Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of August 2023



Aug 1

Officer responded to Arlington Pointe to investigate a vehicle break-in. The victim explained that she found her vehicle broken into in the morning. Unknown person(s) by unknown means broke the front passenger side window and gained entry into the car. Other vehicles in the lot were also observed to have been broken into during the night.

Aug 1

Officer observed another vehicle to be vandalized in Arlington Pointe. Officer made contact with the owner who advised that change was missing from the center console.

Aug 1

While en route to Arlington Pointe, officer observed a blocking motor vehicle in the southbound lane of Riverside Dr. Officer made contact with the owner who was already talking to AAA for towing. Officer stayed on scene with the owner until AAA arrived and towed the vehicle.

Aug 1

While investigating other vehicle break-ins at Arlington Pointe, another vehicle owner approached the officer. The victim was unsure if any items were taken from his vehicle.

Aug 1

Officer was dispatched to Ravello on an animal complaint. Officer met with the complainant, who advised that she was walking her dog on Ridge Top Ln when another dog from a home came out and jumped on both her and her dog. She advised that the offending dog was on a long leash that extends outward many feet.

Aug 1

Officer was dispatched on a broken car window on the driver side front at Arlington Pointe. Officer spoke with the victim, who stated nothing was missing from his vehicle.

Aug 1

Officer spoke with another individual at Arlington Pointe, who advised that an unknown person entered her vehicle and stole a bottle of medication belonging to her husband. No other items were stolen.

Aug 1

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and McCoy Rd. Unit 2 was southbound on Riverside Dr and attempted a left turn onto McCoy Rd. Unit 1 was northbound on Riverside Dr and struck the passenger side of Riverside Dr. The at-fault driver was cited for failing to yield when turning left.

Aug 1

Officer was patrolling the area of Arlington Pointe and was flagged down by a resident on an attempted theft from their vehicle. Nothing was stolen from his vehicle, but he was able to provide officers with a photo of the attempted theft.

Aug 2

Officer was dispatched to Arlington Pointe regarding a vehicle with the driver side window smashed. The victim stated that he had just noticed the damage and wanted to file a report for insurance.

Aug 3

Officer was dispatched to meet with a victim of identity theft.

Aug 3

Officer was dispatched on an accident on Dublin Granville Rd. A vehicle attempted to make a right turn out of a parking lot onto Dublin Granville Rd and struck a utility pole located at the exit. The driver was cited for failure to control.

Aug 3

While on patrol on Riverside Dr, officer observed a vehicle make a left turn into a construction zone on Hayden Run Rd. Officer conducted a traffic stop and discovered that the driver did not have a valid driver's license, insurance, or a passport. Officer cited her for driving without a valid license and failing to obey a traffic control device.

Aug 4

Officers responded to a non-injury crash on Henderson Rd near Henderson Hts. Officers took an information only report for the involved parties and referred them to the CPD website to file a crash report as the incident took place in Columbus' jurisdiction.

Aug 4

Officers responded to an alarm at the Brookside Country Club. Officers checked the perimeter and found an open door at the rear of the bar. After walking through the building, no intruders were found and no signs of forced entry.

Aug 5

While inspecting an abandoned vehicle on Riverside Dr, officer observed a man lying in the grass next to another vehicle. The man stated that his truck had broken down. He asked if the officer could provide a ride to his apartment. The vehicle did not appear to be causing a traffic hazard as it was off the roadway, so officer provided a courtesy ride.

Aug 5

Officers located an abandoned SUV on Riverside Dr. Officers determined that it was a safety hazard for oncoming traffic and had Capital Towing tow the vehicle.

Aug 5

While on patrol, officer observed a vehicle drive turn left into the Hayden Run Rd construction zone with "no left turn" signs posted. Officer conducted a traffic stop. Officer discovered the driver did not have a valid Ohio license, insurance, or passport. The driver was issued a citation for operating a vehicle without a valid license and failing to obey a traffic control device.

