Jan 1

Officer observed a vehicle driving southbound on Riverside Dr in the northbound lane. The vehicle then went off the roadway and struck a small tree. The vehicle was impounded and the operator determined to be operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Driver was issued a citation for failure to control and OVI.

Jan 1

Officers were dispatched to the 870 block of Clubview Blvd N on report of a suicide attempt. Officers learned that the caller was the ex-boyfriend of a resident's daughter and had been making drunken calls and harassing his daughter. Officers advised the ex-boyfriend make no further false calls to the police and to quit contacting the family.

Jan 1

Officers responded to Riverside Dr and Hayden Run on report of two bikes abandoned by the guardrail. Officers recovered both bikes and placed them in storage.

Jan 3

Officers were dispatched to the intersection of Riverside Dr and Hayden Rd on a two-car accident. Unit 2 was traveling northbound on Riverside Dr and failed to yield while attempting to turn left and was struck by Unit 1. Unit 1 fled the scene. No citations were issued.

Jan 3

Officers responded to a two-car accident on Riverside Dr. Unit 1 was stopped in the southbound lane of Riverside Dr. Unit 2 failed to stop in time and struck the rear of Unit 1. Unit 2 was cited for failure to maintain assured clear distance ahead.

Jan 4

Officers responded to an accident on Henderson Rd approaching Charlbury. Unit 1 attempted to pass and merge in front of Unit 2 and struck the front left fender of Unit 2. Unit 1 was issued a citation for a marked lanes violation.

Jan 5

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr north of Fishinger Rd. Units 1 and 2 side-swiped one another as the two northbound lanes merged into one. Due to conflicting statements, no citation was issued.

Jan 5

Officers responded to a report of suspicious activity at a residence.

Jan 6

Officers responded to a deer strike on Riverside Dr south. The deer ran off and was not located, and the driver of the vehicle was not injured.

Jan 6

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of Linworth Rd and W Dublin Granville Rd. Unit 2 was stopped in front of Unit 1 and reversed into the front of Unit 1, before driving off.

Jan 8

Officer was dispatched to the 8300 block of Fairway Dr on report of a scam. The victim stated they were "federal agents" and had a warrant for her arrest, asking her to provide them with information. Officers explained the individuals were not federal agents and she would not be arrested.

Jan 9

Officers responded on mutual aid to assist Dublin Police in locating a suicidal male. Officers located the individual with a self-inflicted gunshot wound to the head.

Jan 11

Officer responded to a single-car deer strike on Henderson Rd.

Jan 11

A Perry Township employee located a Kroger bag containing miscellaneous prescriptions outside of building #2. The medications were collected and placed into evidence for future destruction.

Jan 11

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of McVey Blvd and Merwood St. Unit 2 1 attempted to make a left turn onto Merwood St. Unit 2 attempted to make a left turn from Merwood St onto McVey Blvd and failed to yield to Unit 1. Unit 2 was issued a citation for failure to yield when making a left turn.

Jan 11

Officers responded to an accident on SR 161 east of Linworth Rd. Unit 2 turned left out of a parking lot without yielding the right of way and was struck on the driver's side by Unit 1. Unit 2 was cited for failure to yield.

Jan 12

Officer initiated a traffic stop after observing a vehicle with two illuminated blue lights next to each headlight instead of the legal colored marker lights. Officer discovered the vehicle's registration had expired and the driver did not have a driver's license in the United States or proof of insurance. The vehicle was impounded and the driver provided with a court date.

Jan 12

Officers were dispatched to the 2700 block of Snouffer Rd on a disturbance. Upon arrival, officers encountered two white males, highly intoxicated, belligerent, and disorderly in nature. Officers attempted to quell the disturbance. Both agreed to cease their disorderly behavior for the remainder of the evening. A second call was received, and it was found that their behavior and hostility had continued. Officers decided to physically arrest both individuals.

Jan 14

Officers were dispatched to the 4600 block of Riverside Dr on an accident. Officers found a one car accident blocking both lanes of traffic. The occupants were taken to the hospital for treatment. At the hospital, it was discovered that the driver had a strong odor of alcohol about his person. The driver was cited for OVI, failure to control, and no operator's license.

Jan 14

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Olde Hill Ct N on report of a missing person. The caller stated his room mate went on a date and did not return home and was not responding to phone calls. Officers were able to make contact with the individual, who explained that he would be home tomorrow, and that his phone had died which is why no one could reach him.

Jan 15

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr. Unit 1 was off to the side of the road after running out of gas. Unit 2 struck the rear of Unit 1, stating that Unit 1 was not far enough to the side to be avoided. Due to conflicting statements, no citation was issued.

Jan 16

Officers were dispatched to the 5500 block of Riverside Dr on a suspicious person in a resident's driveway. Officers searched the property and found no one. No footprints or evidence were found in fresh snow on the ground. Officers reassured the resident that no one was present, then cleared and returned to patrol.

Jan 17

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Winston Ct N to assist medics. Dispatch indicated Worthington Medics were on scene for an injured male and could hear a lot of screaming coming from inside the residence. Officer knocked on the door and was allowed in. The injured individual was located and medics were able to get him on a gurney. There were no indications of a struggle or fight inside the residence. The man was transported to the hospital.

