Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township  
**Month of November 2023**



**Nov 1**

Officers were dispatched to the 8700 block of Evangeline Dr on report of a person having a mental crisis.

**Nov 1**

Officer was dispatched to 5400 block of Havenhill Dr on report of fraudulent activity. Officer gathered pertinent information and prepared a report for the victim.

**Nov 3**

Officer was dispatched to the 1500 block of Oakbourne Dr on report of a road rage and assault.

**Nov 4**

Officers responded to a multi-car accident on US-33 south of McCoy Rd. At the intersection, Unit 3 struck the rear of Unit 2 causing Unit 2 to move forward and strike Unit 1. Unit 3 was cited for ACDA.

**Nov 7**

Officers assisted Sharon Township Police. Sharon Officers initiated a traffic stop on a suspect while Perry Officer met with the teller at a bank where the suspect attempted to use stolen identification.

**Nov 7**

Officers responded to a non-injury accident on US-33 south near Griggs Park Dr. Both parties gave conflicting statements on who was at fault for the accident. No citation was issued.

**Nov 7**

Officer was dispatched on an unoccupied suspicious vehicle on private property on Riverside Dr. Officer found the vehicle was secured with no visible damage and was not reported as stolen. Officer made contact with the property owner and informed them that they could have the vehicle towed since it was on private property.

**Nov 9**

Officers were dispatched to the 4900 block of Postlewaite Rd on report of a neighbor dispute and a dog bite. Dispatched advised that medics and Franklin County Animal Control were dispatched as well. The victim, a contractor, said that he was nipped by the neighbor's dog, but it did not break skin and did not need a medic. Officer met with the neighbor along with Franklin County Animal Control. Officer advised the neighbor that the fence his neighbor was putting up was approved by Perry Township Zoning and that he was to refrain from speaking with anyone putting up the fence.

**Nov 9**

Officer was flagged down in Worthington Hills by a resident, who requested aid in locating his dog. Officer conducted a search of the residential streets for an hour but was unable to locate the dog.

**Nov 10**

Officers were dispatched for a deer struck by a vehicle in the 2500 block of W Dublin Granville Rd. Officers met with the driver, who stated she was not injured and her vehicle only sustained minor damage. Officers determined that the deer was in distress and should be euthanized.

**Nov 10**

Officer was dispatched to assist Sharon Twp with traffic control on I-71 while they investigated a traffic accident.

**Nov 11**

Officers were dispatched to the 2600 block of Darwin Dr on report of a theft.

**Nov 11**

Officers were dispatched to a non-injury accident on US-33 south of River Hill Ln. Unit 2 was backing out of a driveway and struck the front passenger area of Unit 1 which was northbound on US-33. The driver of unit 2 was cited for improper backing.

**Nov 13**

Officer responded to an injury crash at the intersection of US-33 and McCoy Rd. Unit 1 was northbound on US-33 and failed to stop for the red light, striking unit 2 as they were turning onto US-33. After investigation, the driver of unit 1 was placed under arrest for OVI. Driver was cited for OVI and disobeying a traffic control device.

**Nov 15**

Officer observed a vehicle fail to yield the right of way while turning right on Riverside Dr. Officer conducted a traffic stop and discovered that the license was expired. Officer issued a citation for driving with an expired license.

**Nov 16**

Officer initiated a traffic stop after observing a vehicle with their high beams activated despite several other cars ahead and approaching. Officer discovered the driver's license was suspended. Driver was cited for driving while suspended.

**Nov 17**

Officers responded to a non-injury accident at the intersection of US-33 and Canterbury Rd. The at-fault driver failed to stop for traffic. The at-fault driver was cited for ACDA.

**Nov 17**

Officers responded to a non-injury accident at the intersection of SR-161 and Nicholas Dr. Unit 1 failed to yield to oncoming traffic while making a left turn and was struck by unit 2. The at-fault driver was cited for failure to yield and for operating a motor vehicle without a license.

**Nov 18**

Officer received a call from a resident who informed the officer that someone claiming to be from the Franklin Municipal Court told him he needed to withdraw \$9200 to bail his son out of

jail. Officer informed him that this was a scam and assisted the resident in dealing with the scam and confirmed that his son was not in any trouble.

**Nov 18**

Officers responded to a non-injury accident at the intersection of US-33 and Henderson Rd. Unit 1 failed to yield when making a left turn and was struck by Unit 2. The driver of Unit 1 was issued a citation for failing to yield on a left turn. During the investigation, the driver of Unit 2 was found to have a suspended license out of New York and was cited for driving with a suspended license.

**Nov 18**

Officers were dispatched to investigate a concern of a child yelling. Officers circulated the area but did not locate anything.

**Nov 21**

Officers were dispatched to assist Sharon Twp on a roll over traffic accident on SR-315. Officers assisted in shutting down the roadway until it was able to be cleared by Columbus Fire.

**Nov 21**

Officer responded to a report of identity theft. Officer prepared a report for the victim and will follow up as needed.

**Nov 21**

Officers responded to a non-injury accident on US-33. Unit 2 failed to maintain ACDA and struck the rear of Unit 1. No citation was issued as the damage was minor and Unit 2 admitted fault.

**Nov 21**

Officers responded to a blocking disabled vehicle in the westbound lane of West Case Rd. Officer remained on scene as the tow request was fulfilled.

**Nov 22**

In the morning, there were reports and footage of shots being fired from a vehicle on Clubview Blvd S from the previous night. Officers investigated and located multiple shell casings on Clubview Blvd S between Southview Dr and Colony Way. No homes or property were damaged by the bullets.

**Nov 22**

FCSO deputies were dispatched on a possibly suicidal person who appeared to want to jump off a bridge above I-270. A Perry officer responded as the location was near the Township offices. Officers were able to talk to the woman and get her down to the ground safely.

**Nov 24**

Officer responded to an injury accident at the intersection of US-33 and Hayden Run Rd. Unit 1 was struck by Unit 2, which then fled the scene.

**Nov 25**

While on patrol on Henderson Rd, officer observed a vehicle going 50 MPH in a 35 MPH zone and the headlights were not illuminated despite it being night. Officer initiated a traffic stop. Officer discovered the driver did not have a valid licenses and a suspension. Officer issued a citation for driving with an expired license and warnings for the other offenses.

**Nov 28**

Officers were dispatched at the request at the request of Worthington Medics to the 2500 block of Winston Ct N. Medics were responding to a medical emergency and requested officers to secure the scene. Officers found man sitting on the floor with dried and fresh blood on his face. He stated that he had tripped and fell and hit his head. He was unable to stand on his own and spoke with slurred speech. Medics transported him to the hospital.