Aug 5

While conducting traffic enforcement, officer observed a vehicle turn left onto the Hayden Run Rd bridge with "no left turn" signs posted. Officer conducted a traffic stop. Officer discovered that the driver did not have a valid Ohio license or insurance. The driver was cited for operating a vehicle without a valid license and failing to obey a traffic control device.

Aug 6

Officers responded to a non-injury crash at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Henderson Rd. Unit 1 was northbound on Riverside Dr and Unit 2 was westbound on Henderson Rd. Unit 2 made a left turn through a red light. Unit 1 struck the driver side of Unit 2. Both drivers declined medical attention.

Aug 6

Officers responded to the intersection of SR-315 and Hard Rd to assist Sharon Twp with an injury crash. Two vehicles were blocking the intersection and multiple injuries were sustained by the vehicles' occupants.

Aug 8

While conducting traffic enforcement at the intersection of Hayden Run Rd and Riverside in response to complaints regarding construction traffic violations. Officer observed a vehicle make a prohibited left turn onto Hayden Run Rd. While conducting the traffic stop, officer discovered the driver did not speak English, did not have a driver's license, or a social security number. The driver was cited for no operator's license, failing to obey a traffic control device, and turn signal violations. The vehicle was impounded.

Aug 8

Officer responded to a complaint of an injured deer near Dublin-Granville Rd. Officer found a baby deer with completely broken legs. Officer dispatched the deer with a deer slug round and confirmed it was deceased. Officer notified ODOT for pickup.

Aug 9

Officer responded to an accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Henderson Rd. Unit 1 was southbound on Riverside Dr approaching the intersection. Unit 2 was southbound and stopped at the intersection waiting to turn left. Unit 2 abruptly changed from the left turn lane into the through lane. Unit 1 swerved to avoid a collision and struck the guardrail. Unit 2 left the scene.

Aug 9

Officer responded to an injury crash on Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd. While en route, dispatch advised that parties involved were physically fighting. Two of the suspects were reported to have fled the scene.

Aug 10

Officers responded to a non-injury hit-skip accident on Riverside Dr and Fishinger Rd. There was a confrontation between the involved parties and suspects stole items from the victim.

Aug 11

Officers were dispatched to Worthington Hills on a DOA.

Aug 11

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Zollinger Rd. Unit 1 was northbound in the left lane of Riverside Dr. Unit 2 was southbound on Riverside Dr. Unit 2 failed to yield and struck unit 1. Unit 2 was cited for failure to yield and unit 1 was cited for no operator's license.

Aug 12

Officers responded to reports of shots fired in Worthington Hills. The caller stated that he heard three slow shots and then three rapid shots fired in succession. Officers searched the area but did not locate anything.

Aug 13

While on patrol, officer was stopped by the grounds crew manager of the Brookside Country Club. Sometime overnight, unknown person(s) entered the golf course area from Greenvale Dr driving across the fairway and down into a sand bunker.

Aug 13

Officers were dispatched to Arlington Pointe on a juvenile complaint.

Aug 14

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr near Palatas Dr. Unit 2 was behind Unit 1 on Riverside Dr and failed to notice Unit 1 slowed down and struck the rear of Unit 1. Unit 2 was cited for ACDA.

Aug 15

Officer was dispatched to Brookside Elementary on people causing a disturbance near the pond. Officer found three men fishing at the pond. Officer asked if they were ready to leave and they stated they would. Officer remained on scene until all three vacated the premises.

Aug 17

Officers were dispatched on mutual aid to assist Worthington Police with suspects possibly hiding inside a building. While enroute, the suspect was located and placed under arrest.

Aug 17

Officer responded to an accident on Riverside Dr north of Lane Ave. Unit 2 was following too close behind unit 1 and failed to safely come to a stop and struck the rear of unit 1. The driver of unit 2 was cited for ACDA.

Aug 18

An unknown person(s) broke the windows of multiple vehicles at the Worthington Hills Country Club after midnight. Many of the vehicles were rummaged through.

Aug 18

Officer was dispatched on a hit-skip accident at a business on Dublin-Granville Rd. An employee stated that a yellow tractor trailer scraped the top side of the building and left the scene after the driver was told of the contact. Officer attempted to make contact with the company which owned the tractor trailer.