Jan 18

Officers were dispatched to assist Sharon Township with a vehicle crash involving four cars at the intersection of Flint Rd and Park Rd. Perry Officers conducted traffic control for Sharn. After the Sharon investigation was completed, Capital Towing arrived and removed the vehicles from the roadway.

Jan 19

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr during a period of heavy precipitation. Driver of unit 2 was traveling northbound and went left of center, striking southbound unit 1. The driver of unit 1 complained of back pain but declined medical services on scene.

Jan 19

Officers responded to an accident on US 161 at the intersection with Railroad St. Unit 2 was eastbound on 161. Unit 2 slid on the snow roads, striking Unit 1 in the rear. Unit 2 was cited for ACDA and no operator's license.

Jan 19

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr. Unit 1 was traveling south during heavy precipitation. Driver failed to maintain control of the vehicle, left the roadway, and entered a tree line, causing damage to the grass and his vehicle. Vehicle was removed by owner's requested wrecker.

Jan 19

Officers were dispatched to the Arlington Pointe Apartments on an assault complaint.

Jan 19

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr south of Chateau Cir. Unit 2 changed lanes to the inside lane and struck the rear of Unit 1. Both occupants of Unit 1 were examined by Upper Arlington Medics, and one was transported to the hospital. The operator of Unit 2 was issued a citation for ACDA.

Jan 20

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr south of Cranston Dr. Unit 2 was traveling northbound and struck the rear of Unit 1, which was stopped for traffic. Unit 2 was issued a citation for ACDA.

Jan 21

Officer was dispatched on a noise complaint for loud music at Arlington Pointe. Upon arrival, officer did not hear any loud music.

Jan 22

A driver southbound on Riverside Dr lost control and struck a wall in the 4900 block of Riverside Dr.

Jan 22

Officers responded to a hit-skip accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd. Unit 2 accelerated and attempted to merge, striking unit 1 on the passenger side. Unit 2 continued southbound and did not stop. Unit 1 was not able to get a tag number or details of the driver. No injuries were reported.

Jan 22

Officers responded to a report of vandalism. The caller explained that his wife's vehicle appeared to have been gone through sometime the previous night. To the best of their knowledge, nothing was missing or stolen.

Jan 24

Officers were dispatched to Arlington Pointe on a prowler call. The caller stated a man in a baseball cap and jacket had knocked on her window. Officers located a man meeting that description talking with a tow truck driver. The man explained his car had broken down and he was trying to get help as his cell phone was not working.

Jan 24

Officers responded to an accident in the 3900 block of Riverside Dr. Unit 2 was northbound on Riverside Dr and went left of center, striking Unit 1. The driver of unit 2 was cited for a marked lanes violation.

Jan 27

Officers were dispatched to Arlington Pointe to meet with the Licking County Sheriff's Department. Officers were met by Officers of the Pataskala Police Department. Officers assisted Pataskala officers in serving a warrant. The suspect was arrested and transported to the Licking County Jail by Pataskala police.

Jan 27

Officers were dispatched to assist Dublin Police with a well-being check per mutual aid.

Jan 27

While on patrol, officer observed an unoccupied vehicle parked off the roadway in the 2500 block of W. Dublin Granville Rd. The vehicle had no license plate. The key was in the ignition, but the ignition appeared damaged, and a screwdriver was laying on the driver's seat. Officer attempted to make contact with the registered owner but was unable to make contact.

Jan 29

Officers responded to an accident on SR 161 approaching McVey Blvd. A vehicle went off the left side of the road into a ditch, striking a mailbox, and then a utility pole. The driver was cited for failure to control.

Jan 29

Officers were notified by the lieutenant that the owner of a business reported a gold van with no plates parked in his parking lots. Officers arrived on scene and found the vehicle. Officers had the vehicle towed to be impounded for safekeeping.

Jan 29

Officers were dispatched to the 6500 block of McVey Blvd on a mental health run. Officers spoke with the resident. He explained his wife has spent thousands of dollars on someone impersonating Alan Jackson. Franklin County CID 771 and 772 were dispatched as well. It was determined his wife was in the early stages of dementia.

Jan 29

Officers received a report of an accident which occurred on Jan 23. Unit 1 was west on US 33 and stopped for traffic. Unit 2 struck the rear of Unit 1. Involved parties exchanged insurance information and had medical treatment at a later date. No citation was issued.

Jan 30

Officers responded to an accident in the 6100 block of Linworth Rd. Unit 1 was traveling south on Linworth Rd and stopped for traffic. Unit 2 drove on the double yellow line to pass unit 1 and struck the front of unit 1. Unit 2 was cited for a marked lanes violation.

Jan 30

Officers responded to an accident on SR 161. Unit 1 was stopped for a red light. Unit 2 failed to stop and struck the rear of unit 1. Unit 2 was cited for ACDA.

Jan 30

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of US 33 and Hayden Run Rd. Unit 2 attempted to make a left turn on yellow and was struck by southbound unit 1. The driver of unit 1 was transported to the hospital. The driver of unit 2 was cited for failure to yield on a left turn.
