a wellness check regarding a mental health crisis. Officers met with the subject and provided them a courtesy transport to the OSU medical center.

June 3

Officers were dispatched to a female walking in the roadway on Riverside Dr at Hayden Rd asking for money. Officers met the individual, who appeared lethargic, tired, and sweating profusely. Officers instructed her to wait on the curb while waiting for a medic. She instead walked into the oncoming traffic lanes and jumped over the guardrail. Officers were able to handcuff and detain her for her own safety. Medics arrived and were able to transport her to the hospital for a mental evaluation.

June 3

A sudden storm came through the US-33 (Riverside Dr) corridor causing damage to trees and power lines. Officers responded to several locations on Riverside Dr for downed trees and the affected traffic light at the Fishinger Intersection. Upper Arlington Fire Department Engine 91 responded to assist in removing a tree. ODOT responded to assist in several locations and restore traffic light power. No vehicle accidents or damage were reported.

June 4

While on patrol, officer observed several vehicle stopped at the intersection of Snouffer Rd and Smoke Row Rd. Officer observed people assisting an elderly woman who had fallen out of her mobilized chair. Officer blocked the right turn lane and requested medics to respond. Several

people on scene were medical professionals and had the woman stabilized. CFD Medic 27 arrived on scene and transported her to the hospital.

June 5

While enroute to a house fire, a minivan turned left and into the direction of an officer's path of travel. Officer was unable to avoid contact and was struck by the mini van on the driver's side of the cruiser. Both drivers were fine. Dublin PD arrived to take the crash report.

June 6

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of Dublin Granville Rd and Linworth Rd. Both parties stated they had green signals and collided in the intersection. No injuries were reported.

June 6

Officers responded to a three-car accident on Dublin Granville Rd near Flora Villa Dr. The at-fault driver rear ended another vehicle, pushing it into a third vehicle. No injuries were reported, and the at-fault driver was cited for ACDA.

June 6

Officer responded to a report of a possible drunk driver on US-33. The caller stated the truck was swerving and almost hit another vehicle. Officer initiated a traffic stop and discovered the driver to be a Hispanic female who could not speak English. Through translation, officer discovered the driver did not know how to drive and had no license. Officer detected no signs of impairment. The driver was cited for having no operator's license and driving at an unsafe slow speed. The vehicle was impounded for safekeeping.

June 6

Officers were dispatched on a dispute between roommates. Once on scene, officers found all three individuals to be intoxicated. There were no weapons. The three individuals had conflicting stories. All parties declined charges and agreed to go to bed since no one could drive.

June 7

Officers were dispatched to Winston Ct N regarding threatening remarks made to the zoning officer. Officer informed the individual that they could not make any threatening remarks to the zoning officer and that any time the zoning officer arrives on the property in the future he will be accompanied by a police officer.

June 9

Officers responded to reports of an intoxicated individual having health complications. A friend was concerned they may have been exposed to an adulterated alcoholic beverage. The victim was transported to the hospital and CPD was notified of the Columbus bar which was the location of occurrence.

June 9

Officers responded to a non-injury accident on Dublin Granville Rd near Flora Villa Dr. A vehicle failed to yield on left turn while exiting a parking lot and was struck by a westbound vehicle on Dublin Granville Rd. The at-fault driver was cited for failure to yield on a left turn.

June 9

Officers responded to a non-injury accident on Smoke Row Rd near Smokey Meadow Dr. One vehicle failed to slow down for stopped traffic and struck the rear of the vehicle ahead of it. The

collision sent that vehicle forward into a third vehicle. The at-fault driver was found to have no valid license and cited for failing to maintain assured clear distance ahead and for driving without a valid Ohio license.

June 9

While on patrol on Riverside Dr, officer observed a truck failing to stay in a single lane and exceeding the posted speed limit. Officer followed the vehicle and initiated a traffic stop. Officer discovered the driver's license was suspended. The driver was cited for speeding and driving while suspended.

June 10

Officers responded to a residence in Worthington Hills on a reported altercation. Officer made contact with the homeowner, who explained that a vehicle parked in front of their home. An individual exited the car and into their front yard, then proceeded to yell threats of bodily harm at the homeowner's daughter. The individual then returned to the vehicle and left the area.

June 11

Officer was dispatched to Worthington Hills on report of a motor vehicle theft. Officer met the victim, who advised that some time over night his vehicle, which was parked in his driveway, was stolen. The victim's vehicle was located later in the day by Columbus Police and he was able to recover it.

June 11

Officer was dispatched to Worthington Hills on report of a theft from a motor vehicle. Officer met with the victim, who advised that someone had entered their unlocked car and rummaged through the interior compartments.

June 11

While on patrol in Worthington Hills, officer was flagged down by a pedestrian. The pedestrian handed the officer a couple of keys, a flash drive, and a pack of hearing aid batteries they said they found around the 1500 block of Clubview Blvd. Officer was also flagged down by other pedestrians who stated that every car on the block had been gone through the previous night.

June 12

Officer was dispatched to police headquarters to stand by for an arriving CPD cruiser. CPD officers arrived at Perry Township with a suspect of an OVI-involved wreck. CPD officers completed their breathalyzer test and left with the arrestee.

June 12

Officers took a report from an individual from outside Perry Township. He was referred to his jurisdiction's agency.