Aug 19

While conducting traffic enforcement at the Hayden Rd construction site, officer conducted a traffic stop after observing a violation. Officer discovered the driver did not have a valid Ohio driver's license. The driver was cited and the vehicle was impounded.

Aug 20

Officer was dispatched to Brookside Estates on a theft. Officer spoke with the victim, who had money stolen as part of a fake social security scam.

Aug 20

Officers were dispatched on an injury accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd. Unit 1 was southbound on Riverside Dr approaching the intersection. Unit 2 was northbound on Riverside Dr and preparing to turn left. Unit 2 failed to yield on left turn and was struck by Unit 1. The at-fault driver was cited for ACDA.

Aug 20

Officers were dispatched on an injury accident on Riverside Dr involving a single motorcycle. Officers spoke with the driver, who stated that he tried to brake when traffic slowed and fell to the ground on his motorcycle. The driver was treated on scene and no citation was issued due to no contact with another vehicle and no property damage caused.

Aug 20

Officers responded to a possible domestic dispute. Officers made contact with and interviewed both parties, determining that there were no signs of injury and no signs of any escalation. Both parties were advised to keep the noise down and contact law enforcement for any further assistance.

Aug 21

While conducting traffic enforcement at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd, officer initiated a traffic stop after a vehicle make a prohibited turn. Officer discovered the driver had no valid driver's license. The driver was cited, and the vehicle was impounded.

Aug 22

While conducting traffic enforcement at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd, officer observed a vehicle make a prohibited left turn. Officer initiated a traffic stop and found the driver had nine active suspensions and two active warrants. The driver was transported to jail and the vehicle was impounded.

Aug 22

While conducting traffic enforcement at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd, officer observed a vehicle make a prohibited left turn. Officer initiated a traffic stop and discovered the driver did not have a valid driver's license. The driver was cited and a valid driver responded on scene to take the vehicle away.

Aug 25

While conducting traffic enforcement at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd, officer observed a vehicle make a prohibited left turn. Officer initiated a traffic stop and discovered the driver did not have a valid driver's license. Officer also observed an open corona beer bottle in the vehicle. The driver was cited for his violations and the vehicle was impounded.

Aug 26

Officers responded to an injury accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Griggs Reservoir Dr. Unit 1 failed to notice the red light and struck the rear of unit 2 as it was traveling through the intersection. The driver of unit 2 was transported to the hospital in stable condition. The driver of unit 1 was cited for failure to obey a traffic control device.

Aug 27

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of Dublin Granville Rd and Linworth Rd. Unit 2 was stopped at the red light. Unit 1 failed to stop and struck unit 2. The driver of unit 1 was cited for assured clear distance ahead.

Aug 27

Officer initiated a traffic stop on Snouffer Rd. Officer discovered the driver did not have a valid license. Officer cited the driver for driving under suspension.

Aug 28

The K9 Team responded to the Tech Data warehouse in the City of Obetz for a bomb threat. Obetz Police and K9 teams from Franklin County, the Airport, Columbus Fire, the Ohio State Fire Marshal, and the US Marshal Service also responded. The building was cleared in two sweep periods. No devices or materials were located and all units went back in service.

Aug 30

Officer observed a a vehicle partially blocking the northbound lane on Smoky Row Rd near Billingsley Rd. Officer asked if the driver was okay. She stated that she thought her battery was dead. Officer assisted in moving the vehicle. Officer and two firefighters from CFD Station 27 were unable to restart the vehicle. Officer provided the driver and her friend a courtesy ride home.

Aug 31

A suspicious person and vehicle were observed in the parking lot at 999 Bethel Rd. An individual was asking strange questions to the employees at LEPD. The man eventually returned to his vehicle and drove away. Officer gathered pertinent information and patrolled the other businesses in the area but did not locate the vehicle.

Aug 31

Officer observed an individual pull into the Perry Township parking lot and take several photos of the neighboring construction site. Officer informed the driver that he could not be sitting the police parking lot unless he has police business. The driver left the scene without incident.
