Police Reports and Activity in Perry Township  
**Month of July 2024**



**July 1**

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Fishinger Rd. Unit 2 was eastbound on Fishinger Rd and turning north onto Riverside Dr. Unit 2 failed to yield to unit 1 and struck unit 1 head on. Unit 2 was cited for failure to yield on left turn.

**July 1**

Officer responded to SR-315 at Hard Rd to assist Sharon Township on an injury crash. Upon arrival, officer checked on involved parties until Worthington Fire arrived on scene. Officer remained on scene to assist with traffic until Sharon Officers advised they could clear.

**July 2**

While on patrol in the area of Riverside Dr and Nottingham Rd, officer observed a northbound vehicle on Riverside Dr that appeared to be driving faster than the posted speed limit of 45 mph and did not have headlights. Lase confirmed the speed of the vehicle to be 69 MPH. Officer initiated a traffic stop. Officer discovered that the driver's driving privileges were suspended. The driver was cited for speed, driving without a license, driving under suspension, and driving without headlights. The vehicle was impounded.

**July 3**

Officers were on regular patrol on Clubview Blvd S and noticed an open garage door. Officers noticed that the entry door leading into the house was unlocked, but there were no signs of forced entry. Officers searched the house as, then cleared and secured the door and garage.

**July 3**

Office responded to an accident on Riverside Dr in the area of Canterbury Dr. Unit 1 drove off the right side of the roadway and made contact with the guardrail. Unit 1 was charged with failure to control and OVI.

**July 5**

Officer was conducting traffic enforcement as part of the Franklin County DUI Task Force and witnessed two vehicles street racing north on Sawmill Rd. Officer followed the vehicle in the left lane, which failed to stop and switched the vehicle lights off at 70 mph. Officer initiated a traffic stop. The driver stated that he turned his lights off to test if they were working. The driver was cited for speeding, street racing, and driving without taillights. The vehicle was impounded for safe keeping.

**July 6**

Officers responded along with Sharon Township on a mutual aid request from Gahanna PD on a wrong way driver going westbound on I-270 approaching US-23. Gahanna PD struck the vehicle and forced it towards the center barrier wall causing it to stop. Officers blocked lanes until a tow arrived to take the suspect's vehicle.

**July 7**

Officers received a call on a reported vehicle in the water along Riverside Dr. The Columbus Division of Fire and Police Department were already on scene. Officers assisted CPD with traffic control and shutting down Riverside Dr while they investigated the found vehicle.

**July 8**

While conducting traffic enforcement, officer observed a vehicle traveling westbound on Henderson Rd at a high rate of speed. Officer conducted a traffic stop and discovered that the driver did not have a valid license but was able to provide proof of insurance. The driver was cited for speed and operating a motor vehicle without a valid license.

**July 10**

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr approaching Henderson Rd. Unit 2 was traveling northbound on Riverside Dr. The driver stated a vehicle turned from Henderson Rd onto Riverside north suddenly, causing her to slam on her brakes and swerve into the southbound lane of travel, striking unit 1. All parties declined medical attention.

**July 10**

Officers responded to a multi-vehicle accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd. Unit 3 was traveling northbound on Riverside Dr and attempting to turn westbound onto Hayden Run Rd. Unit 2, on Hayden Run Rd west, stated he had a green light and entered the intersection. Unit 3 attempted a left turn and struck the front of unit 2. After striking unit 2, unit 3 continued and struck the center front of unit 1. Unit 3 was issued a citation for failure to yield and for driving without a license. The driver of unit 3 was transported to the hospital. All other parties declined medical attention.

**July 10**

Officers were dispatched on a missing child. Officers searched the property and located the child sleeping upstairs.

**July 11**

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr north of Fishinger Rd. Unit 3 approached unit 2 and 1 at a high rate of speed. Unit 3 struck the rear of unit 1 which caused unit 1 to sideswipe unit 2. Prior to the accident, units 3 and 1 were involved in a road rage incident on Riverside Dr south of Fishinger Rd. Unit 3 was cited for ACDA.

**July 12**

Officer observed a subject and vehicle with an active warrant. Officer was able to confirm the warrant and explained it to the subject. The subject was released with a new court date.

**July 12**

Worthington PD requested mutual aid in their search for a suspect that fled on foot from a traffic stop. Perry officers arrived on scene and deployed a UAS. Officers began searching the area and observed the suspect. Officer maintained visual on the suspect as he fled and was safely apprehend by Worthington Officers.

**July 12**

Officers responded to at the railroad crossing on Snouffer Rd. Unit 1 slowed to cross the railroad tracks. Unit 2 failed to maintain safe distance and collided with unit 1.

**July 13**

Officers went to the 8100 block of Blind Brook Ct on a residential house check. Officers found the residence unlocked with no signs of forced entry. Officers searched and secured the house.

**July 14**

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr north of Fishinger Rd. Unit 2 attempted to change to the right merge lane to pass a vehicle in front of them. Unit 2's passenger side collided with unit 1. The driver of unit 2 was issued a citation.