June 13

Officer was dispatched to I-270 west's ramp to SR-315 north on two separated crashes in close proximity on mutual aid with Sharon Township. Officer assisted with traffic control at Sharon Township PD's request.

June 14

Officer was dispatched to assist Sharon Township PD with a blocking disabled semi-truck. Officer assisted with traffic control while that semi-truck was towed.

June 15

Officer initiated a traffic stop on Riverside Dr for speeding. During the course of the stop, Officer discovered the driver had a valid warrant out of Franklin County and that the driver's license was suspended. The driver was cited for speeding and driving without a license and placed them under arrest for the warrant.

June 18

While conducting a traffic stop on Riverside Dr, a vehicle passed at high speeds by an officer. Officer pursued the speeding vehicle and initiated a traffic stop. Officer discovered the driver had no license, a suspension listed in his name, and had a warrant out of Columbus. Officer cited the driver for no valid license, speeding, and a move over violation, and transported the individual to jail on the warrant.

June 18

Officers were dispatched to the 4000 block of Shuster Rd on a stolen trailer. Officers spoke with the victim, who stated he borrowed a trailer from his friend. The victim left the state for work and upon his arrival he noticed the trailer missing. The owner was notified of the stolen trailer.

June 18

Officer was stopped at the intersection of Linworth Rd and W Dublin Granville Rd by the clerk from the nearby BP. The clerk told the officer that the kids in a silver vehicle had stolen items from the store. Officer observed the vehicle and conducted a traffic stop. Officer aired for Columbus PD to respond to the scene then spoke with the driver of the vehicle, who admitted to stealing two lighters. CPD cruisers arrived and took control of the investigation and the suspect was placed into CPD custody.

June 20

Officer responded along with Sharon Township cruisers to an injury crash on SR-315 north of Bethel Rd, where a female was fighting with Columbus Police. Officers arrived on scene where the female was arrested and in the back of a CPD cruiser. Sharon Officers eventually transported the female to jail, while she was still uncooperative. Officers radioed ahead to notify the jail of the combative arrestee.

June 21

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr. A vehicle traveling at unsafe speed for the traffic conditions rear-ended a stopped vehicle in traffic. The at-fault driver fled the scene. The at-fault vehicle was later located.

June 23

Officers responded to a neighbor complaint. The caller reported that his neighbor came on to his property agitated and aggressive towards his family. Officers were asked to speak with the neighbor. Officers met with the neighbor and warned him that he would be arrested for trespassing if he returned to his neighbor's property.

June 24

Officers responded to an accident on West Case Rd. A vehicle went off the right side of the roadway, striking a speed limit sign and a fire hydrant. The driver was cited for failure to control.

June 24

Officer was dispatched to Arlington Pointe regarding a neighbor complaint. One individual stated that their neighbor had come to their apartment and threatened them to be quiet. The individual

stated that they had a party that ended around midnight, but a few friends were still over talking. The neighbor stated that there had been a noise complaint recently and did not want a repeat of the issue. Both parties were advised to contact the police for any further issues.

June 25

Officer was requested to assist Dublin Police on a possible domestic. Officer met with two Dublin officers on scene and the parties in question were gone. Dublin PD advised that Perry officer could clear.

June 25

While on patrol in Worthington Hills, officer observed a bicyclist laying in a yard with her bicycle still in the roadway. Officer asked if she had been struck. She advised that she had struck a parked vehicle while attempting to check an app on her phone. She declined medical attention. The owner of the vehicle declined a crash report.

June 25

Officer responded to the 900 block of Bethel Rd on report of someone possible smoking marijuana in a parking lot. Officer met with the individual. She informed the officer that she had lost her keys. Officer could detect the faint smell of marijuana, but it was not fresh, and the individual had no signs of impairment. She stated that she would call for a locksmith and Perry officers offered to check on the vehicle overnight if it had to be left where it was.

June 26

Officer responded to an accident at the intersection of US-33 and Hayden Run Rd. One vehicle failed to observe traffic slowing ahead of them and struck the vehicle in front of them, pushing it into a third vehicle. The at-fault driver was cited for ACDA.

June 26

Officer was dispatched to a traffic accident with a possible heart attack. UA Medic 72 was on scene to treat one of the drivers involved.

June 27

Officers were dispatched on reports of shots fired near the Brookside Country Club. Officers made contact with a country club employee, who advised she had been outside all day and hadn't heard anything. Officers met with the caller who indicated that she had heard several shots but they had stopped once she went to investigate. Officers cleared.

June 27

Officers were dispatched to Brookside Estates on report of an identity theft.

June 28

Officers were dispatched regarding an incident that happened on Riverside Dr. The complainant stated they were run off the road by a white pickup truck.

June 28

Officer was dispatched to W Dublin Granville Rd to meet Worthington PD regarding found property.

June 29

Officer met with an individual who stated that her vehicle was struck by a tree branch caused by a crew trimming trees. She met with the ODOT crew who advised her to file a police report concerning the damage. The tree caused minor damage to the front of her vehicle.

June 30

Officers were dispatched on report of a disruptive intoxicated male. Officers met with the man's son, who stated that his father was very agitated and yelling. Officers spoke with the man, who was clearly intoxicated. Eventually the man was transported to the hospital by Worthington Medic for mental health reasons.

June 30

Officers responded to a vehicle that struck a tree on Circle on the Green. The driver stated she may have had a seizure and blacked out. The driver was treated by Worthington Medic 101. The driver was issued a citation for failure to control.
