Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township
Month of October 2023



Oct 1

Officers assisted Sharon Township officers with a domestic dispute on SR-161 over SR-315. The parties were separated, and Perry officers cleared the scene without incident.

Oct 2

Officer initiated a traffic stop on US-33. Officer found the driver had a suspended license. The driver was cited, and the vehicle impounded.

Oct 3

Officer was alerted to a car crash in the 1000 block of Bethel Rd. Officer remained on scene until Columbus PD could arrive. Officer cleared once CPD responded.

Oct 4

Officer responded to the area of I-270 and Roberts Rd per Hilliard Police's request to conduct a search of a female they placed under arrest. Officer conducted the search without incident.

Oct 4

Officer was dispatched to the 6700 block of McVey Blvd on an ATV complaint. Officer located the ATV and the driver, a young boy. Officer assisted in ensuring he made it home safely and informed the boy and his parents that he cannot ride the ATV on roadways.

Oct 4

Officer was dispatched to SR-161 and McVey Blvd on report of an auto accident.

Oct 5

Officer was dispatched to the 2000 block of Darwin Dr on a report of identity theft.

Oct 6

Officers responded to a hit-skip accident on SR-161 near McVey Blvd. Unit 2 struck the rear of unit 1 after failing to slow down. Unit 2 fled the scene.

Oct 7

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of Hayden Run Rd and US-33. Unit 2 failed to slow and struck unit 1 in the rear. Unit 1 filed a report at Perry Township PD headquarters after the crash.

Oct 8

Sharon Township PD requested to use the Perry PD BAC machine for a test. Officer was dispatched to perform the test.

Oct 8

Officers were dispatched to the 6500 block of McVey Blvd on a well-being check.

Oct 10

Officer was dispatched to the 2500 block of Olde Hill Ct on a theft.

Oct 10

Officers responded to an accident on US-33 north of Canterbury Rd. Unit 2 and unit 1 were parallel traveling north and struck one another.

Oct 12

Officers responded to an accident on US-33 in the 5500 block of Riverside Dr. Unit 1 failed to brake for traffic and struck the rear of Unit 2. Unit 1 was cited for ACDA.

Oct 13

Officer was dispatched to assist Worthington Police in translating. Worthington had an individual in custody who could only speak Spanish.

Oct 14

Officers responded to an accident on US-33 north of McCoy Rd. Unit 1 failed to maintain control and went off the roadway.

Oct 14

While on patrol on US-33 near Zollinger Rd, officer initiated a traffic stop for a speeding vehicle. Officer discovered that the driver's license was suspended and had a warrant for his arrest for failure to appear. Officer issued a citation for speeding, operating a vehicle under a license suspension, expired vehicle registration, and operating a motor vehicle without a valid license.

Oct 14

Officer was dispatched to the 3000 block of Riverside Dr on an injured deer. Officer put down the deer and contacted ODOT for pickup.

Oct 14

Officer responded to a hit-skip accident at the intersection of Hayden Run Rd and US-33. Unit 2 struck the rear bumper of Unit 1 and fled the scene.

Oct 15

Officer initiated a traffic stop for a driver that came within inches of the officer and his patrol car while conducting a separate stop. Officer learned the driver spoke limited English and did not have a valid license. Officer cited the driver.

Oct 15

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Olde Hill Ct on a well-being check.

Oct 15

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Snouffer Pl on a suicide attempt.

Oct 16

Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Colony Way on a report of an identity theft. Officers prepared a report for the victim.

Oct 17

Officer was dispatched to the 6600 block of McVey Blvd on a suspicious person in a caller's yard. The caller then stated that an unknown male individual entered his yard and appeared to

be looking into the residence's windows. The caller went outside to confront the suspect and the suspect fled the scene. Other residents in Brookside reported capturing the same individual on their own security cameras.

Oct 18

Officer was conducting traffic enforcement in the area of Riverside Dr and Scioto View Ln. Officer initiated a traffic stop after observing a vehicle traveling 60 MPH in a 45 MPH zone. Officer discovered that the driver's license was canceled and that he had an arrest warrant through the Franklin County Sheriff's Office. Officer issued a citation for speeding and driving under suspension and had the officer transported to Jackson Pike to be slated.

Oct 18

Officer was dispatched to police headquarters to take a report for a victim of scams and theft.