**July 15**

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd. Unit 3 was north on Riverside Dr and the operator became distracted. Unit 3 was unable to come to a stop before striking unit 2 in the rear. The collision pushed unit 2 into the rear of unit 1. Only one involved party requested medical treatment. The operator of unit 3 was issued a citation for ACDA.

**July 17**

Officer met with a resident regarding an identity theft.

**July 17**

Officers responded to a non-injury accident on Riverside Dr north of Fishinger Rd. Unit 1 was stopped for traffic. Unit 2 failed to stop and struck the rear of unit 1. The driver of unit 2 was issued a citation for ACDA.

**July 18**

Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Bethel Rd on an individual protesting in front of a building. Officer made contact with the individual, who was sitting in a chair on the sidewalk with a sign advising people not to go to a business due to poor service. Officer saw nothing defamatory to the business and the individual was not violating any laws.

**July 18**

Officers responded to an accident on Riverside Dr just south of Stratford Dr. Unit 1 was stopped in traffic facing northbound. Unit 2's driver claimed to have fallen asleep behind the wheel and struck unit 1. The driver of unit 2 was transported to the hospital. Unit 2 was cited for ACDA.

**July 19**

Officer observed a vehicle fail to stop at a stop sign on McVey Blvd. Officer initiated a traffic stop and discovered that the driver did not have a valid operator's license. The driver was issued a citation for disobeying a traffic control device and operating a motor vehicle without a valid license.

**July 20**

Officers responded to an accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Hayden Run Rd. Northbound unit 2 failed to yield when attempting a left turn onto Hayden Run Rd and struck southbound unit 1. Occupants of unit 1 were transported to the hospital. Unit 2 was issued a citation for failure to yield.

**July 20**

Officers responded to the 1000 block of Blind Brook Dr on a domestic dispute

**July 20**

Officer was dispatched to relay with Reynoldsburg PD for possible warrants.

**July 21**

Officer observed a vehicle traveling westbound on Snouffer Rd with highbeams on and failing to dim them. Officer initiated a traffic stop and discovered that the driver did not have a valid license or insurance. Officer issued a citation for failure to dim highbeams and driving without a valid license. The vehicle was impounded.

**July 21**

Officers were dispatched to the area of Brookdown Dr and Dublin-Granville Rd on a person laying in a ditch and asking for help. Officers located the man, who was identified as an amputee and using crutches. Medics were requested as a precaution and the man was transported to the hospital for evaluation.

**July 22**

Officer was dispatched to the 2500 block of Riverside Dr on a theft from a motor vehicle.

**July 24**

Officers responded to an injury accident at the intersection of Riverside Dr and Zollinger Rd. Unit 2 attempted to make a left turn onto Zollinger Rd in front of Unit 1 causing Unit 1 to strike the passenger front of Unit 2. Both units were transported to the hospital for medical evaluation. Unit 2 was issued a citation for failure to yield when making a left turn.

**July 24**

Officers responded to the area of I-270 westbound and Cemetery Rd on an officer in trouble call. Upon arrival, officers were advised that armed robbery suspects were taken into custody and additional units were no longer needed. Officers cleared without incident.

**July 24**

Officers were dispatched to the 6700 block of McVey Blvd on a report of possible domestic violence. Dispatched advised a caller heard a male yelling at a female making threats towards her. Officers spoke with the involved parties and found no signs of any type of physical altercation, and no threats were made. The male loudly yelled at officers to get off his property. Officer advised the male to keep his voice down or officers would probably be called again.

**July 24**

While on patrol, officer observed a vehicle with expired registration. Officer discovered the driver had an expired Mexican license and no valid Ohio/US driver's license. The driver was cited for not having a valid driver's license, fictitious plates, and an expired registration. The vehicle was released to the passenger, who possessed a valid license.

Officer responded to a single vehicle accident in the 5400 block of Linworth Rd. The driver stated that he fell asleep, causing him to drive off the right side of the roadway and strike the guard rail. The driver was issued a citation for failure to control.

Officers responded to an accident on W Dublin Granville Rd at the intersection with Bellbrook Rd. Unit 2 did not see unit 1 stopped in traffic and struck unit 1 from behind. The passenger of unit 1 was transported to the hospital. The driver of unit 2 was cited for ACDA.

Officers responded to a non-injury accident W Dublin Granville Rd at Flora Villa Dr. Unit 1 struck the rear of unit 2 as unit 2 slowed to a stop. Unit 1 was issued a citation for ACDA.

Officers responded to an accident on W Dublin Granville Rd approaching Fiesta Dr Unit 2 attempted to make a left turn onto W Dublin Granville Rd and was struck by westbound unit 1. Unit 2 was issued a citation for failure to yield.

While working traffic on Riverside Dr, officer observed a vehicle traveling northbound with illegal blue fog lights. Officer initiated a traffic stop and discovered the driver did not have a driver's license or proof of insurance. Officer cited the driver for driving without a valid license and having illegal blue lights.