Oct 19

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of Shore Line Ln and US-33. Unit 3 failed to yield when turning right onto US-33 south, striking Unit 1 and Unit 2. Unit 3 was cited for failure to yield.

Oct 19

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of US-33 and Zollinger Rd. Unit 2 failed to yield when turning onto US-33 from Zollinger and was struck by Unit 1. Unit 2 was cited for failure to yield.

Oct 21

While on patrol, officer observed a window to be fully open at a preschool. Officer notified Worthington PD and assisted with clearing the building. There were no signs of forced entry or intrusion.

Oct 21

Car 165 was stopped in traffic at the intersection of Sawmill Rd and West Case Rd. The cruiser was rear-ended by another vehicle which failed to stop. No injuries were reported and the at-fault driver was cited by Columbus Police for failure to maintain assured clear distance ahead.

Oct 22

Officer was patrolling the area of Hard Rd and Sefton Park Dr and observed several cars in the middle of the road and Columbus Fire engine 27 blocking most eastbound traffic. Officer stopped to assist and direct traffic. Officers remained on scene until Columbus Police were able to secure the scene.

Oct 23

Officers were dispatched to the area of Riverside Dr and Henderson Rd on a possible single vehicle injury crash. Officers met with the occupants of the vehicle and learned of a disagreement between the occupants.

Oct 24

Officers responded to an injury accident on SR-161 east of Nicholas Dr. Unit #2 was traveling west on SR-161 and struck unit #1 in the rear. The passenger of unit #1 was transported to the hospital. The driver of unit #2 was cited for ACDA.

Oct 24

Officers responded to a non-injury accident at the intersection of US-33 and River Park Dr. Unit #1 slowed to a stop for traffic. Unit #2 was following too closely and could not stop before striking the rear of Unit #1. The at-fault driver was cited for failure to maintain assured clear distance ahead.

Oct 25

While on patrol near Brookside West, officer observed an occupied vehicle stopped on the roadway at the perimeter of the Beightler Armory. Officer made contact with the occupants. Officer observed no cameras or weapons during contact. The driver stated that he was lost. Officer provided him directions to the nearby UDF.

Oct 25

While on patrol, officer was flagged down by a resident in the 6600 block of Millbrae Rd. Officer prepared a report for the theft of a catalytic converter from the resident's vehicle.

Oct 25

Officer was requested by Sharon Twp Police to respond to the 2000 block of Dublin-Granville Rd on a blocking disabled vehicle. Upon arrival, officer observed the vehicle with a dealer sticker for Carmax. A tow vehicle from Carmax arrived to pick up the vehicle from the scene. The tow driver explained that the car had died and the key was back at the dealership.

Oct 25

Officers responded to a non-injury accident at the intersection of US-33 and Hayden Run Rd. Unit 1 was northbound on US-33. Unit 2 was eastbound on Hayden Run Rd. The light turned green for Unit 1, but Unit 2 did not stop and continued through the intersection. Unit 1 struck the passenger side of Unit 2. A witness provided video capturing the event for the report. Unit 2 was issued a citation for disobeying a traffic control device.

Oct 27

Officers were dispatched to the 6700 block of McVey Blvd on a neighbor complaint.

Oct 27

Officers were dispatched to assist Dublin Police with a juvenile complaint. Officers assisted in clearing a parking lot of vehicles due to the fact no one had permits for the event.

Oct 27

During a business check, officer observed a vehicle with the occupant asleep at the driver's seat. Officer made contact with the owner, who left the premises without incident.

Oct 28

Officer was advised to contact a person who wanted to file a stolen vehicle report. Officer made contact with the victim and prepared a report for the victim. The vehicle was located by Columbus Police and towed to the CPD impound lot.

Oct 28

Officer was conducting traffic enforcement in Brookside and observed a speeding vehicle. Officer initiated a traffic stop and discovered that the driver had a summons into Franklin County Municipal Court for speeding and driving without a valid license. A citation was issued to the driver and to the registered owner for wrongful entrustment.

Officer was dispatched to police headquarters on an identity theft complaint. Officer prepared a report and provided instructions on removing outstanding, fraudulent bills from the victim's accounts.

Oct 31

Officers responded to a non-injury accident on US-33 near Stratford Dr. Unit 2 failed to slow down and struck the rear of Unit 1. The driver of Unit 2 was cited for ACDA.
